In Glas-Ply Outboard Models the life preservation system comes into play. Have your dealer fully explain to you the floatation

features and benefits. The rigid hull grid construction with its FRP stringers is second to none. The power plants as selected are perfected and refined for the Glas-Ply Models. Full unitization permits the hull to absorb greater forces from the various boating activities. Yes, at Glas-Ply we believe that a boat that is only powerful is dangerously incomplete. We demand precision where precision is crucial, and agility and durability are more than just matters of theoretical speculation.

Second it maintains its original color and gloss with maintenance. Third, your Glas-Ply boat resists the penetration of water into the fiberglass laminate below the water line with this superior Gelcoat.

Remember, because of the constant exterior exposure your Glas-Ply boat receives, it needs and appreciates the same tender loving care

used to maintain a quality automobile. Gelcoat is not an indestructible surface coating nor is it an impervious material. See your local authorized dealer for suggestions on cleaning, maintaining, and protecting the surface of your quality Glas-Ply boat.

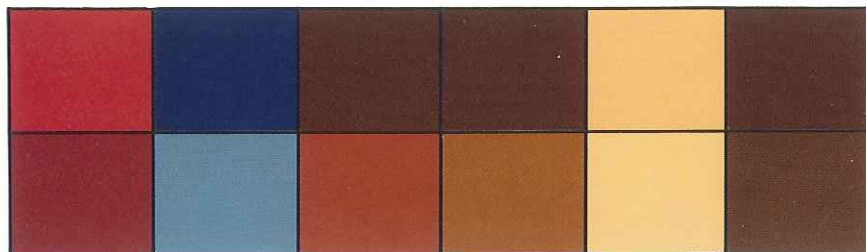
