## Scholarship/Fellowship Opportunities:

- **The Conference of Asian Pacific American Leadership (CAPAL)** is now accepting applications for its summer Scholarship & Internship Program. The Scholarship program provides a stipend for students who are doing an unpaid government or non-profit internship in DC, and the Internship program provides students the opportunity to be placed in a federal agency for an 8-10 week internship. Both programs provide \$3,500 stipend.
  - **Eligibility:**
    - Only currently enrolled students are eligible for an internship or scholarship through CAPAL. Only applicants with a 3.0 GPA or higher will be considered. All majors are encouraged to apply.
    - **Priority deadline to submit applications is Monday, February 22. Final deadline is Monday, March 7.**
