Sponsors: France, Great Britain, Spain, the Ottoman Empire Signatories: None Topic: "Ending the Great War and balancing the relative strength of the world powers"

The General Assembly,

Deeply concerned with the devastating effects of the current great war,

<u>Alarmed</u> the rapid expansionism and unhindered growth by the Russian Empire, and the resulting strength of the Russo-German alliance,

Emphasizing the role Russian and German belligerence played in starting the war,

Noting Sweden's justified need for expansion,

- 1. <u>Congratulates</u> the valiant war effort displayed by Great Britain, Spain, the Ottoman Empire and France,
- 2. Condemns Russia's aggressive expansionism in general,
- 3. <u>Proposes</u> that Sweden is given the entirety of Iceland in exchange for giving their Canadian provinces to Great Britain, to eliminate border friction,
- 4. Invites Sweden to a defensive alliance against Russo-German aggression,
- 5. <u>Demands</u> the following:
 - a) Russia is to cede the following provinces to Sweden upon the end of the war:
 - Kola
 - Karelia
 - Neva
 - Ingermanland
 - Kexholm
 - Olonets
 - Ladoga
 - Kholmogory
 - Kargopol
 - Arkhengelsk
 - b) Germany is to cede the following provinces to Sweden upon end of the war:
 - Narva
 - Reval
 - Ösel
 - c) Russia is to cede the following province to Ming upon the end of the war, for the sake of pretty borders:
 - Wenzhou
 - d) Germany and Russia ends their current alliance and are not to enter into a new one for at least a hundred (100) years,
 - e) Germany and Russia are each to pay a sum of one thousand (1000) ducats as war reparations to each of Great Britain, Spain, the Ottoman Empire and France over a period of 20 years.
 - f) Russia is to cease it's expansion into the Chinese and Indian regions.
