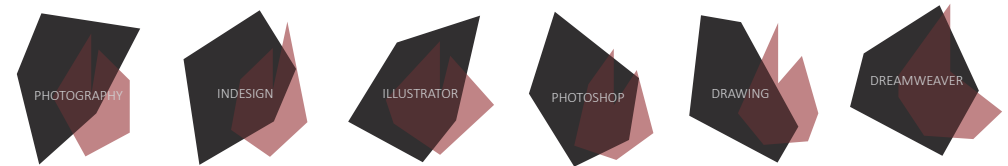

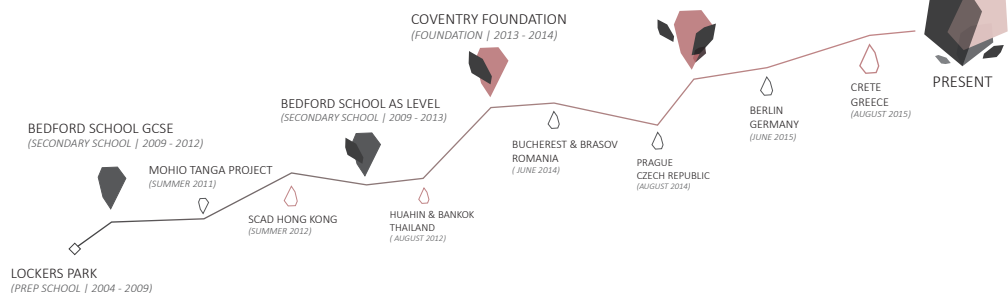
My multicultural background led me to having an open mind about new things with great acceptance. My depth of knowledge in design have expanded through past travels therefore I am very resourceful.
