Chapter 1 The Traveler

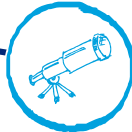


I developed a diverse perspective by being raised in a Mexican-Jordanian household

One of the several hundred business cards I had to order as a real estate agent. I still keep extras in my car in case somebody needs real estate advice.

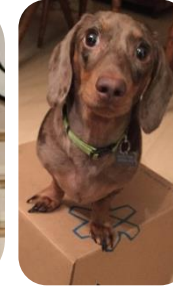
Chapter 4 The Family Man
