TORNADO WATCH: conditions are favorable for severe thunderstorms to form, but it also means that a few storms may be capable of producing a tornado.

TORNADO WARNING: a tornado is either occurring or imminent based on radar.

WHEN A WATCH IS ISSUED:

- ❖ Text/Call is issued to all Emergency Coordinators
- ❖ Immediately secure individuals in police custody in lockup

WHEN A WARNING IS ISSUED:

- ❖ Text sent to all personnel on duty
 - All officers must contact commander

- ❖ Immediately secure Duty/Visitor Log
 - Each unit is responsible for their log

- ❖ Assist civilians to a safe room
 - Instruct to protect from flying debris

- ❖ Lockup is a safe room
 - Instruct those in custody to protect from flying debris
