Visit the Rizzato family's fully operational apple packing shed then on to meet the cheesemaker at Stanthorpe Cheese. Back to the Queensland College of Wine Tourism for a cooking demonstration with Chef Drew and a lesson in food and wine matching with the wine maker Peter Orr whilst enjoying the regional, seasonal signature dish of Varias Restaurant, Medley of Mains.

After a facilities tour, join the apprentice chefs on the lawns for an interactive canapes competition and sit back for an enjoyable night under the stars with entertainment and event ideas.
