You can also use plastic bags on warm days to kill bedbugs. Loosely put your clothing or linens in a big plastic bag and seal. Take care not to overly pack the bags. Keep the bags outside in the sun for a few days.

A great way to repel bedbugs is using boric acid powder which can be found at a pharmacy or supermarket. Do not place this powder in your bed, but around it. Putting the powder in the cracks and pathways leading to your bed is a great way to prevent their entry. A great bedbug repellent is boric acid which is typically used to kill cockroaches. If you have been vacuuming and steam cleaning regularly, but cannot get rid of your bedbugs, you can also call an exterminator for help.
