

I'm selling this 2000 Dodge Neon. I've got a clean rebuilt salvage title for this vehicle. Last tested a month ago, the vehicle is in running condition.

Besides the cosmetic, rust, and door damage visible on this vehicle, the rear brakes do not work and the battery needs a jump and likely a replacement. A recent inspection suggested that the following work be done:

- Install new battery
- Clean terminal ends, install new battery, retest system for proper operation.
- Perform drum brake reline service
- Remove and install new brake shoes and drums, clean and replace hardware as necessary.
- Complete brake fluid flush
- Remove old fluid, install new brake fluid.
- Drivers window diagnosis and panel removal and installation
- Install new wiper blades
- Mount and balance 2 tires
- Dismount tires, inspect/clean rims, install new valve stem, reinstall new tires to rims.
- Power steering flush
- Remove old fluid, install new fluid.
- Remove and replace lower ball joint(s)
- Remove wheel assembly to access ball joints, remove ball joints from lower control arm, install new ball joints, reassemble everything.
- 4 wheel alignment

Extra notes from that inspection:

- Front brake rotor is rusted.
- Brake pad life 10mm.
- Muffler very rusty and brittle, will need replacement soon.

My notes:

Interior: The interior is in decent condition. The console sports a CD deck. According to another mechanic, the Freon line for the air conditioner got cut by one of the belts. The air conditioning does not work. The driver's side window cannot be rolled down. I believe it broke when I tried to roll it down too hard in the cold.

Exterior: This car got in some scrapes and one collision. There may be hail damage on the roof. The driver's side, above both wheel wells and across the doors, got scraped and dented. The passenger side's rear door got scraped and dented, as well. The front driver side door and the rear passenger side door both close but do not seal completely with the frame of the car. Some paint seems to have peeled off the top of the roof and the outside of the top of the trunk. The tires may need to be filled up again.
