The Academic Resource Center (ARC)

• The ARC provides opportunities for students to become more fully integrated into the rich and diverse culture of the university. Peer tutors provide one-on-one writing support for papers in any class and lead a wide variety of writing workshops. Student Psychological Services (SPS)

Student Health Center (SHS)

• SHS is a full service medical office with a health care team that includes physicians, nurse practitioners, registered nurses, an x-ray technologist, and trained support staff. The health center can be found next to the fitness center.
