Materials

- 1 Skein of your main color (I used Red Heart Super Saver)
- 1 skein White
- H Hook (I crochet tightly so you might want to adjust accordingly depending on your tension)
- Tapestry Needle
- Black Yarn (for nose)
- 2 Buttons/Beads/Safety Eyes for eyes
- Needle and Thread

Gauge and Measurements

20 dc = 5.5" 5 rows = 3"

Dimensions: 37" x 5.5" (nose to tail tip)

Adjust hook size as needed to meet gauge.

Stitches and Abbreviations

Sl st – Slip Stitch

Sc – Single Crochet

Dc – Double Crochet

Scdec – Single Crochet decrease, also known as sc2tog

Hdc – Half double crochet

Fpdc – Front Post Double Crochet

Bpdc – Back Post Double Crochet

** - Follow instructions within until the end of the row unless otherwise indicated

The Body

Ch 20

Row 1-2: sc in ea st, ch1, turn (20)

Row 3: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (18)

Row 4: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (16)

Row 5: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (14)

Row 6: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (12)

Row 7: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (10)

Row 8: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (8)

Row 9: sc across, ch1, turn (8)

Row 10: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (6)

Row 11: scdec in first two sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 12: sc across, ch1, turn (4)

Row 13: scdec in first 2 sts, scdec in last 2 sts, ch1, turn (2)

Rows 14-16: sc in ea st across, ch1, turn (2)

Row 17: 2sc in ea st, ch1, turn (4)

Row 18: 2sc in first st, sc in next 2, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (6)

Row 19: 2sc in first st sc in next 4, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (8)

Row 20: 2sc in first st, sc in next 6, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (10)

Row 21: 2sc in first st, sc in next 8, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (12)

Row 22: 2sc in first st, sc in next 10, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (14)

Row 23: 2sc in first st, sc in next 12, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (16)

Row 24: 2sc in first st, sc in next 14, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (18)

Row 25: 2sc in first st, sc in next 16, 2sc in last st, ch1, turn (20)

Row 26: sc across, ch1, turn (20)

Row 27: sc across, ch 1, then sc around the edges, ending at the same corner.

Row 28: Fold both side together so they are even, sl st into the corner, and sc across, making sure to end at the other corner (20)

Row 29: hdc across (20)

Row 30: Change to second color, dc across (for clean edges, sk the first st, dc across, and then dc in the 2nd ch from the previous row) (20)

Rows 31-63: dc across ch 2, turn (20)

Row 64: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st* ch2, turn

Row 65: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 66: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 67: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 68: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 69: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 70: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 71: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 72: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 73: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 74: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 75: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 76: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 77: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 78: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 79: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 80: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 81: *pdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 82: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 83: *bpdc in first st, dc in next st*

Row 84: *fpdc in first st, dc in next st* ch 1, turn

Row 85: Sc across (20)

Row 86: 2sc in 1st st, sc across, 2sc in last st (22)

Row 87: 2sc in 1st st, sc across, 2sc in last st (24)

Row 88-91: sc across (24)

Row 92: Change to white, sc across

Row 93-96: sc across (24)

Row 97: sc across (24)

Row 98 scdec in 1st 2 sts, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts (22)

Row 99: scdec in first 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts, *scdec in next 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts* across. End with sc. (16)

Row 100: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (14)

Row 101: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (12)

Row 102: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (10)

Row 103: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (8)

Row 104: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (6)

Row 105: scdec in first 2, sc across, scdec in last 2 (4)

Finish off and reconnect your white yarn to one side of Row 92. Sc around the tail to even the edges. Finish off, weave in ends.

The Ears (Make 2)

Row 1: Chain 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook (6)

Row 2-4: sc in ea st across (6)

Row 5: scdec in first 2 st, sc across, scdec in last 2 sts (4)

Row 6: scdec in first 2 sts, scdec in last 2 sts (2)

Row 7: sc in the last st, ch 1 and sc around.

Leave long tail, sew to top of head in between the hdc and first dc row.

The Face

For the nose, I just took black yarn and a tapestry needle and made a triangle the size of the nose I wanted then filled it in, top to bottom, with black yarn.

For the eyes, you can use anything you want. I used small buttons, but you can embroider them on, get some safety eyes, or use black beads.

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
