

HELP SAVE OUR SEA TURTLES!



These structures are an eyesore and are having a negative environmental impact on our nesting sea turtles.

The beaches of Treasure Island are important turtle **nesting sites**. Each summer, threatened marine turtles migrate to our beaches to nest. Holes dug on the beach, and furniture left overnight can **disorient** and **trap turtle hatchings**, and can hinder the females from coming ashore to lay their eggs.

Other cities such as Madeira Beach have passed a **“Leave no Trace”** ordinance to deal with property left on the beach. To read this ordinance that was just passed in April 2016 please visit:
