The "Third Reich" rendered the German Lufthansa Services for Goering's Luftwaffe and had forced workers toil for themselves. Today Lufthansa will not hear little - it was founded in 1955 so new.

Since my architecture study I know about the history of this place and this part of the city. King Ludwig I. built here a Greek and a Roman Temple.

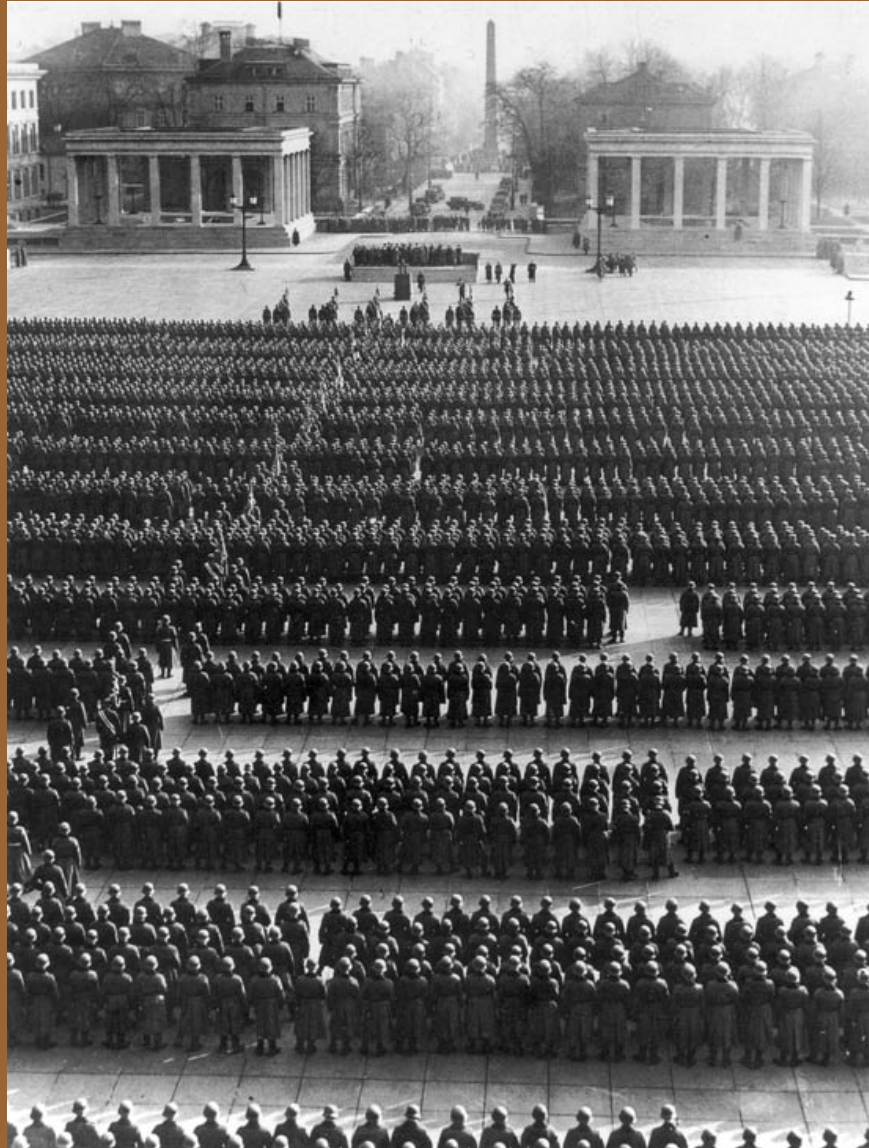
At the Königsplatz and many other places in Germany on the 10th of May 1933, it was on Pesach Sheni, books had been burned



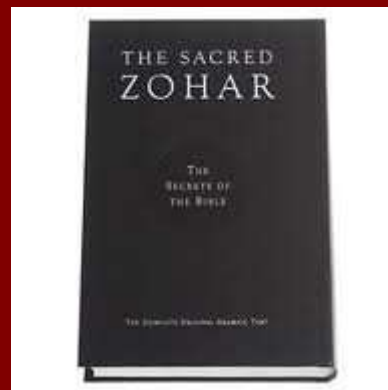
“where books are burned, they will ultimately also burn people”

During the time of the National Socialism the Nazi's hold a lot of manifestations at the Königsplatz for more than 12 years. Starting in 1933

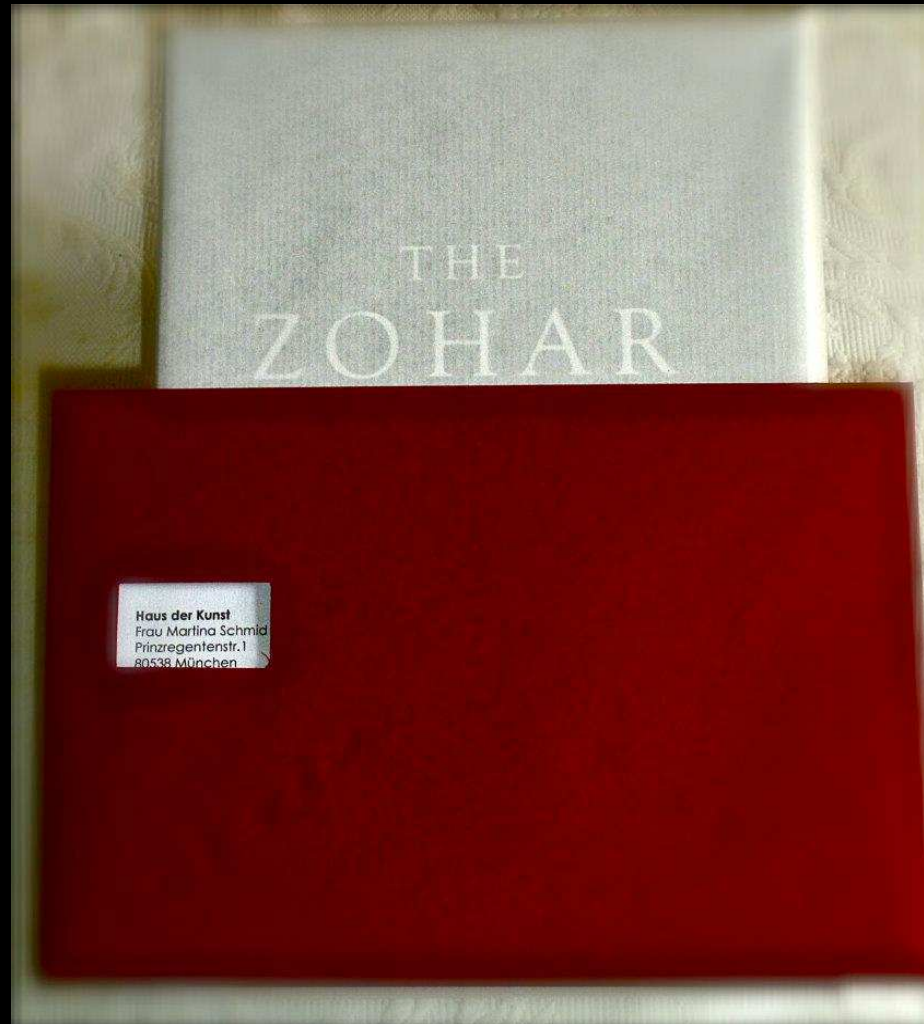


79 years later,

Haus der Kunst 1933-1937

The museum, then called *Haus der Deutschen Kunst* ("House of German Art"), was opened in 18 July 1937 as a showcase for what the Third Reich regarded as Germany's finest art.

Since 1983, the museum building also houses the nightclub, P1, Munich's famous high-society destination.

Germanys 1st Concentration Camp in Dachau



On March 22, 1933, a few weeks after Adolf Hitler had been appointed Reich Chancellor, a concentration camp for political prisoners was set up in Dachau. This camp served as a model for all later concentration camps and as a "school of violence" for the SS men under whose command it stood. In the twelve years of its existence over 200.000 persons from all over Europe were imprisoned here and in the numerous subsidiary camps. 41.500 were murdered. On April 29 1945, American troops liberated the survivors.

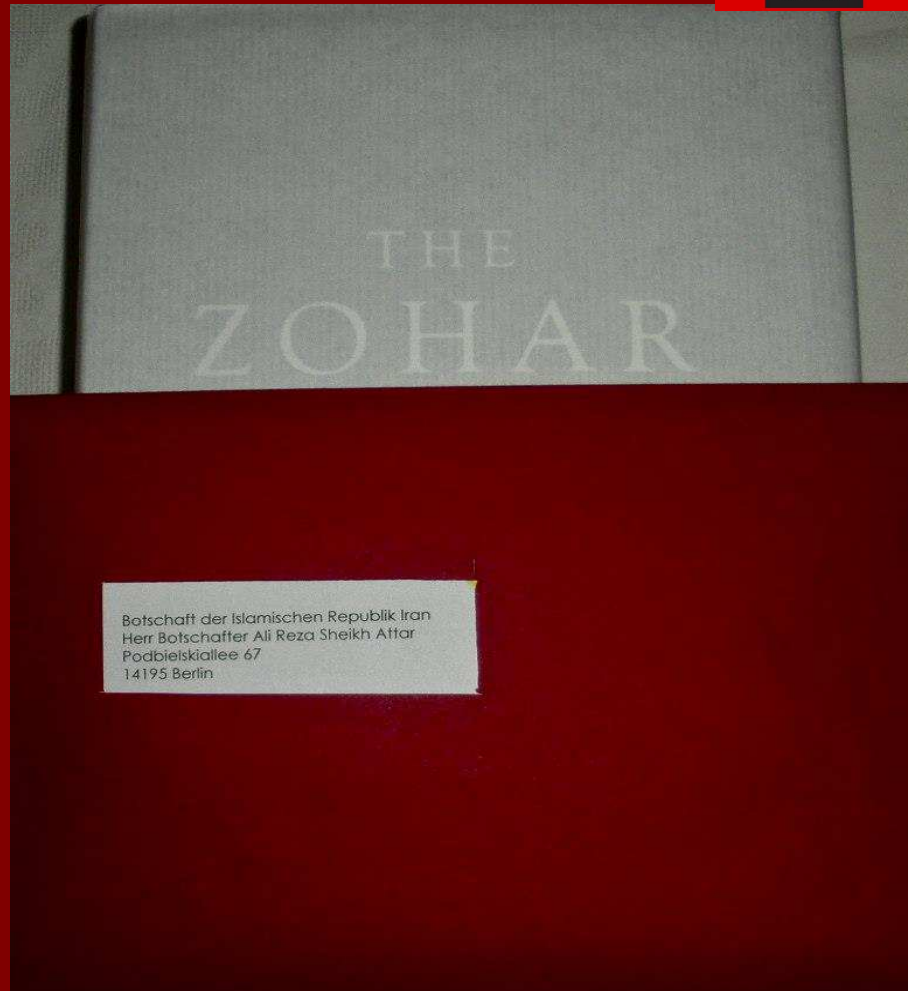

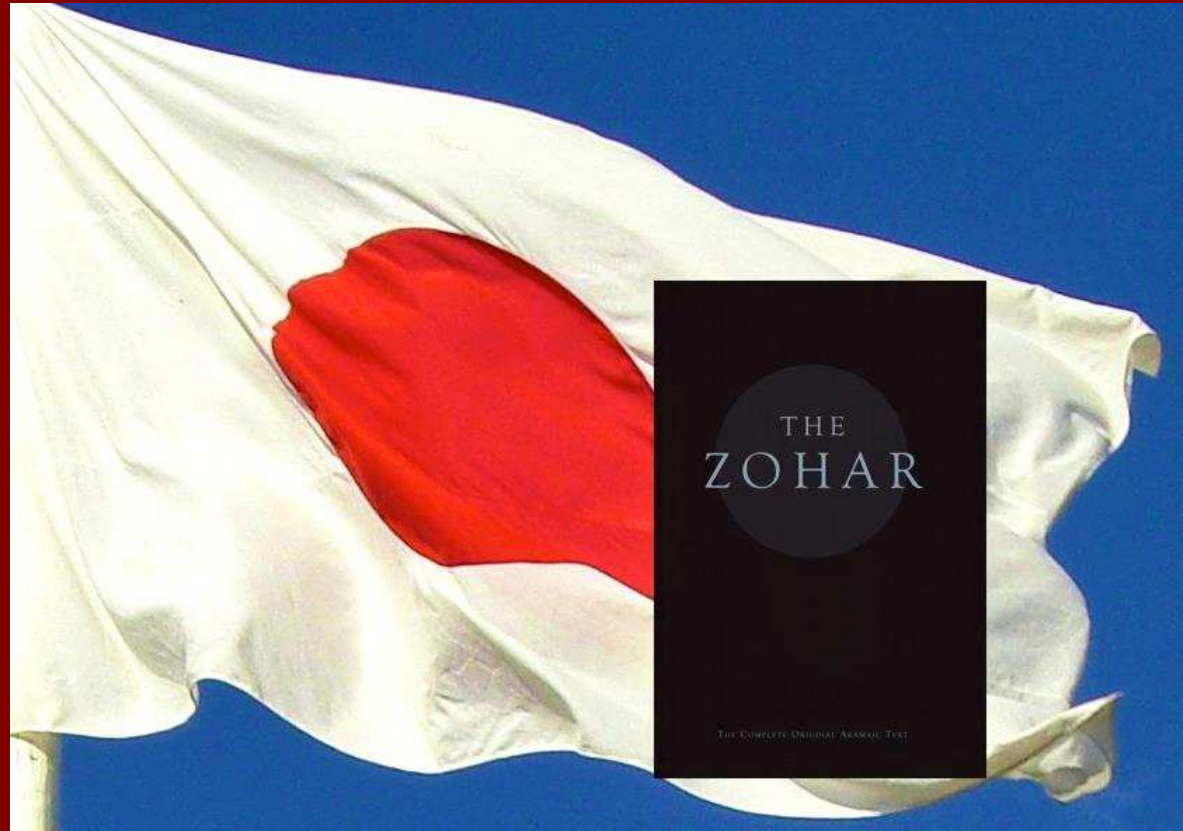

My experiences

since I started with the Zohar Project are:

- ➡ the right consciousness is very important when you get in contact to prepare the delivery of the Zohar. You need to connect to the energy of the Zohar
- ➡ as more consciousness you put inside to share the Zohar, the more you get connected to the light force.
- ➡ the more light you reveal the more difficult is getting your life, we have to let the things go that stop our connection to the light
- ➡ you have to move on, especial when it's getting difficult for yourself
- ➡ our way is difficult because we don't let the light inside in the right way.
- ➡ If you get really involved in sharing the light, you get the certainty to do the right things and the light is protecting and helping you
