

Jesus said "It is more blessed to give than to receive" → something can't be a burden and a blessing...it's one or the other right...so if giving is a blessing, it can't ever be a burden! Only good can come from the seed of sowing!

The thing to remember here is all offerings are relative...if you have \$10 and give \$5 into the offering, that's a 50% offering to God → Remember that...it is an offering TO GOD...so a 50% offering to God is a 'rich offering' now if someone has \$100 and they give \$5...that's a 5% offering to God...it's like a 'poor offering' The bigger the revelation of God's love and the finished work of Jesus living and dying on Earth you have...the richer you will want your offering to be because you just WANT to show God love – this is because it is through greater revelation and understanding of God that we build greater relationship and intimacy with our Father!

So then – the greater the revelation, the greater the intimacy, the greater expression of love we want to show

BUT – in the same hand...God accepts every offering just the same and multiplies them just the same, the thing that differs is the supernatural blessing...the more you sow IN LOVE, the more blessing you reap → so then the richer your offering...the greater the revelation you will have of God's love through the blessings he will pour into your life...I believe when you get a greater revelation for God's love through blessings in your life, then you will get a greater revelation of the GRACE you're given to receive that love, grace that's only poured onto us through the Finished work of Jesus Christ.

But the key to unlocking all this and really getting a revelation of God's love comes from something else...and there's 2 paths to choose that will lead you either in a circle back to where you were or deeper into a revelation of God and the Finished work that soaks us in grace...

OK so the story of the First Passover...in Exodus God said "when I see the blood of the lamb on the front door of your house, I will pass over you". So you're there in your house, with lamb's blood painted on your front door and you're eating your nice lamb dinner inside and you're here these loud wailing sounds outside and you feel everything start to shake...you know it's God coming through the town, and you know you've painted the lamb's blood on your door – and God told you that as long as that blood is on your door, you're safe...

Are you trembling in fear inside your house, worrying that God might not keep his word and that he won't bless the offering of lamb's blood you left on the door

OR – are you sitting inside enjoying your lamb, enjoying the peace of resting in God and experiencing his love first hand...

The attitude you have when it comes to your offering, and the hunger you have for deeper revelation of God's love and what it REALLY means that Jesus finished His work on Earth by dying on the cross...will determine how much you will reap from the seed you sow → God's blessing and love was exactly the same for the man trembling in fear as it was the man rejoicing in His love...it's only the revelation of the truth behind it that differs.
