The Foreigners are coming! The Cockpit is supporting PSYCHEdelight by lending in-kind support to their comedy play, *Borderline*, made by and about refugees, and this year's **VOILA!** flagship show.

The Theatres are coming! We are delighted that other spaces are interested in joining **VOILA!** and very excited that the unique Conway Hall is presenting a show as part of the festival.

VOILA! is coming — with a welcoming, friendly, upbeat soiree to kick off the festival with a bang and a party on Wednesday 2nd Nov and the usual drink-up in the bar following Pulcinella on the last night on Saturday 13th. And in between, there'll be comedy, new-writing, classics, kids shows, improv, dance and film, in English, in French or both!

VOILA! And again VOILA! Le beat goes on. Le spectacle continue. All welcome. Passports not required.
