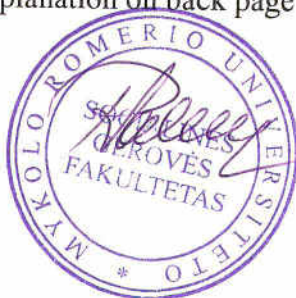

(2) **Until 1 September of 2011** Mykolas Romeris University **used** credit system, which allocated 1 credit point for **40 hours** of student workload. **Academic year** was equated to **40** Lithuanian credit points, **semester** – to **20** credits.

Credit points were also allocated to Internship (work placement) and/or research work as compulsory parts of the study programmes.

1 LT credit was equal to 1,5 ECTS credits.

From 1 September of 2011 Mykolas Romeris University **uses** credit system, which allocated 1 credit point for **27 hours** of student workload. **Academic year** is equated to **60** Lithuanian credit points, **semester** – to **30** credits.

Credit points were also allocated to Internship (work placement) and/or research work as compulsory parts of the study programmes.

1 LT credit was equal to 1 ECTS credits.

(3) Alongside the ten-point system Mykolas Romeris University uses the pass/fail system of evaluation. Examinations and work defence evaluations, as a rule, are graded. For the courses that do not end with examinations the pass/fail system is used to test if a student has earned the credits allocated to it. A student passes when he/she proves that he/she assimilated not less than 50 % of the required knowledge scope.

Table below provides a Grading scheme and grade distribution guidance:
