enigma-noun: 'something that baffles understanding and cannot be explained', 'a difficult problem'

apathy-noun: 'an absence of emotion or enthusiasm', 'the trait of lacking enthusiasm for or interest in things generally'

indifferent- 'adjective: 'marked by a lack of interest', 'showing no care or concern in attitude or action', (usually followed by `to', 'or indifferent', 'fairly poor to not very good', 'having only a limited ability to react chemically; chemically inactive', 'marked by no especial liking or dislike or preference for one thing over another', 'characterized by a lack of partiality', 'being neither good nor bad', 'neither too great nor too little''

revere- 'noun: 'American silversmith remembered for his midnight ride (celebrated in a poem by Longfellow', '1735-1818', a lapel on a woman's garment; turned back to show the reverse side', verb: 'love unquestioningly and uncritically or to excess; venerate as an idol', 'regard with feelings of respect and reverence; consider hallowed or exalted or be in awe of'

candor-noun: 'ability to make judgments free from discrimination or dishonesty', 'the quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech'

reticent-adjective: 'temperamentally disinclined to talk', 'cool and formal in manner', 'reluctant to draw attention to yourself'

aesthetic-noun: '(philosophy', adjective: 'relating to or dealing with the subject of aesthetics', 'concerning or characterized by an appreciation of beauty or good taste', 'aesthetically pleasing'

ascetic-noun: 'someone who practices self denial as a spiritual discipline', adjective: 'pertaining to or characteristic of an ascetic or the practice of rigorous self-discipline', 'practicing great self-denial'
