

Sin/Offense	Consequence	Scripture Verse
Disobedience	Separation (sin separates us from God) and prayer until ready to obey with a happy heart. Pray together.	Colossians 3:20 <i>Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.</i>
Lying	Deal swiftly with the sin. Pray together.	Proverbs 12:22 <i>Lying lips are abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly are his delight.</i>
Selfish disputes	Removal of the toy. We remove anything that causes us to sin.	James 3:14a, 16 <i>But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not...For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.</i>
Hitting	Separation and prayer until they have a clean heart. Apologize to the one offended and say 3 nice things about them.	Ephesians 4:32 <i>And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.</i>
Hateful Talking	Apologize to the one offended and say 3 nice things about them. Pray together.	Ephesians 4:29 <i>Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.</i> Proverbs 11:17 <i>The merciful man doeth good to his own soul: but he that is cruel troubleth his own flesh.</i>
Complaining and/or Whining	Separation until they have a genuinely good attitude.	Philippians 2:14 <i>Do all things without murmurings and disputings.</i> Proverbs 15:13a <i>A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance...</i>
Arguing	<i>With mom:</i> Break until ready to obey with a happy heart. <i>With others:</i> Who wants to be like Jesus and be the peacemaker?	Ephesians 6:1 <i>Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.</i> Matthew 5:9 <i>Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God.</i>
