- PRISM leaker: Edward Snowden's criticize NSA

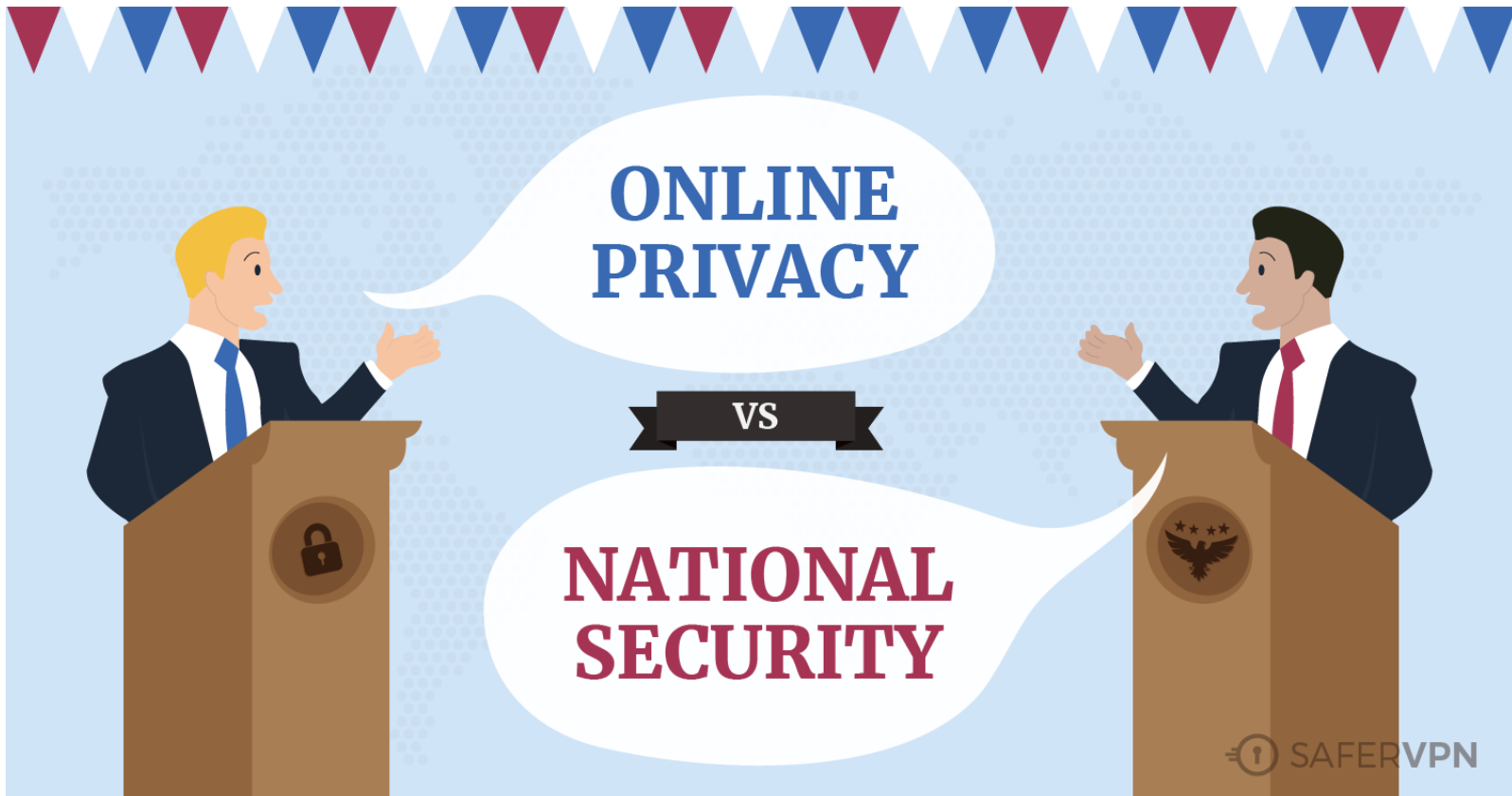

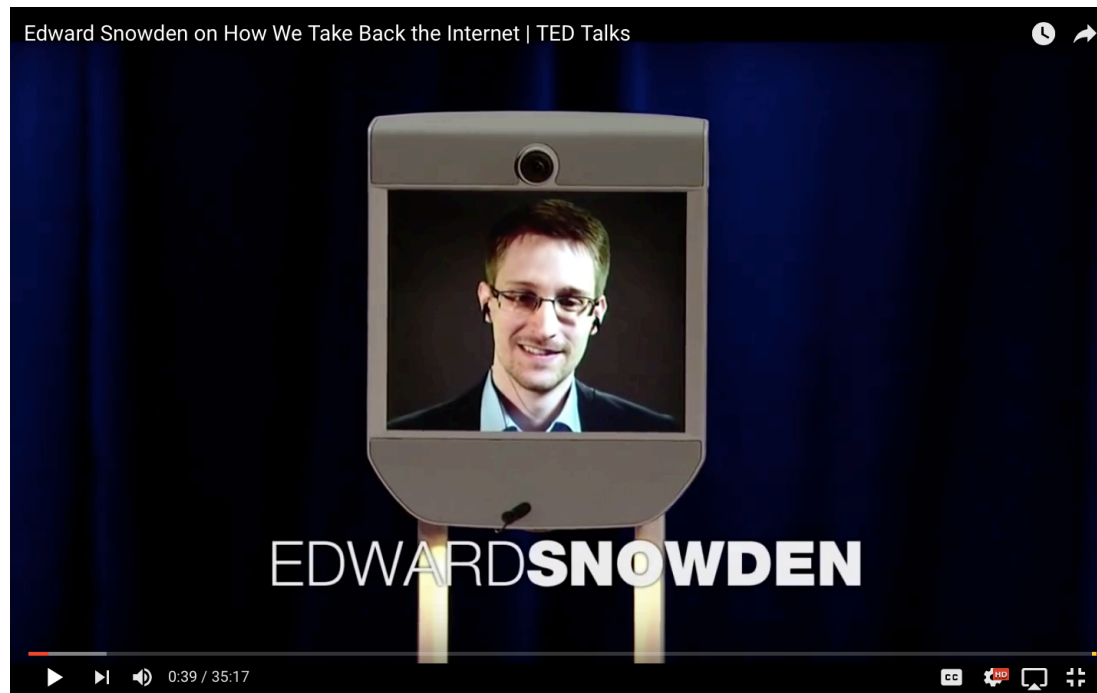
