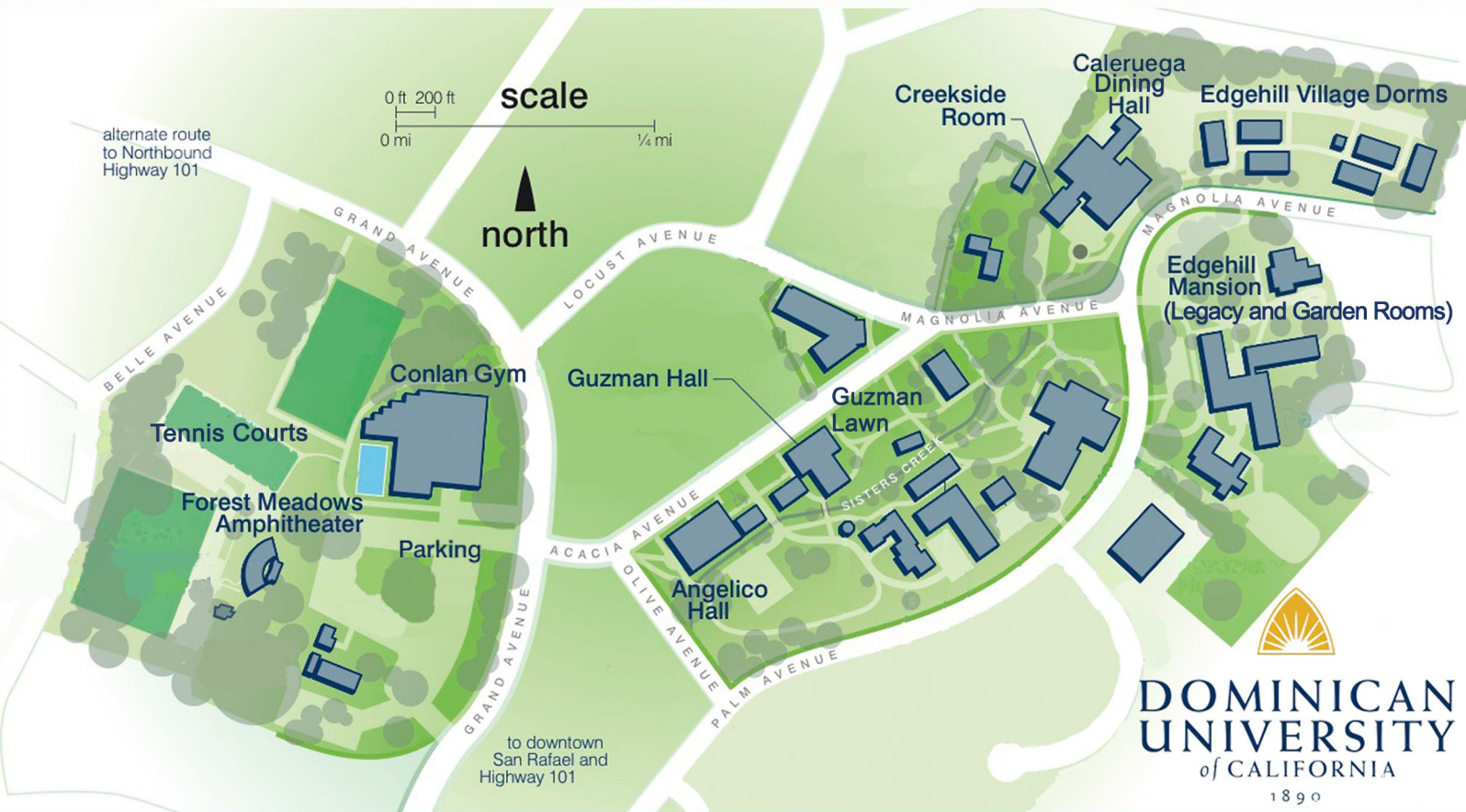

## Driving and Parking



**From the North:** Take Highway 101s to Central San Rafael exit. Turn left on Grand Avenue and travel approx. one mile to Acacia Avenue.

**From the East:** Interstate 580 to Richmond-San Rafael Bridge. Follow signs to Highway 101 North and take the Central San Rafael exit. Turn right on Second Street. Turn left on Grand Avenue and travel one mile to Acacia Avenue.

**From the South:** Highway 101 N across Golden Gate Bridge to the Central San Rafael exit. Turn right on Second Street. Turn left on Grand Avenue and travel one mile to Acacia Avenue.

Free parking will be available for all attendants on campus near the Grand Avenue entrance. All major rental car companies are represented at both the San Francisco and Oakland International Airports. Parking costs vary at the hotels.
