- Early Childhood Special Education birth-gr 3
- *minors are completely optional, NOT required

After you have decided your major and whether you want a minor for an additional certification...

You must choose the pathway you want to take classes through before your junior level classes begin!

Pathways to Certification

Traditional Pathway

- Free standing 2 and 3 hour methods classes
- limited practicum jr year
- Flexible Schedule
- Senior year Senior block + full-time student teaching
- Open request for preferred student teaching location

Clinical Pathway

- Integrated Methods courses in blocks
- Each block is completely field embedded
- Fixed Schedule
- Senior year Full year
 experience in the same school
 with one semester full time
 student teaching
- Request from a specific list of primary partner districts

Admission to Teacher Education

- Complete 36 hours of college credit with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 and professional education GPA of at least 3.0
- Complete specific courses with a "C" or higher
- Pass all sections of the MO General Education Assessment (MoGEA)
- Complete a satisfactory background check
- Get departmental recommendation

Study Abroad

- If you wish to study abroad, you must plan to do so early in your college career. ECEL majors are professional licensure programs for Missouri and you will not be able to take any courses abroad that count for MO certification requirements.
- Study abroad is about the **EXPERIENCE**, not just the coursework.
- Short-term study tours are also available (like our spring break trip to Sweden)
