Southern shoalhaven is full of fun places to see, things to get up to and packed with outdoor adventures. One such outdoor adventure for visitors who come to the territory is to challenge the climb to the summit of Pigeon House Mountain. The mountain famous as Didthul by the indigenous community in the area, was named as Pigeon House Mountain by Captain Cook in 1770. This seven hundred and nineteen metre tall mountain is a tough adventure for tourists who decide to take up the up hill adventure. Shoalhaven is a amazing holiday region. So remember it is advisable to holiday several days and enjoy all the thrills and adventures on store.

The climb is accessible from the south shoalhaven region in south Burill Lake. The approach to the base of the mountain is a dirt road suitable for four wheel drive motor or approached by foot. The tourist information centre provides visitors weather updates and the state of this un-sealed road when requested and for your convenience there is a picnic area at the bottom of the mountain including a cafeteria at the start of the un-sealed road.

The climb is not for the faint hearted. There are tough climbs prior to reaching the top of the mountain. However, the fantastic views from the top will definitely prove the adventure well worth the effort.
