



3rd Annual WALK AGAINST MALARIA 2011

The Pre Health Professionals of Oshkosh invite you to participate in the third annual UWO Walk Against Malaria on Saturday, April 30th, 2011. As the name suggests, the walk will raise money to prevent transmission of malaria, a deadly tropical disease.

Why malaria? Because malaria kills millions of people each year, most of who are children. It is estimated that the number of children that die from malaria each day is enough to fill 7 jumbo jets. Worldwide, a child dies every 30 seconds from malaria. Using bed nets is the easiest way of holding malaria at bay and to save the lives of children. The Walk Against Malaria is working with AgainstMalaria.com to supply bed nets to families who live in malarious areas. Each bed net costs only five dollars, and 100% of donated funds are used for buying and transporting bed nets – participants can use the AgainstMalaria website to view how many nets were donated by UWO, find where they were delivered, and view pictures of families receiving their bed nets.

The 3 km circular walk will be around campus. It will begin and end at the Student Recreation and Wellness Center. After the Walk, there will be fruit, bagels, and water provided as well as door prizes. The walk will begin at 11 am on April 30th with registration beginning at 10:30 am.
