


Richard De Klerk, CBGB actor

"For Lovers Only" is a movie about two people who were lovers that meet again after several years in the same city and discover that actually their love is far from faded away. But...no. This is so not the way of speaking about this movie. Let's begin again, shall we?

"For Lovers Only" is a story about two lost souls who find themselves again after long time, and that come back home again, because true love never dies. Because this is the whole point. There are many people who can make a person happy, but only one is THE ONE, that complementary part of the soul that is somewhere in the world. Sofia and Yves had find that, but they were too young, to unexperted to recognize that, and they left the world taking away that possibility of happiness from them, understanding then, only later, the mistake. "If you find something really really great don't screw it up, don't mess it up, hang on to each other.", and it's true, even if once there it's not so easy to understand what really is important, and how to deal with it. The fact is that world and life are complicated, and if and when, in a moment of serendipity, all the circumstances are right again, and the two persons find themselves again, everything else is changed.

For Sofia and Yves this was the case, because in the meantime they had constructed a family, Yves had had a daughter; all things that cannot be easily underestimated. But what to do when the real love appears again in your life? Would you want to taste it again, even for a few days? Thinking about it all the movie is about Sofia and Yves saying goodbye to each other. They understand that there is no possibility they can stay together now, and decide to use those last days to dream for a while that it is possible. Leaving to personal opinion judging the rightness of their behavior towards their partners, Sofia and Yves have a certain degree of desperation in their time together

... They know it will end soon, and are afraid of it, they want the other, but at the same time they know what they are doing and the thought saddens them. Like when someone tries to hold water in their hands; no matter the efforts everyone knows that it will drop away. Everytime they kiss, everytime they make love, or it is characterized by some kind of desperate craving, or by a quiet feeling of melancholic happiness that highlights even more every second of it. Trying to define what these two people are trying to do it could be said that they are trying to fill that hole that they have in their hearts with the other, with all the moments and laughs and kisses of the other person. Because they have to let it go, they have to come back to their life and live it in the present and future, not in the past. This really happens when Sofia gives Yves the letter before, and then with the dress of his daughter. The message is: we have to let it go, it is useless we continue to torture ourselves because it is impossible to come back, and now there is no possibility for something. We have to live for what we have, and be happy with it. We have to go on. It is implicit that going on does not mean forgetting, on the contrary it means living with the renewed strength that all the memories give.

Particular importance has the end. Contrary to all the movie, the ending is not in black and white. Sofia and Yves are in a flowered field and play together, laugh, dance, in an atmosphere of complete serenity. Why this difference? Maybe with an hazard it could be said that the last frames do not show an earthly scenario, but a sort of aerial parallel version of the universe where the souls meet, and in this world Sofia and Yves's souls are together. It is quite understandable the difference between the atmosphere of the all movie, that, however, lightens a bit in the end when Sofia leaves Paris, and the atmosphere of the ending frames. Very different, as the music is, reflecting the evolution of the relationship understanding by both the characters. This understanding of the reality of the situation, frees them from their past, so that now they are free with the deep belief that they will never be apart. And it is not just a case that the movie ends with Sofia and Yves souls' hug in that flowered field.

After all I wrote it wouldn't be necessary to explain why I love this movie, and why I love the characters; it is impossible not to feel pulled into a story that is so realistic and romantic at the same time. The feelings and the exact atmosphere of each character are expressed at their best by the two actors, that find their natural environment a black and white movie, a choice that highlights even more their ability in portraying the characters emotions and expressions. So thank you Mark, Michael, and Stana for this beautiful gift. This is a very precious movie, one that leaves something inside, a rare one.

I think that, as an actress who loves characters so much, you would like hearing about how a bunch of completely inexperienced people found creative ways to share a real life person's story. That's probably the shortest way of explaining why I thought about including this article in this project. Enjoy!

Professional storytelling: It's not quite acting, but it's not quite not acting either. Rather, it doesn't have to be acting, but it's allowed to involve some acting if you want it to. Or...well, that's the great thing about telling stories--the possibilities are endless. Apparently, you can even do the storytelling thing professionally. But I'm getting ahead of myself here. Sort of...

Telling their stories : Students and the legacy of the Holocaust

In the fall of 2003, Uta Larkey, assistant professor of German, recruited students for a new course she planned to offer the following semester. Called "oral Histories of the Holocaust," the course was based on one offered at Pittsburgh-area schools. Under the guidance of Larkey; Steve Salzberg, a psychiatrist who interviewed Holocaust survivors for the Shoah Foundation; and Jennifer Rudick Zunikoff, a Jewish storyteller, a half-dozen Goucher students learned to dramatically embody the stories of two local Holocaust survivors, Rubin Sztajer and Emmy Mogilensky.

Based on enthusiastic response to the course and its outcomes, Larkey hopes to offer an expanded version for the Fall 2005 semester. In the pages that follow, three of the participants, Shana Lieberman '06 and Taneisha Osborne '04 share their creative journeys.

The Best You Can Give (by Shana)

Very few people survived the Holocaust: even fewer are still alive. One of these days none of them will be around to tell their stories. Someone else will have to do it for them. Why not me?

Even though I had not done any theater or a lot of interviewing--and I was terrified of the thought of having to give a final presentation--the course sounded important when Professor Larkey told us about it. So I registered for it.

For the first few weeks, we met with Steve Salzberg and Jennifer Rudick Zunikoff to learn interviewing and storytelling techniques. At one of the early meetings, Jennifer performed a story from Hasidic Tales From the Holocaust, as a sample of the type of presentation we would eventually do. She's a professional so obviously it was very good. The expressions on the other students' faces seemed to say, "We are supposed to do it like that?"

We did mock interviews with Steve, including one when he pretended to be his father (complete with a Polish accent). One of the most important things he taught us, however, was how to sit through somebody's pain. He also told us not to turn the camera off too soon, since that's often when the best material comes out.

We were divided into two teams. David, Andria, and I were assigned to Rubin Sztajer, who was sent to the camps as a young teen. We met with him on three different occasions and conducted hour-long interviews about his life before, during, and after the war. For each interview, we took a different role--asking questions, taking notes, or videotaping.

Although we were initially nervous about what Rubin would be like or what he would (or would not) say, it was easy. He wants to tell his story.

Sometimes, he said, survivors twist their stories a bit or are slightly off with the dates. That worries him, because if even one discrepancy is discovered, the entire story might be questioned. So he knows his facts.

When we did the second interview, he said, "I have my set piece for this part; don't ask any questions until the end." Steven had warned us that we might have this problem, that Rubin might not want to deviate from his "script." He told his story, and we tried to get some extra out of it, but he didn't want to go too far-not because he doesn't want to talk about it, but because he thinks no one will believe him.

We kept asking, "What was it like," and he kept replying, "You wouldn't believe it. I'm not telling you." That line became an important part of David's performance.

It was strange to return to campus after the interviews. One minute I was hearing about things so horrible I couldn't even being to fathom them. Then, I'd step outside into a beautiful day and be back at Goucher.

After each interview, we met as a class and shared the things he had said that surprised us or really stood out. We offered each other feedback, both on what we told and how we told it.

When the time came to piece everything together, Jennifer surprised us. She said we already had our stories, that the images and things we remembered were what we should tell. My story began to take on a life of its own. Our first performance was in Hillel, on a Friday night near the end of the semester. I always eat dinner there on Fridays, and people usually leave after dinner. I was terrified that nobody would stay and listen--more terrified than I was about the performance. We had invited Rubin, and I didn't want him to think that no one cared.

About 20 people came, including people from outside the Hillel community. As I was sitting on the couch, waiting to perform, I hardly heard what anyone else said. My heart was pounding in my head. I remember looking around the room after each person told his or her story, and especially after I told mine. Everybody was keyed into what was going on. Steve had brought his little daughter, who can't be more than 8 or 9. She sat in the front, leaning in the entire time. Her eyes were big and round.

When I went out for pizza the next night, my friends who stayed for the story asked me if I had found out when the class would be offered again. I suppose my story had really touched them.

Right after Rubin mentioned something bad in an interview, he always followed it by saying, "Don't dwell on this. It's over, but just don't let it happen again. Don't act like it's nothing, but don't feel sorry for me." He is an amazing person. He has no real bitterness, and I think people need to see that.

When you read about the Holocaust in history books, you get a very objective, group approach. Even when you are reading memoirs, most of the time it's from a historical perspective. I think it's a much more powerful experience to meet with somebody and see who that person is. The best gift you can give is listening to somebody's story.

Why not anger ? It does me no good.

Why not anger ? It doesn't belong to me.

Why not anger ? Because love is easier.

Why not anger ? You didn't receive reparations. Reparations couldn't bring my parents, friends and millions of jews back.

Why not anger ? They hated you and Jews for no reason. Because loving is easier on the spirit, and god will deal with it.

<u>Why not ...?</u> Taneisha, you have asked me why not anger, why not anger. I asked you why not love ? Why not love those who persecute you ? Why not love those who hate you ? Why not pray instead of being angry ? Why not pray for those who do evil against you ? Do you not know that love conquers all and endures all, even suffering? You no longer have questions to ask me about my anger, yet I am able to still go on in love. You see, love is where the heart is and my heart will never forget my parents or those Jews who died. As long as I live, and now as long as you live, the Holocaust will never be forgotten. Love will always overpower hate, so just give into love--it's a whole lot easier on the heart. So I ask you again, WHY NOT LOVE?

Taneisha Osborne '04 graduated with a major in religion.

She lives in Baltimore. Of her presentation, she writes: "For me, the most traumatic part of Emmy's story was her life after the war. Hearing all the terrible things that had occurred and how she had to start over without her parents made me think about my own history as an African American. This poem represents my feelings at the end of my interview with Emmy and her demeanor throughout the interview. The first speaker represents anger (me); the second speaker is love (Emmy). When read aloud, anger's tone is loud; loves tone is soft." The articles don't do this experience justice at all. I wish I could explain what the ATMOSPHERE was like whenever we all presented the completed projects together. My "team" chose to all tell the story as if we were Rubin himself, so in a way, I guess you could say there was some acting there. Jennifer and Steve even went so far as to mention that, somehow, the three of us each picked up on a piece of Rubin's personality and just stepped into it during our storytelling. It was pretty awesome, if I do say so myself. I also wish I could explain to you how powerful Taneisha's poem/discussion was-how the emotion just escalated and escalated and then, right when it came to a point where you couldn't handle that anymore, there was just this beautiful, peaceful resolution.

My whole storytelling experience was beautiful.

I have never experienced anything like it and probably never will again. One of my favorite parts, besides the obvious one of getting to meet this beautiful, strong person that survived unspeakable evil and yet still had an amazing sense of humor, was the moment right before I'd tell the story. I was able to just kind of take a breath, find this inner peace, and then slip into something much bigger than me. I absolutely loved it. I'd like to imagine that you would too. I hope you've enjoyed what I shared. As someone who manages to tell stories so well in her acting, perhaps you'll be able to understand just a little bit of the magic that I have been able to live through all of this.




I'm also fond of Beckett's hairstyles. It's fun to see all the different hairstyles over time and seasons. There were so many of them ! But every time it suited you well.
