

easy methods to validate email

Electronic mail, or most commonly known as email, is the standard for exchange of information across the Internet. The email address is what you enter into the 'Recipient' area of a composed email in order to send it to that particular person. Many companies utilize groups of individuals to maintain their email lists for various information and updates about the company. With the quick growth rate of the Internet (about 2.2 billion email users around the world), it may be very difficult to determine which email addresses have already been taken or are valid. This information is important to know if you are planning to market to potentially new customers or want to clean up a subscribed email list.

Naturally, inspecting the validity of email addresses always demands an Internet connection. It would be impossible to monitor the email address changes and updates and keep them available offline. Consequently, you might find a number of websites used to determine the availability of an email address. One such website is very simplistic in that it offers a box into which you may type your email address. The website then searches for a registered email address by that name and returns if the address is taken or not. The main drawback is that just one email address can be authenticated at a time. This makes for a long address list clean up an even longer process.

Luckily, a program is available from www.hothotsoftware.com that allows for a huge search of valid email address. By going to the website and searching for 'Check if an E-mail Address Exists' you can find a program to meet your specific need. After opening the software, you will find that it is written in a classic user interface so almost anyone familiar with a computer can master the software. The software also functions completely within a single window. This reduces any possibility of getting lost within the program. The window of the program is split into three primary areas. The left area of the window has a box that can be populated with potential email addresses. These addresses can be anything that you want to check the availability. The center section permits for input of any email addresses to exclude from the search. These are entered by just including the email address up until the @ symbol. This is done because some companies will use similar email addresses for similar purposes. For example, many companies have a registered email address of 'contact@company.com' for question purposes. By entering 'contact@' into the center section of the program any emails beginning with 'contact' will be excluded. The right area of the window shows the completed list of valid email addresses.
