

Rhinoceros beetles are mostly relatively easy to medium difficult. Only relatively few species requires some more complex conditions for resring (usually some type of wood is unavailable or extraneous to the substrate for the laying of eggs.) Unfortunately, however, their development often takes several years. For beginners are very appropriate to the genera *Xyloteupes*, *Allomyrhina* and *Dynastes*. These houses are very attractive due to the size and easy of individual species.
