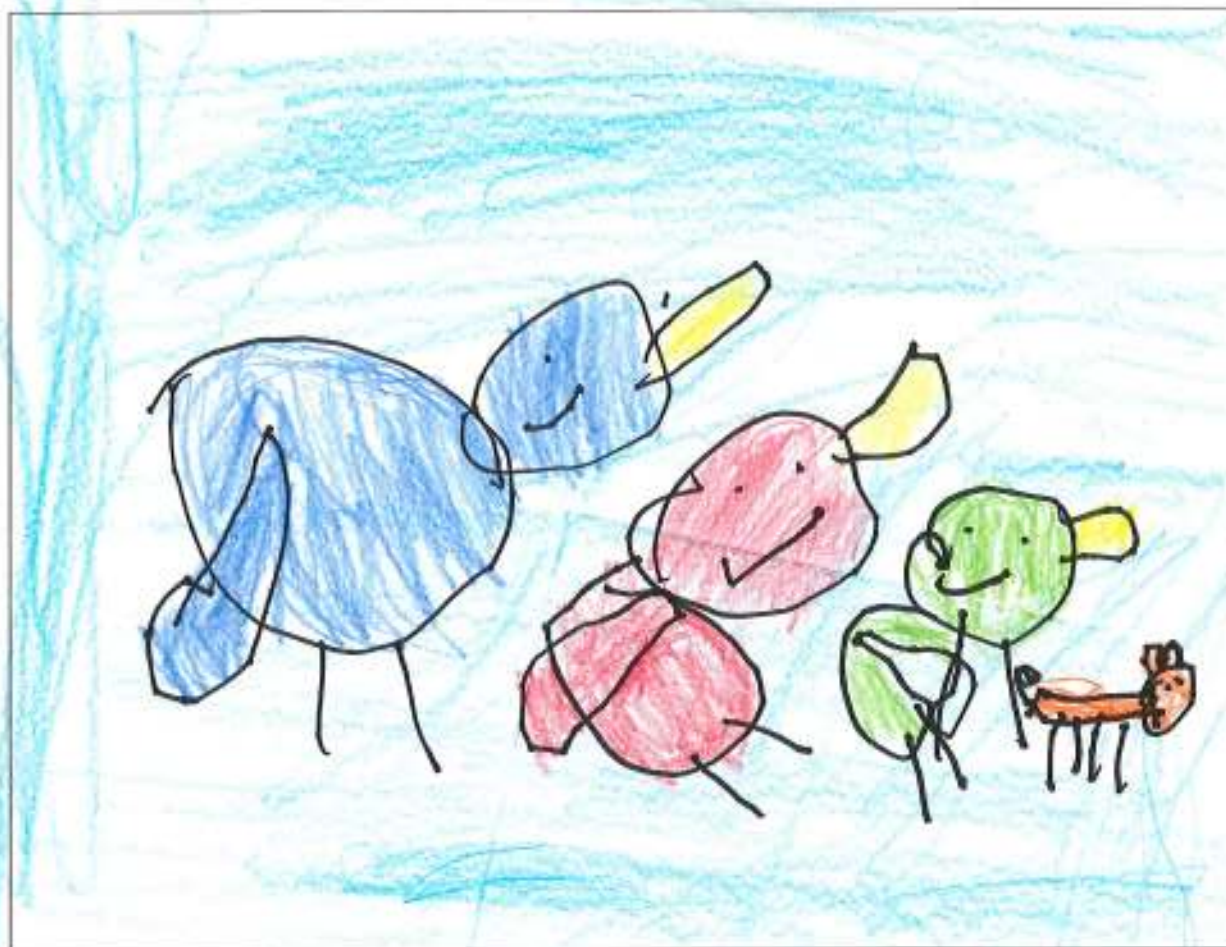


Goldifox and the Three Birds

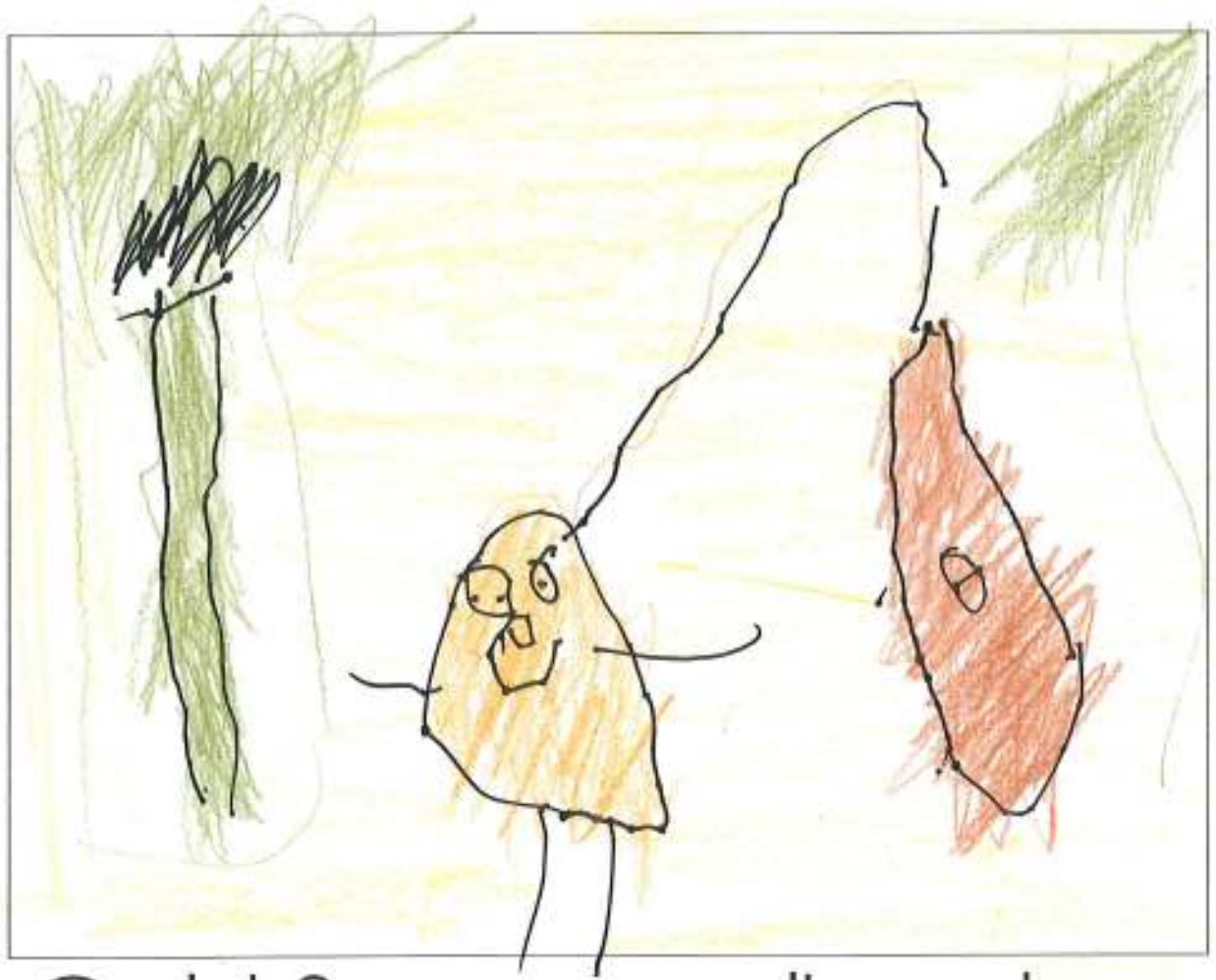
Once upon a time, in a

there was a giant house.



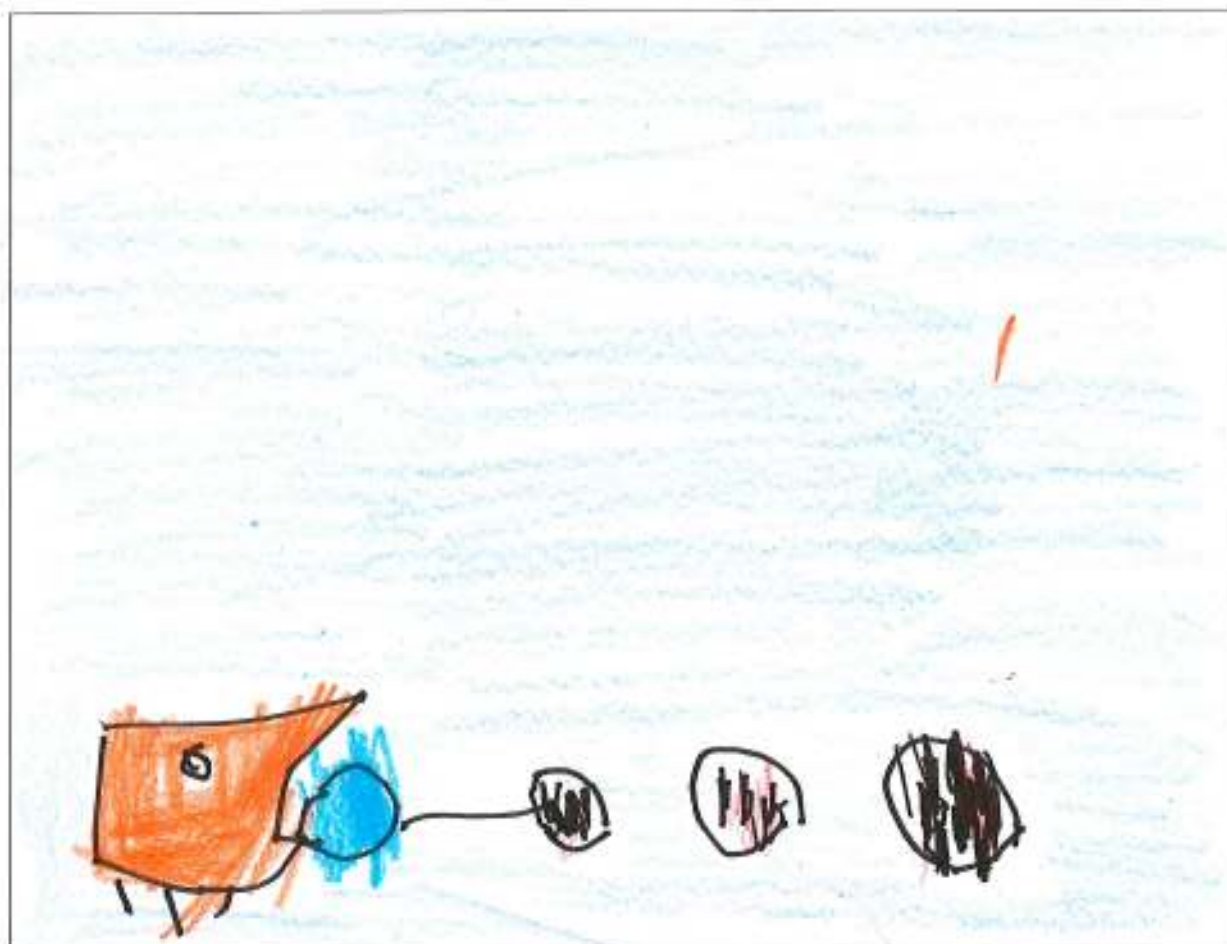
In this house lived 3

away.



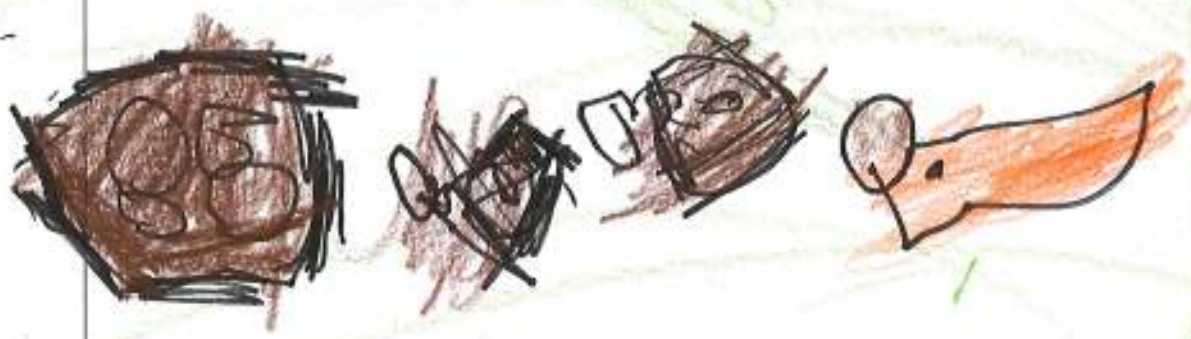
Goldilox was walking by

She saw the 3 bowls of worms. She tried the big bowl, but the worms were too squiggly.



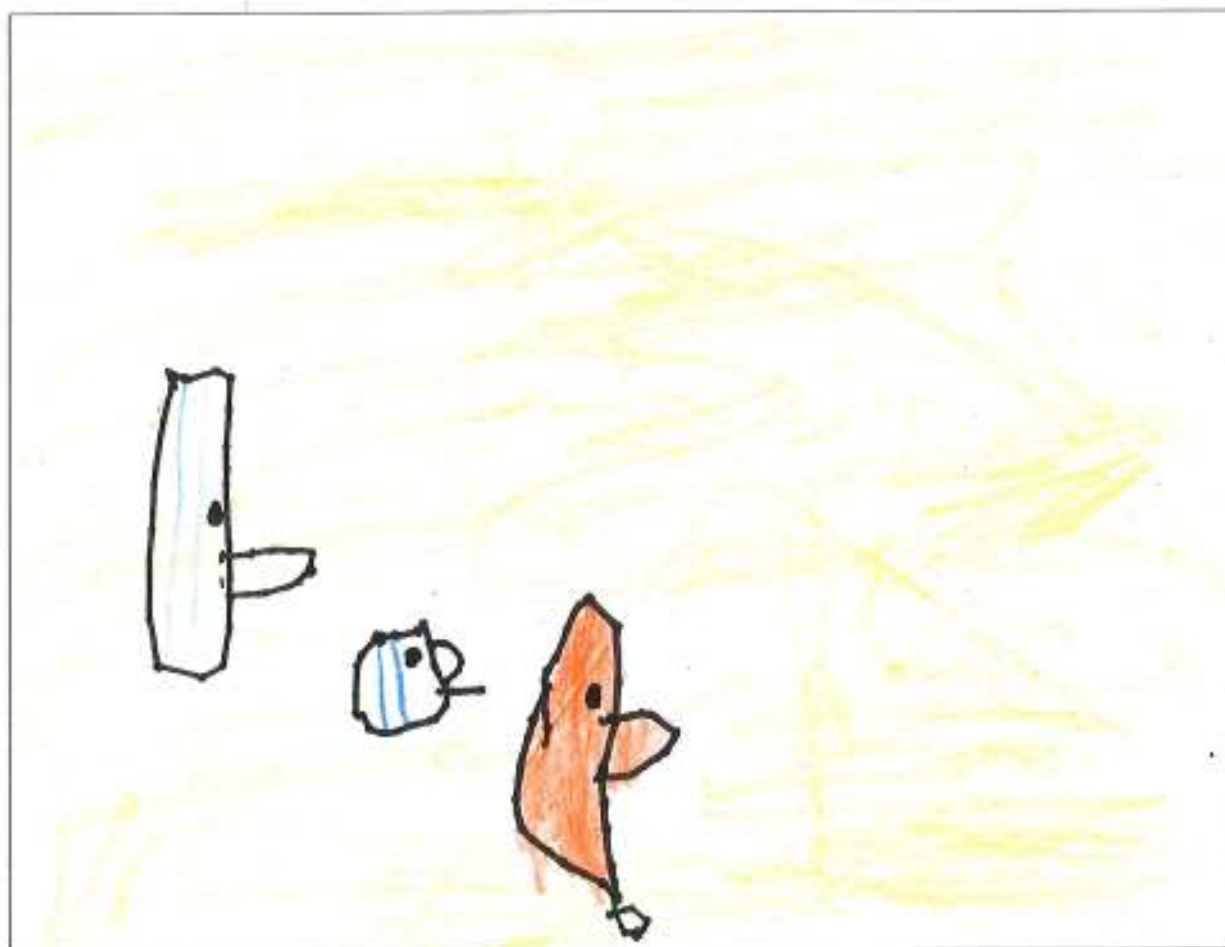
Goldilox tried the medium bowl, but the worms were too soft. She tried the small bowl, and the worms were just right! She ate them all.



Then she went into the living room and saw 3 nests. The big nest was too big!



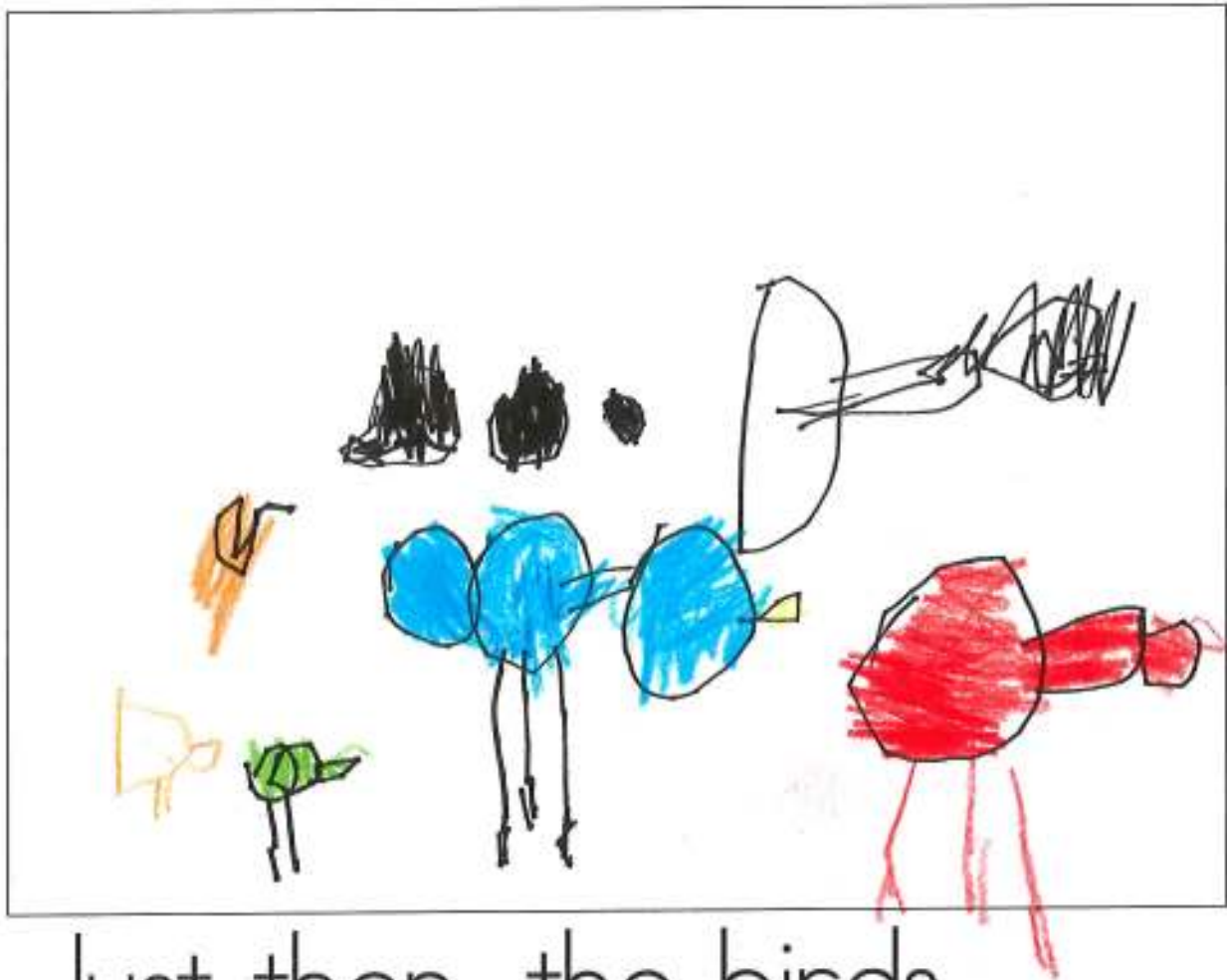
The medium nest was too comfy, but the small nest was just right. But Goldifox was too big and she smashed the nest all the bits!



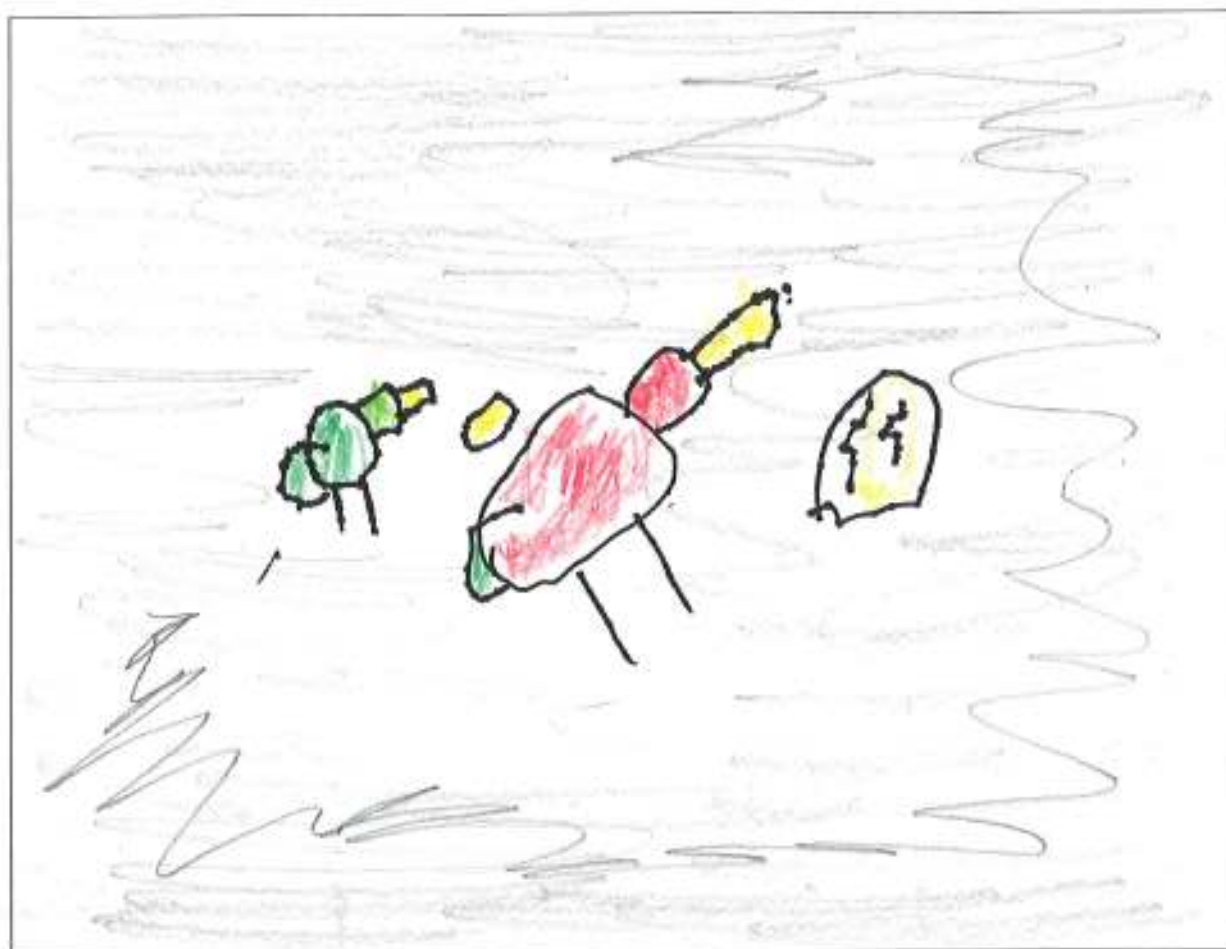
Then she went up to the

fast asleep.



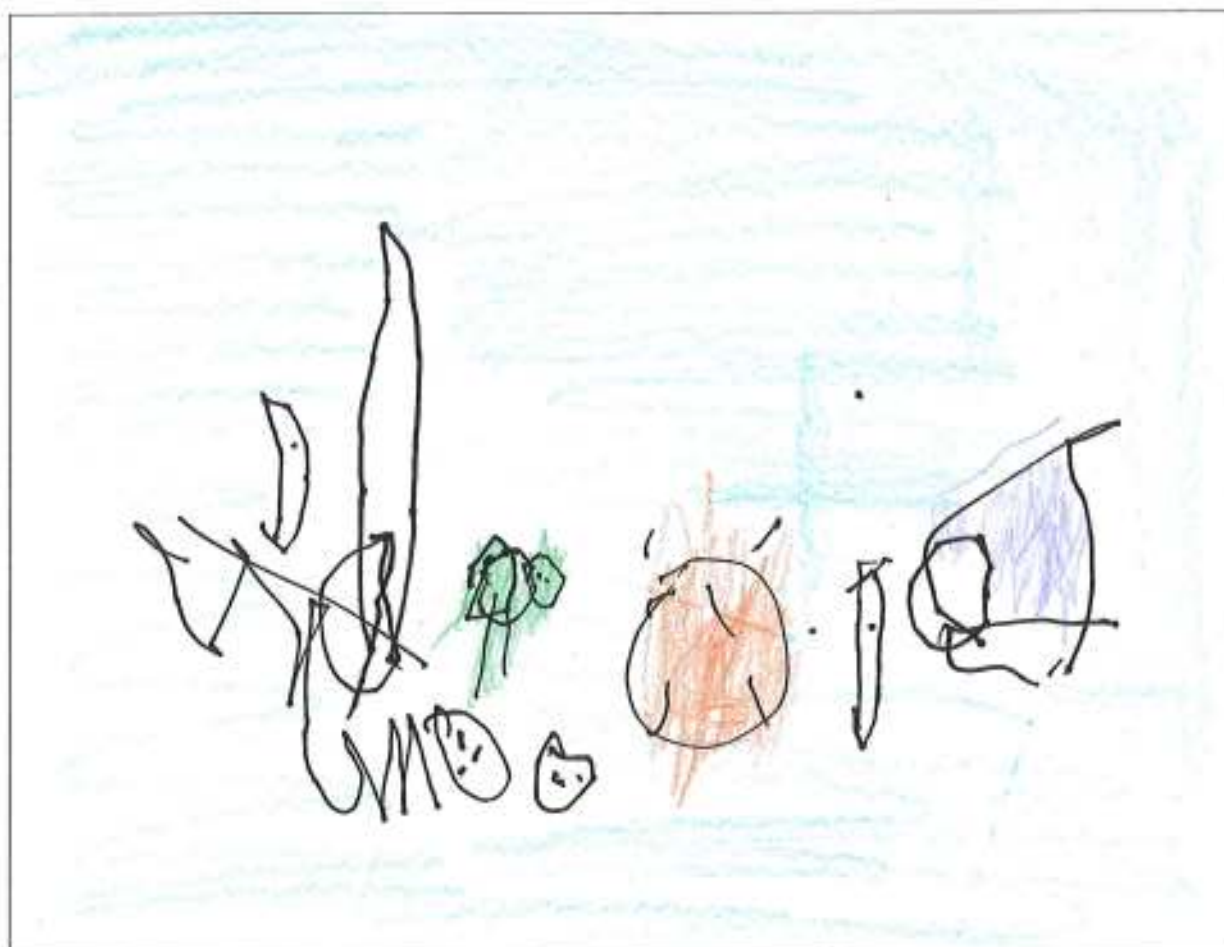
Just then, the birds
