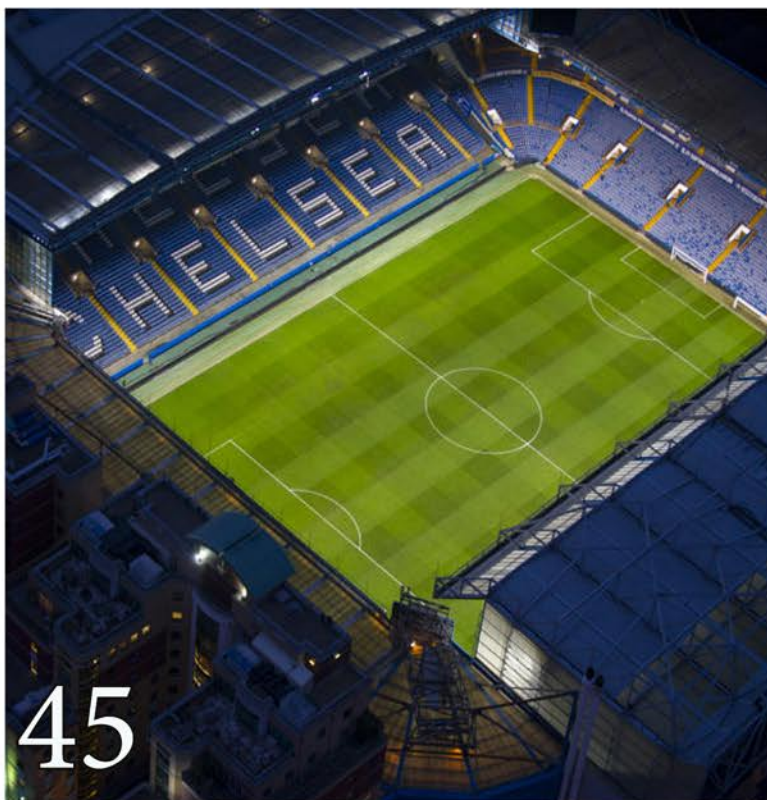

LIVING WITH POWERS YOU DON'T USE



He was praying in a certain place, and when he ceased, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray... (Luke 11:1-4)

After scoring a stunning goal, Diego returned home from the football field when his dad and the family lawyer were discussing an issue about "his father's will". After taking a bathe and having his dinner, he sat beside his dad on the sofa, "as my only share of your inheritance, I will like you to teach me how to write", Diego said to him.

Beaming with shock as though he has just seen a purple cow, "you are my favorite child and the closest one to me, why ask for that? Ok, lets just say you are being humble, why not ask me to teach you how to drive so you can have my Ferrari?" His father responded.

"Dad we both know it was through the sales of your books and magazines that you made your fortune. So, please keep your Ferrari, leave me the garage with a shelf and some books on it. Give me the pen that came with the keyholder, teach me how to write and soon I will be just like you, even greater", Diego said.

The dialogue between Diego and His dad is the same type that occurred between Jesus and His disciples. The disciples were the closest ones to Jesus, they saw Jesus walk on water, they saw Jesus turn water into wine, they saw Jesus cast out demons, they saw Him heal the sick and even raise the dead and when an opportunity came for them to ask for something, all they could ask for at that moment was "LORD, TEACH US HOW TO PRAY."

Is that not amazing that the closest ones to the Son of God (matter of fact, God himself) could ask for that? Couldn't they have said "Lord, teach us how to walk on water, so we don't have to wait for the boat anymore, we will just walk right through; Lord, teach us how to turn water into wine; better still, teach us how to multiply food, so we will never have to worry about hunger anymore, we just double the ones we have." They didn't say any of these, instead they said "LORD, TEACH US HOW TO PRAY".

It is just like living in a hut, when you know it is possible for you to live in a duplex. Even if these disciples were totally retarded, their request to Jesus, is a revelation that Prayer is essential and that it will be impossible to define our relationship with God

without it.

The Secret Weapon of a born again believer, is his/her daily communication with God. THE POWER OF CHOICE

In everyday of your life, you will be involved in taking decisions concerning your life, and every choice you make has consequences. That's the reason why it is advised that before you make decisions about your life, it is good for you to seek counsel, for the bible says "*in the multitude of counselling, there is safety*".

Seeking counsel does not necessarily mean you must come to a Pastor. If you have one, go to Him, but if you don't, there are elders and people out there who must have passed through the same road which you are in now. Therefore, in order for you to make an informed and positive decision in life, you must seek counsel.

CHOICE suggests that you have alternatives, and that you are only picking one and leaving the other.

ILLUSTRATION

When you are making decisions, if you don't weigh the consequences, you may not be able to cope with the consequences when they come. *Imagine a marriage between a tall man and a tall lady. If God grants them children, how do you think the children will look like? They will be like those who play basketball in the United States: Very Tall. Now, imagine a marriage between a short lady and a tall man, how do you think the children will look like? Some may be like the lady, some may be like the man or the average between the two of them: the consequence of that decision. Also, imagine a marriage between a fair lady and a fair man: the children may end up being albinos.*

At the point of making a decision

on any of them getting married, they probably did not weigh the consequences of their children. It may not occur to them how their children will look like.

If all they ever wanted in their marriage is to have beautiful kids, when the opposite starts happening, how do you think they will feel? Therefore, it is important you know that life is all about choice, and every choice you make, has consequences.

There are three major decisions you will have to make in life:

1. Where You Will Spend Your Life after Death?
2. Who to Marry?
3. Career Choice?.

CHOICE ON WHERE YOU WILL SPEND YOUR LIFE AFTER DEATH

Is it with God in Heaven, or with Satan in Hell? This is the greatest decision you will make in life, whether to serve God or to serve the devil? It is a self-driven decision, a decision that will affect everything about you in life, your values, attitudes to life and even your career. It will decide and shape what will become of you thereafter. Therefore, if you have not taken this decision, it means you have not started life and once you take it, beware that it has consequences.

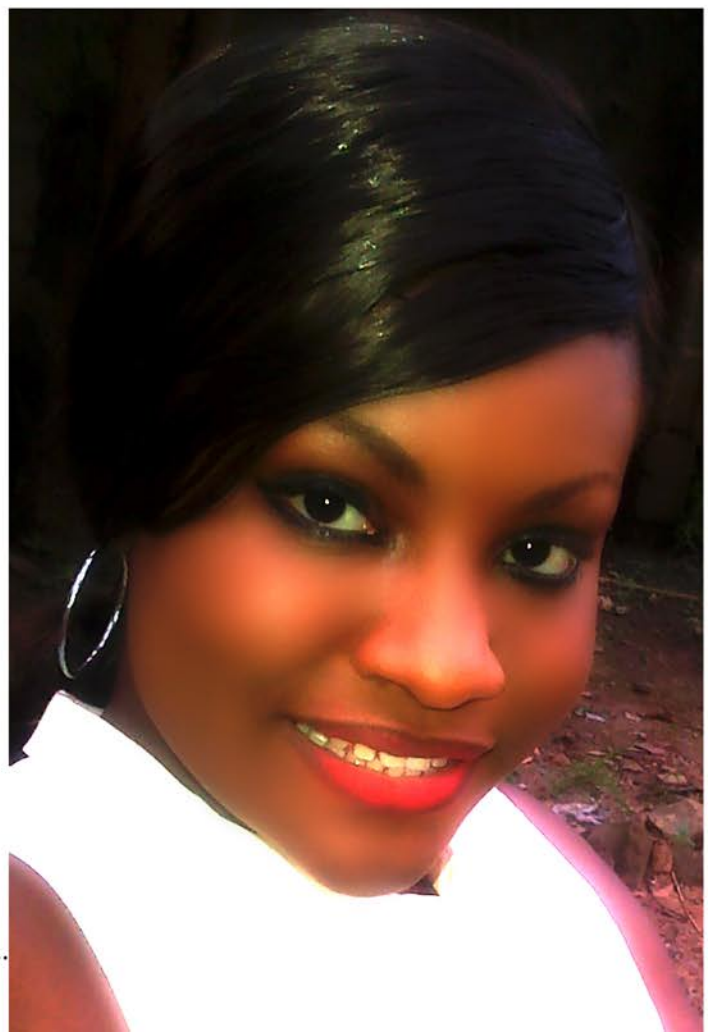

A simple, reserved but strong person who isn't afraid to speak her mind and likes to encourage people. She also loves cooking, giving, praying and most importantly service to God and humanity.

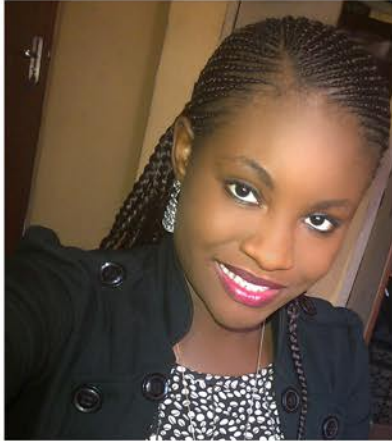

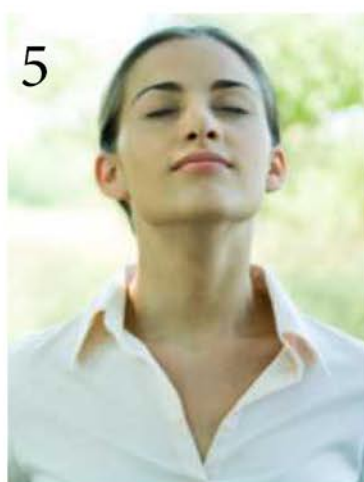
10. Doing something for hours, then returning to your phone and finding it full of text messages and missed calls.

WELCOME TO THE WHITE HOUSE

Every nation has one pocket where the President, his friends and families hangout. Tourists stroll by to gawk at the sights. In the modern society, the whole structure of the White House is known for that kind of lifestyle.

Located in Washington DC, and portrayed as one of the most protected building on the planet, the White House is the official home of the no. 1 citizen of the world, the President of the United States of America

168 feet (51.2 meters) long, & 85feet 6 inches (26.1 meters) wide without porticoes; 152 feet wide with porticoes, the White House has an overall height(to the top of the roof) of 70 feet on the South and 60 feet 4 inches on the North.

It takes 300 gallons of white paint to cover the exterior of just the residence portion(centre), excluding the West and East wings.

The White House has 132 rooms, including 16 family-guest rooms, 1 main kitchen, 1 diet

kiitchen, 1 family kitchen, and 35 bathrooms. Excluding storage rooms, it has 10 rooms on the **Ground Floor**, 1 main corridor, 6 restrooms. 8 rooms on the **State Floor**, 1 main corridor, 1 entrance hall; 16 rooms, 1 main corridor, 6 bathrooms, and 1 restroom on the **2nd floor**; and 20 rooms, 1 main corridor, 9 bathrooms on the 3rd floor.

The White House has 412 doors, 147 windows, 28 fireplaces, 8 staircases, 3 elevators (main, pantry and a lower-levels elevator under the Grand Staircase

A floor area (total of 6 floors approximately 55,000 feet), a tennis court, a basketball court, a putting green, a bowling alley, a movie theatre, a jogging track, a swimming pool, the White House indeed, is an amazing and world-class building.

Secret Service Code ("Olympus") for the White

House, which is being led by a very President Kennedy-esque Benjamin Asher (Aaron Eckhart). But the true lead actor in this constantly gripping tale is Gerald Butler (Mike Banning), who was once the Secret Agent assigned to protect the President and His family, until a tragic event led him to be transferred to a pedestrian Secret Service job in the Treasury Department.

As the very convincing assault on the heart of Washington D.C and the White House itself occurs, Banning finds himself again thrust into the central action and quickly becomes the sole hope of saving the President and preventing a potential nuclear disaster that would end American life as we know it.

Banning has the physical skills and mental cunning that allows him to become a virtual one-man army against a phalanx of single-minded killers out to destroy America by cutting off her symbolic "head": the President himself.

The special effects in "Olympus Has Fallen" are superb. It truly looks like the destruction depicted onscreen has actually occurred, but when everything is said and done, Olympus Has Fallen is simply just another breath-taking movie, because the White House is still in tact, the State Security Service agents still alive and security still unbridged.

It is almost impossible to attack and take over the White House. It will be a suicide mission, not different from strapping a bomb on yourself and pushing the button.

It is almost a given belief that the White House is the most secure place in the planet, possibly in the universe. But when a North Korean terrorist plot can be executed with frightening precision - circumventing the seeming impenetrable defenses surrounding the U.S President and everyone around him - it calls for a moment of silence.

That's the premise of "Olympus Has Fallen," the well-crafted political thriller from Antoine Fuqua. This film's title comes from the fictional

STRUCTURE OF THE WHITE HOUSE

The White House is divided into the East Wing, West Wing and the Residence. The West Wing being the center of activity generally serves the Presidency, the East Wing serves as office space for the First Lady and her staff, including the White House Social Secretary, White House Graphics and Calligraphy Office and correspondence staff, while the Executive Residence is the home of the President of the United States.



WHY IS THE WHITE HOUSE WHITE?

It has nothing to do with the burning of the house by the British in 1814, although every schoolchild is likely to have heard the story that way. The building was first made white with lime-based whitewash in 1798, when the building of its walls were finished, simply as a means of protecting the porous stone from freezing. Why the House was subsequently painted is not known. Perhaps Presidents objected to the dirty look as the whitewash wore away.

The house acquired its nickname early on, when Congressman Abijah Bigelow wrote to a colleague on March 18, 1812 (3 months before the United States entered war with England). In his words "There is much trouble at the White House, as we call it, I mean the President's House" (quoted in W.B. Bryan, "The Name White House", Records of the Columbia Historical Society 34-35 (1932):308).

At various times in history, the White House has been known as the "President's House; the Executive Mansion, but the name "White House" though in common use, remained a nickname until September 1901, when Theodore Roosevelt made it official.

BUILDING OF THE WHITE HOUSE

In 1791, George Washington working with artist and engineer Pierre Charles L'Enfant, selected the site for the White House. The cornerstone was laid in 1792 and a competition design submitted by Irish-born architect James Hoban was chosen. After eight years of construction, President John Adams and his wife, Abigail, moved into the unfinished house in 1800. The total cost was \$232,372.

But however, on August 24, 1814, during the war of 1812, British troops burned down the White House in retaliation for an earlier burning of Canadian government buildings in York, Ontario, by the United States.

James Hoban was appointed to rebuild the house, and President James Monroe moved into the building in 1817. The White House requires 570 gallons of paint to cover its outside surface.

ADMIN

The Chief Usher is in charge of keeping the house running smoothly. He has a staff of 90 workers to assist him: a head housekeeper, five full-time chefs, & numerous maids, butlets, carpenters, plumbers, gardeners, and engineers.

With the 5 full-time chefs, the White House kitchen is able to serve dinner to as many as 140 guests and hors d'oeuvres to more than 1,000.

The White House receives approximately 6,000 visitors a day, or 2,190,000 visitors a year.

SECURITY DETAILS

Extensive security measures are used to protect the White House. Security is primarily provided by the United States Secret Service. Since the September 11, 2001 attacks, the restricted airspace above the White House has been expanded and better enforced, especially with the installation of an automatic weapon called "HYDRA" loaded with missiles, always ready to automatically shoot down any flying object that is considered a threat, once it is within range.

Barricades are also built on the streets surrounding the White House, with well-trained Secret Service agents scattered all over the building, from the roof to the ground floor.

Most of them, even after realizing that a particular fashion will soon fade away, still waste their money over it. Costly articles of clothing are often discarded, only because the fashion trend has faded away. Girls, especially educated ones, are the worst offenders of this respect. They are crazy over ornaments of latest designs and other beauty aids which happen to be popular at a given time. Often, the entire family has to suffer. Owing to their craze for fashion, many family discords and quarrels may be traced to this tyrant.

On the other hand, setting good trends promotes creativity and imagination. Youths who set fashion trends can gain confidence and a personal sense of style that others would often want to emulate. Setting fashion trends during the youthful age can be a serious challenge among peers and family members who follow traditional style rules. However, creating new and good trends could bring the rewards of respect. Trendsetting teaches youths to create new looks of things without spending too much money. Fashion trendsetting involves imagination and creativity, something as employing new styles in craftworks like bead making, hairdressing, confectionaries, dress-making, and also media/ graphic designs. Things like these can start a fashion craze that is inexpensive, original, easy to find and hard to fade. Setting attainable trends can teach the youths to make and use their money well. A youth who sets new and good trend may be interested in becoming a buyer for a major department store. A career as a buyer brings the reward of successful trendsetting with a salary.

Moreover, one can conclude by saying that the influence of fashion on the youths has so far not been encouraging owing to its misuse. Looking at the other side of what fashion could possibly be, youths can develop a different perspective about fashion. Therefore, rather than spending so much on the latest wears, youths could also employ the concept of fashion into useful activities like work(eg. Arts and designs) that could positively profit their lives.

Are You Raising a DAVID OR A PHARISEE

As a Christian parent, your automatic response to this question is likely "a David." After all, God called David a man after His own heart. Which Christian parent wouldn't aim for that?

However, if we examine this question a little closer, some of us may find that what we really want is something else.

WHO WERE THE PHARISEES?

Pharisees have quite a reputation among the Christian community. We associate them with legalism, rigidity and pride - and rightfully so. But if you were alive in Biblical times, you might have a whole different take on them. In Jesus's day, Pharisees were among the most respected religious leaders. They were righteous, law abiding...as close to perfect as you could get. Even Paul referred to his former life as a Pharisee as "faultless" (Phil 3.6)

WHO WAS DAVID?

David on the other hand was a bit of mess. He lusted. He committed adultery. He purposely deceived. He arranged a murder. He called for a census in direct opposition to God's command. And he did absolutely nothing when one of his sons raped his daughter, Tamar (see 2 Sam 13). This was the man after God's own heart? THIS IS WHO WE SAY WE WANT OUR KIDS TO BE LIKE?

THE KEY DIFFERENCE

By all intents and purposes, the Pharisees were perfect. They did everything "right". They tithed, they followed God's law to the letter, they prayed. In effect, their lives were completely devoted to God. On the outside they looked good, godly and holy. That is what everyone around them saw. In fact, if you lived back

then, you might have said, "Gee, I wish I could be more like the Pharisees. They have it all figured out."

But that is not what Jesus saw. He saw through the facade, right into their hearts, and that their hearts were in bad conditions. For that reason, He called them hypocrites. The key difference between the Pharisees and David was the condition of their hearts. David's heart was messy and unkempt, at times full of his own desires, but at times, emptied out before God for Him to fill. David's heart had room for God, softened by the remorse over his sins (see Psalm 51:4). The Pharisees, on the other hand, had hearts filled with their own righteousness - filled so full that there was no room for God at all. Their hearts, like their behaviours, were polished into a shiny and impenetrable shell.

IMPLICATIONS FOR THE CHRISTIAN PARENT

We may say that we want Davids, but do we really? Are we concerned more with behaviour that is right or with hearts that are right? Do we fear sin in our children? Do we worry about what our children's behaviour says about us as parents? Are we concerned about how our children appear before man or how they will stand before God?

We can insulate, indoctrinate and regiment our children's spiritual journey by restricting what they see, read or hear. We can control their prayer time, devotional time and behaviour. All of this may produce a "good" Christian child - one who might make other parents think, "Gee, their kids are so good - they have it all figured out". But without a focus on the heart, we may end up raising Pharisees (people whose hearts have no room for God) instead of Davids (people whose hearts have room for God, softened by the remorse over their sins).

PARENTING THE HEART, NOT BEHAVIOUR

Would you say that most of your parenting interventions focus on your children's behaviour - either what they are doing or what they have done?

Behaviour is what we can see, so it tends to be what we respond to most. While focusing on behaviour might be effective in the short term, we need to dig deeper if we want to have an impact on our children's spiritual development. Let's start digging with the best tool available: God's Word.

In 1 Samuel 15, God gave Saul a clear instruction through the prophet Samuel: wage war against the Amalekites & completely destroy them and their belongings as punishment for their wickedness against His people. Saul goes out, fights, wins the war and brings back the king of Amalekites and the best of the plunder.

God pronounces a judgment on Saul, stating that his kingdom will be removed from him because of his lack of complete obedience. To paraphrase, Saul replies, "But God, I saved all the good stuff for you!" God's

answer is not what Saul expects. God replies "To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams. Because you

have rejected the word of the Lord, he has rejected you as king."
(vs 22-23) .

God didn't want the sacrifices. He didn't want the burnt offerings off the plunder. He wanted Saul's heart. But He didn't have it. God cares about our Heart- the intent behind our behaviour. Whose interest do we have in mind - ours or God's?

We are judged not because of our behaviour, but because of what our behaviour reveals about our heart. Behaviour is much easier to see, so it is much easier to discipline. But if, as Christian parents, we ignore the heart behind the behaviour, we miss an opportunity to shine the light of God's love into the dusty, dark corners of our children's hearts.

HOW TO PARENT THE HEART

The very best tool that you have available to affect the hearts of your children is not a method, intervention or tactic. It can't be summed up in a chart, a reward system or a list of consequences.

The secret to parenting the hearts of our children is to focus on our own hearts.

Saul's army didn't obey because his heart was not devoted to God. Likewise, we cannot lead our children in the ways of God if our hearts are not seeking after the Lord. Assess the condition of your own heart. Evaluate your motivation for doing what you do. Live your faith out loud right in front of your kids - not a polished, candy-coated faith, but one that is worked out with fear and trembling amidst the hills and valleys of life.

Our heavenly Father cares about the heart - it stands to reason that as Christian parents, we should too.

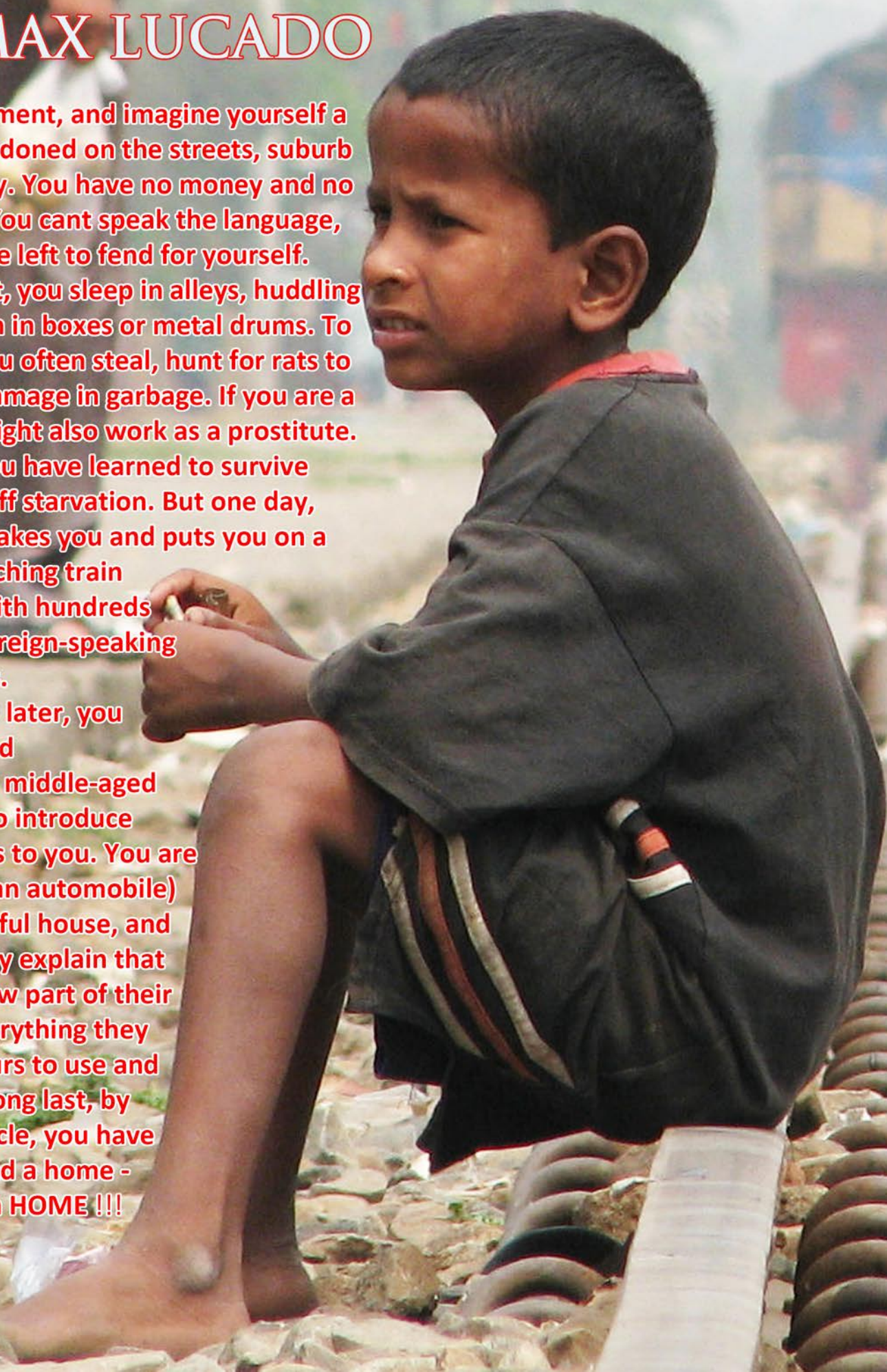
"For the Lord sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the Heart." 1 Samuel 16:7

But one day, someone takes you and puts you on a smoke-belching train jammed with hundreds of other foreign-speaking youngsters.

Three days later, you are selected by a kindly middle-aged couple who introduce themselves to you. You are driven (in an automobile) to a beautiful house, and they quietly explain that you are now part of their family. Everything they have is yours to use and enjoy. At long last, by some miracle, you have a family and a home - and what a HOME !!!





All through my years of ministry, every now and then, I have been hearing of "**UNPLANNED PREGNANCIES**", but one thing I haven't heard of before is an "**UNPLANNED ADOPTION**". When couples go for adoption, they don't do it unconsciously, they do it with an understanding of selfless love that they are going to take care of that child, cost what it may. God does the same for us, He seeks, and then He adopts us. He signs the papers if you will, and then He brings us home.

It is a wonderful thing that Jesus lets us to be servants in the kingdom. It is a wonderful thing that Jesus lets us be soldiers in the army of God. It is a wonderful thing that Jesus invites us to be worshippers in the heavenly worship, but **nothing can be more wonderful in the simple fact that you are called and you can be a son and a daughter of the Almighty God.**

That's the highest title you can ever have in the whole universe. This only should give you enough confidence to face and conquer all obstacles in life. God has chosen, **not just to save us, but to adopt us.** It would have been wonderful for Him just to save us, we would have never complained, but it wasn't enough for Him, He chose to adopt us.

WHY DID HE ADOPT US

Few years ago, I was speaking in another state. A lady approached me after the message and said "can I call you when you get back to San Antonio" and she did. She explained to me that her pregnant daughter was seeking a home for an unborn child. Did I know anyone in our congregation who is looking to adopt? Well I did. So I put her in touch with the family and I took a front row seat as the drama unfolded. I watched the joy, the resolve in the eyes of the father

and the determination in the eyes of the mother, they will travel as far as it took, and spend whatever was necessary. They wanted to adopt that child, and they did. Only moments after his birth, the baby was placed in their arms. And this is no exaggeration, that mum and dad smiled for a month. Everytime I saw them, they were grinning; even in the parking lot, they were smiling; walking down the street, they were smiling; I think I could have preached the sermon of the agony of hell and they would have still smiled the whole time. They just smiled. Why were they so happy? Why did they adopt that child? They had a good life. They were financially stable. They were happily married. They were gainfully employed. What did they hope to gain? Did they adopt the baby so they could get an extra sleep, or extra cash? No, they knew they will lose both, the minute they brought

that baby home.

Why did they adopt that child? Why do people adopt children? As you are formulating your answer, can I tell you why God adopted us?

Ephesians 1:3-5 (TLB)

Long ago, before God made the world, God chose us to be his very own. Through what Christ would do for us; he decided then to make us Holy in his eyes without a single fault, we who stand before Him covered in his love.

*His unchanging plan has always been to **adopt us** into his own family by sending Jesus Christ to die for us. And he did this because He wanted to.*

God adopted us simply because He wanted to, not because you were good looking, not because He needed your money, not because of your skills, or your wisdom. Isn't it something to know that the motivation for your adoption as a Son of God really has nothing to do with you, but everything to do with God? That he just adopted you because He wanted you, he wanted you in His family.

To be adopted into a family is not the work of the person being adopted. Adoption works because the parent takes the initiative.

Parents don't go to the orphanage and say "we want to adopt somebody, help us find a kid that has a lot of money, or help us find the smartest of your kids or help us find a kid that will not give us any trouble". A good orphanage will tell those parents to leave, because the success of the adoption depends on the parents, not upon the child, **THE CHILD DOESN'T HAVE ANYTHING TO OFFER.**

God knows all these, but still, He adopts you. Will you receive Him today and say, "Lord I want you to be my father". He has done everything necessary to take you home. All you need to do now is to manifest your identity as the son of God, by living a life in accordance with the word of God.

GOD AS OUR FATHER

After dying for your sins, and in the spirit of adoption, Jesus has invited you to call God "father". So what does a father do? He hears us when we cry, He holds our hand, he gives us words of exhortation and sometimes words of correction, He leads us, and when we step quickly or into dangerous intersections, it is His job to pull us back. He walks us across the street, He walks us through difficult times. And then there are occasions, just out of the love he has for us, he lends down and He picks us up and He carries us

to the next level. Why not pause for just a second, before anything else happens, Will you let God be your Heavenly Father? If you let Him, he is going to bring glory out of the ashes of your struggle, out of the fumes of your disgrace, and out of the dismay of your predicaments in life. God is going to bring glory in your life. But right now, He is calling you to repentance.

MANIFESTING YOUR IDENTITY

Even if you don't remember anything I have said, I want you to remember this: "you are and can be a Son and a daughter of the Living God. That's the highest Identity you can ever have in the whole universe. This only should give you enough confidence to face and conquer all obstacles in life, and it is your mission on this earth to manifest that Identity, by living a righteous and holy life in everything you do. We live in a perverted world, where everything has been turned upside down, but however, as the Son and daughter of the Living God, you must live a life that is harmless, lameless and without rebuke. A life that is not compatible with SIN, a life connected to Heaven, which is the only path to achieving greatness in life. The only way to achieve this is to let the Word of God rule over you. Read your Bible daily, meditate on it day&night, put everything you have read into practice, & your life will never remain the same.



Final Goodbyes

Take a moment, on your own, ask yourself, what does that word "goodbye" mean to you? From the day you came into this world, and as you grow old, it is a word you are going to learn how to say and express, whether you like it or not. Nothing on this green earth lasts forever. All over this world, every now and then, people say goodbye to many things, to a friend on a visit, to their jobs, to their properties, but the most painful is the Final Goodbye to a loved one who has died.

If you know what it is to weep, if you know what it means to have the kind of pain that feels as if you cannot be comforted. If you know what it means to be at the end of a rope and feel like your life is over and you got questions that cannot be answered, and you are confused, then you will agree with me that grief over the lost of a loved one is not something you shake off easily. I listened in horror to the news of the death of a teenage girl, who was hit by a bikeman, on her way back from purchasing her birthday

goodies. What a tragedy! Her mum was inconsolable, because nothing in this world can ever explain a mother's pain when her child drops dead, especially in the most unusual circumstances.

DEATH IS INEVITABLE

It is almost a given belief that strong men of God will only die at a very ripe age, possibly in their 90s. But when Dr. Myres Munroe and his wife were confirmed dead after a plane crash - it calls for a moment of silence. Questions then arises to where God



was when that plane crashed? Well, the same place He was when John the Baptist was beheaded, same place He was when Stephen was stoned to death, same place He was when the 12 disciples were executed, and even, same place He was when His only begotten son was crucified.

This sums up the fact that irrespective of who you think you are, DEATH IS INEVITABLE. But however, a person who is close to God can, in one sense, look forward to death, as Paul did (Phillippians 1:21-24). But what he or she is really looking forward to is not death itself, but waking up with a new spirit body in God's kingdom.

IT IS PART OF LIFE

When you grow older in life, things get taken from you. That's parts of life. Therefore, losing someone (a friend or family) to death is a stage in life, which you must pass through. Right from the point you were born,

you will see people come and go, you will see people being born and die, you will stand over the cold graves of people you loved, and drop hot tears. No matter how much you pray and believe God, you will have to release people who were dear to you. You will say goodbye to people, and not understanding why they died, what seems like untimely, unnatural and unfair deaths, you will deal with many troubles and adversities, but if you trust God, if you TRUST GOD, He will strengthen you to overcome these pains, for the bible says that "those that sow in tears shall reap in joy". (Psalm 147:3) says that God heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

God is the greatest source of comfort. He alone knows our hearts and also how best to help us. When we are grief-stricken, if we will talk to God and read His Word, we will experience great comfort, hope and healing.

Prayer and Bible study are two things we need to do every day in our lives.

Ecclesiastes 7:2-4

It has been said, "An open casket can be worth a thousand sermons". When you think of someone's else's death, it's an important time to think about your own life and inevitable death, and also think about your relationship with God. Because when it is all said and done, what matters most is not how, or when you die, but where you are going to wake up in the after life: In God's Kingdom or Satan's Kingdom, it is your call to make.

2Peter 3:11

No man knows his time of departure, therefore it is necessary to get prepared and stay prepared. Yes! Jesus is coming soon, but don't get it twisted! To everybody who encounters death, to that person, Jesus has come! DO YOU KNOW WHY? Because after death, comes Judgment. Think about this!!!

The **problem** with Christians today is that they are born again by faith, but they don't walk by faith, in handling the issues of life. They are carried away by what they see happening around them. YOUNG PEOPLE ASK!

1. MUST I HAVE A GIRLFRIEND? IF NOT, HOW DO I CLEAR MY MIND OF THE FEELINGS I HAVE FOR A GIRL?

The world has taught us to follow our hearts (feelings), but God warns us that our hearts (feelings) are deceptive and cannot be trusted (Jer. 17:9). The world has also taught us that when we feel lonely, then we should begin to seek intimacy with the opposite sex. However, you must know that "loneliness is not the absence of affection, but the absence of direction". The truth is, when you discover God's purpose (direction) for your life, your feelings for that lady will change drastically. A young lady's greatest need is someone who would point her to God so she can fulfill God's purpose for her life.

The world has made ladies seem like mere sex objects that desire nothing but intimacy and sex. This is far from the truth. Song of Solomon 2:7

"Oh let me warn you, sisters in Jerusalem, by the gazelles, yes by all the wild deer. Don't excite love, don't stir it up, until the time is ripe and you're ready".

As a young person/teenager, you have a lot to occupy yourself with, a relationship is not yet part of your itinerary. Let God prepare you first. When He is through with you, you will be ready. The most important thing for you at this phase of your life is to serve God whole heartedly and trust Him to take care of your future. There is so much work to do in God's kingdom and God requires your full attention (see 1Cor 7:32-35)

3. WHAT IS REALLY THE BASIS FOR A GOD- KIND OF RELATIONSHIP? IF YOU'VE HAD A FAULTY OR SINFUL FOUNDATION ALREADY, WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

I'm sure by God-kind of relationship, you mean a relationship that honours God. For a relationship to honour God, it has to first be inspired by Him. Is it God that is leading you or simply your fleshly passions? (Romans 8:5-8).

Secondly, your motive must be right. Are you ready to get married and therefore seeking a relationship or are you just playing the "dating game" when you know marriage is still very far from you? The only relationship that makes sense to God is one that is gotten into by two

people (a man and woman) who are ready to get married (Proverb 24:27).

Thirdly, both partners must be determined to please God at all cost. Kissing, sex, smooching, etc are completely out. The focus is not your bodies but your souls. Making heaven and maturing spiritually must mean more to you than exploring how your bodies feel.

Once you have discovered that you are building on a faulty (sinful) foundation, the remedy is very simple. Tear down the building and start afresh with God. Pleasing God and making heaven must always be the focus of your life. Jesus says:

Matt. 5:29-30 (GNB)

"...if your right eye causes you to sin, take it out and throw it away! It is much better for you to lose a part of your body than to have your whole body thrown into hell..."

What would it profit you if you gain your relationship and lose your soul? Save your soul first and God will take care of the rest. You are better-off pleasing God than pleasing your partner. **DO NOT PLAY WITH YOUR SOUL.**

Your time as a single is very precious, don't throw it away because of the pleasures of this life. Occupy your mind with God and consecrate your heart to Him afresh. This will help you forget about the relationship and to focus on serving God. When you are ready for marriage, you will know.

4. IS IT WRONG FOR A CHRISTIAN TO LISTEN TO SECULAR MUSIC?

Secular music (songs with wrong messages) is not designed to entertain you, but kill your fire for God (Rom 8:6-8). It quenches the Holy Spirit and makes you ungodly (1 John 2:15, 2 Tim 2:16, James 4:4). The presence of a desire for secular music in a Christian is actually proof that the devil is attacking your faith. It's not possible to experience the presence of God and still desire or enjoy secular music (see 2 Cor 3:18, Matt 13:44-46)

People say sometimes that Christian songs are boring or too slow or not cool. That is not true at all. It's just a lie propagated from the pit of hell. Worthy of note are songs by young people (like you and me) affecting lives for Christ. Foreign gospel artists like Deitrick Haddon, Tye Tribett, Da truth(rap), Lecrae(rap), Britt Nicole, Tobymac, Mali Music, etc and Nigerian Gospel Artists like Nathaniel Bassey, Promise Benson, Preye, Solomon Lange, Sinach. Godly music transforms. It helps to build you up and draws you closer to God in your daily life.
