

Commander Rra'Saum, Twilight Fire of the T'au Sept'S Ta'Shiro. Years of infiltration, and focussed force operations deep behind enemy lines, and in cramped confined of space battle have honed Rra'Saum into one of the most efficient, and ruthless of the Tau command structure. Typically shunning the open field of battle, Rra'Saum leads his Kau'ui of Xv25-2's into some of the most dangerous, and vital missions for the Greater Good. Instead of opting for the increased mobility of a suit akin to Commander Shadowsun's Xv22, Rra'Saum pilots the prototype Xv85-2. Flung against the Grater Good's foes, Rra'Saum and his Stealth Cadre focus on eliminating high priority targets of the Gue'la, and Ork incursions on the third sphere.

SIGNATURE SYSTEM

XV85-2 Stealth Battlesuit: Created by the Kel'shan Sept to imitate the Y'vahra's power in a stealth chassis this experimental Battlesuit merges the power of an XV8, with the stealth technology of the XV25 to devastating effect

The XV85-2 Battlesuit confers a 3+ Armour Save. Like other Stealth battlesuits, the XV85-2 comes equipped with a multi-tracker (pg 122) and blacksun filter (pg 121).



For some foes, the only hint of danger is a slight sensor-ghost, or the unnerving feeling of being watched. For others there is no warning at all, before the world lights up with chattering burst cannons and hissing fusion blasters. Flickering out from amid their camouflage fields come the Tau Stealth Suits, their point-blank salvoes chopping enemy infantry to steaming offal and blowing their armoured vehicles sky high. Panicked wildfire flashes back at them, flying wide or rattling from the thick XV25 armour. In response, the Stealth Suits fire their jump jets to leap away, shimmering out of view in moments. Alternatively, activating homing beacons or markerlights, they may call down reinforcements or barrages of seeker missiles to annihilate the last of their prey without mercy. Trained under Rra'Saum, these warriors

modify their XV25's to suit each battle
