- Application form
- Financial aid form
- Recommendation Letter

### Eligibility

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S. (including DACA students)
- Currently enrolled as an **undergraduate** at a college or university in the U.S.
- Study abroad program must be eligible for credit at the student's educational institution
- Study abroad program must include at least 4 weeks (30 days) in country/countries



### Funding Amount

- up to **\$10,000** (Academic Year); **\$5,000** (fall/spring semester); prorated by no. of weeks, minimum **\$1,250** (summer)

- **Academically rigorous and immersive study abroad program**
- **Study of the host country language (if not English)**
- **Non-traditional destination**
- **Student demonstrates financial need**
