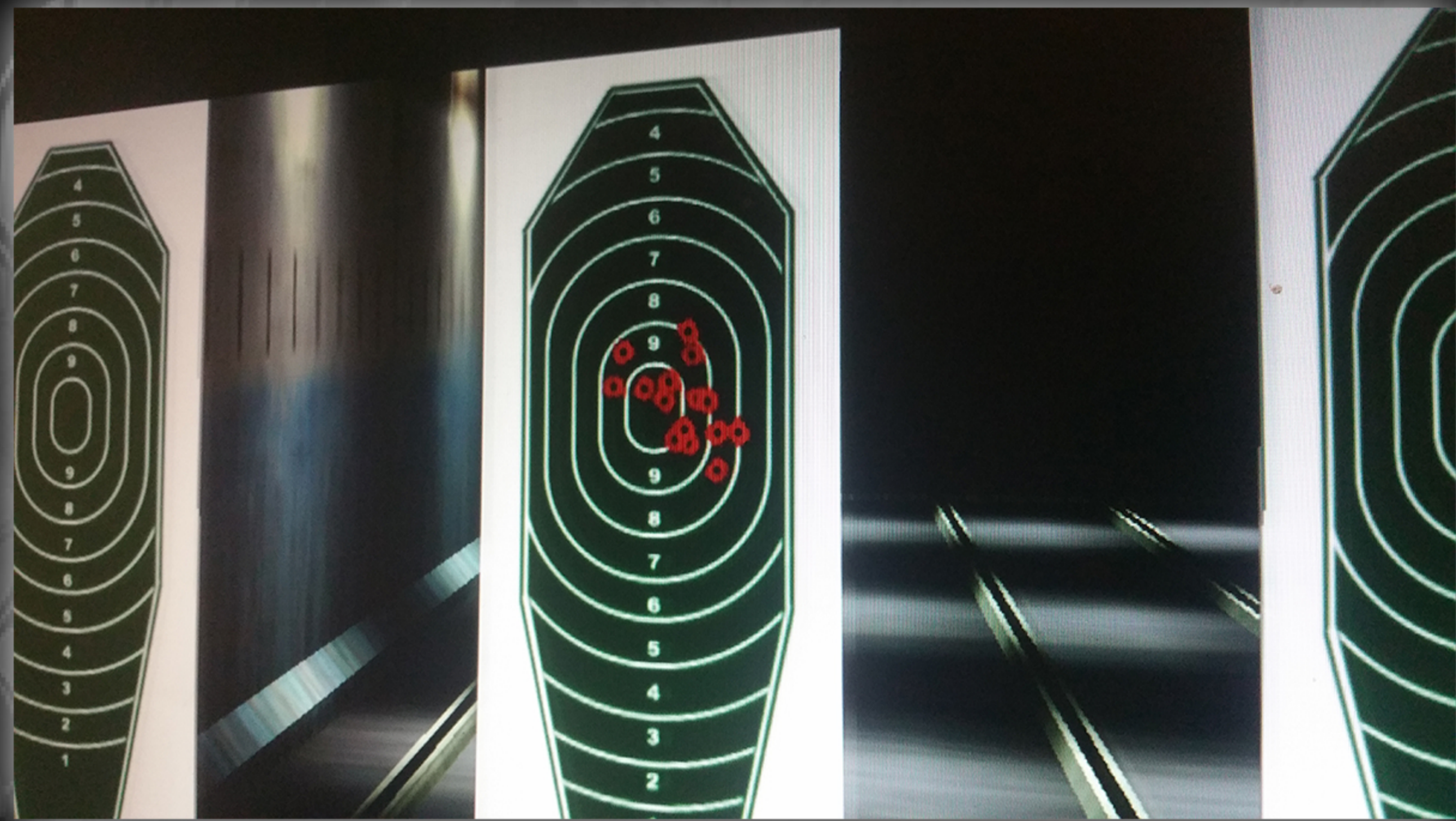

But how does it shoot?

Now down to the shooting, the rifle is satisfying to charge the bolt, its comfortable in your shoulder, has plenty of adjustment in the stock and cheek riser and over all feels very comfortable. The trigger can feel abit spongy at first but after a few rounds you get used to where the break is, allowing precise shots on human sized targets without having to guess where your break point is.



Here at JD have an amazing facility to test rifle accuracy up to half a centimeter on our interactive digital range system, however being a sniper rifle we weren't able to test this to its fullest capacity, but in our 10 meter range we were able to judge the grouping pretty well, direct out the box with no hop or tweaking the rifle had a very consistent grouping for a sportsline gun on a human sized target, no firing jamming or feeding issues.

Overall for someone who is just starting into the sniper role, or just wants to do abit of plinking in the garden, this gas/spring sniper is a great way to get into the hobby without spending a good chunk of cash just to watch your rounds fall at your enemies feet.
