Just a stone's throw from the Resort Hotel is the Newbridge on Usk, our traditional country pub serving wholesome country fare.






Comfortable sofas, blazing fires, and afternoon tea; what could be better?



ultimate challenge built specifically to test the world's greatest golfers at The 2010 Ryder Cup.


In early June the Resort hosts the annual Celtic Manor Wales Open, a leading European Tour event.



















There are two clubhouses within the manicured grounds of Celtic Manor.
