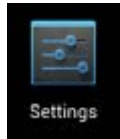


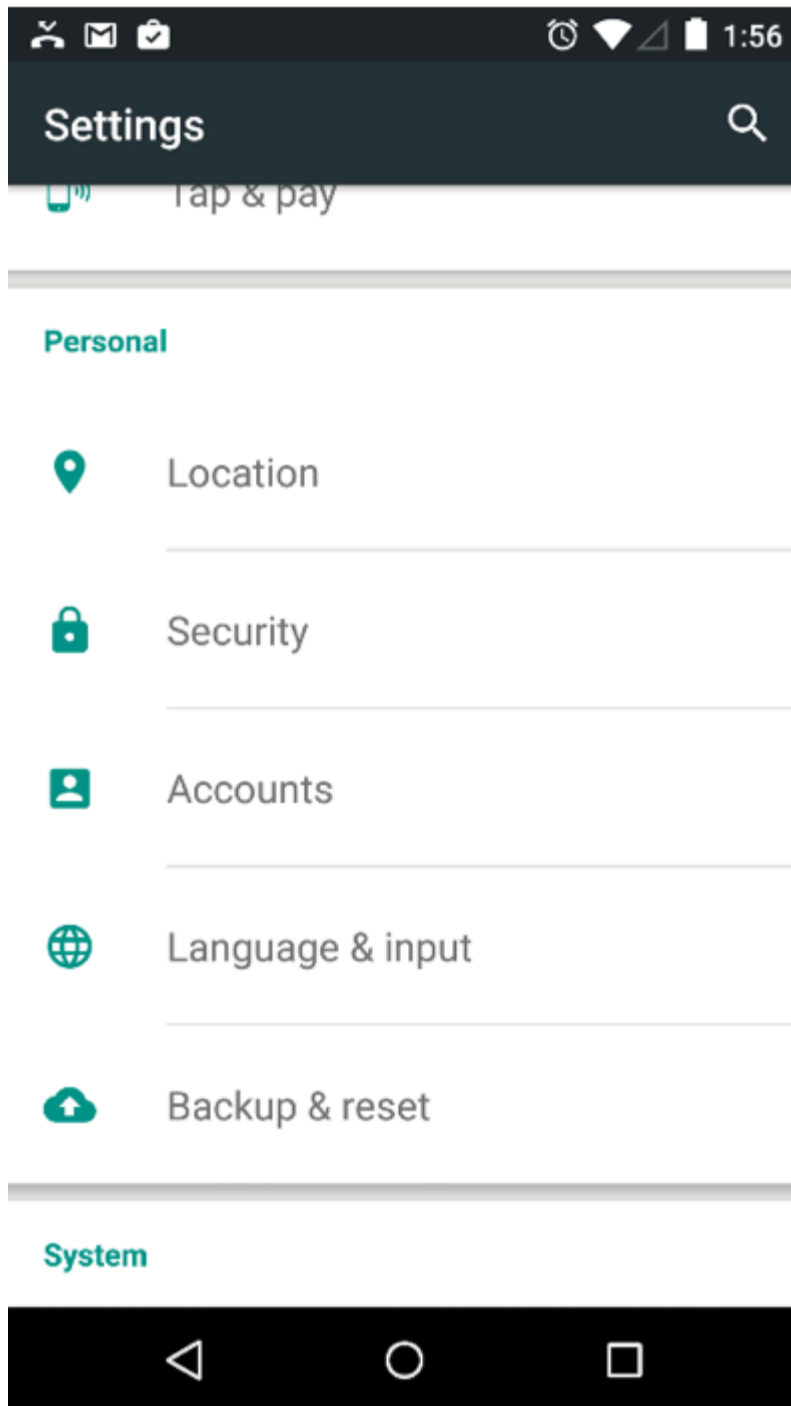
Android: Nexus (IMAP)

This is a setup guide that will assist you in setting up your Hosted Mailbox on Google Nexus mobile and tablet devices using IMAP.

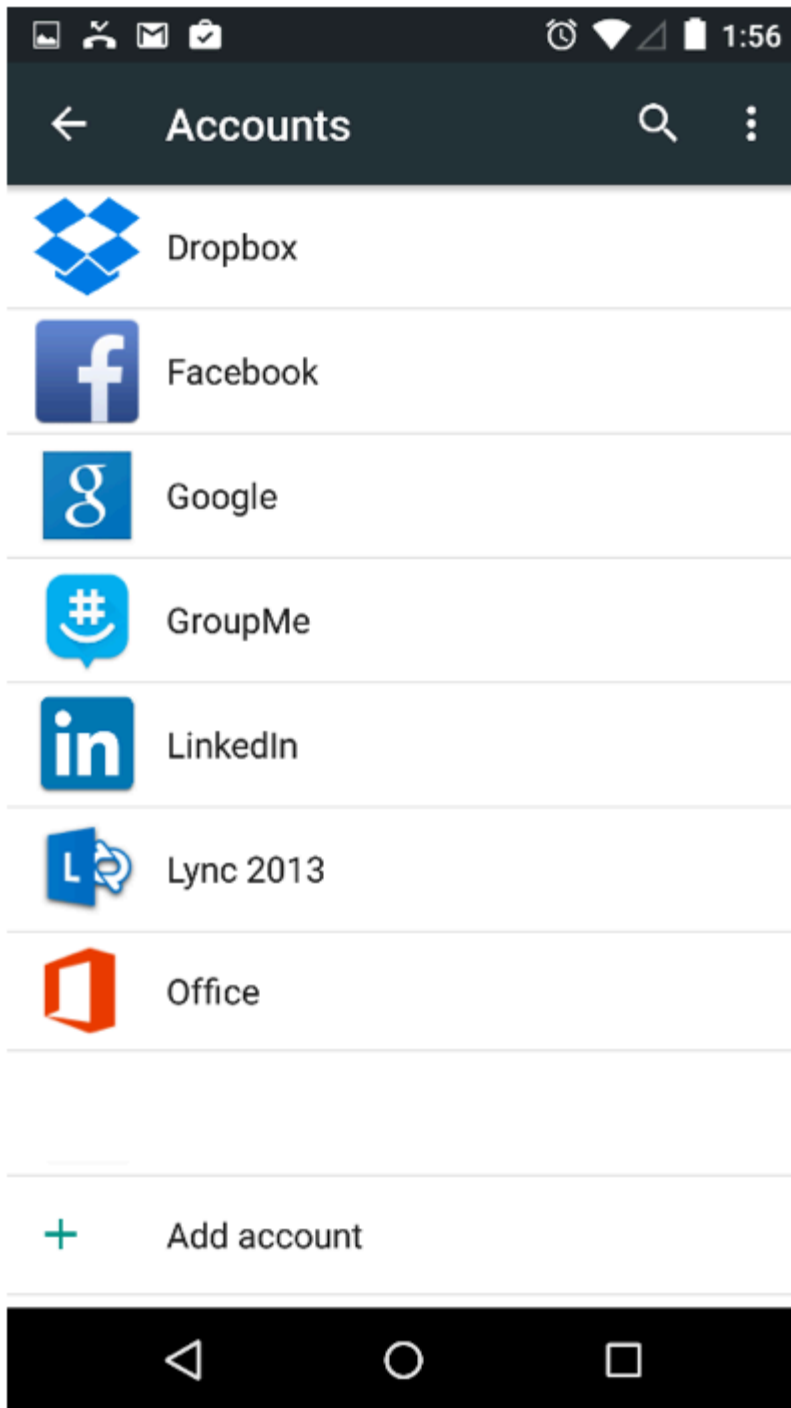
1. Locate the "**Settings**" icon within your Apps Drawer.



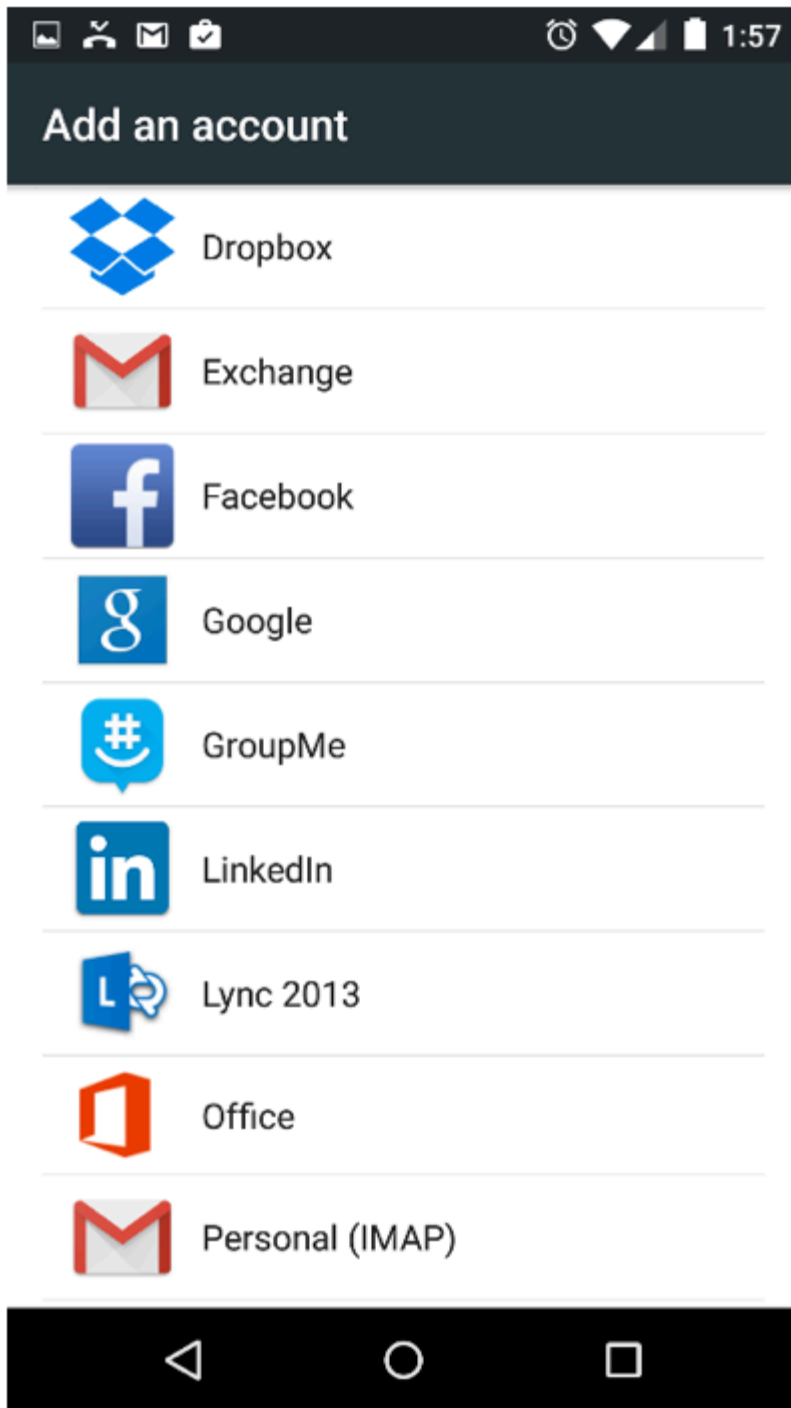
2. Within Settings, scroll down to the "**Personal**" section and select "**Accounts**".



3. Select "Add account".

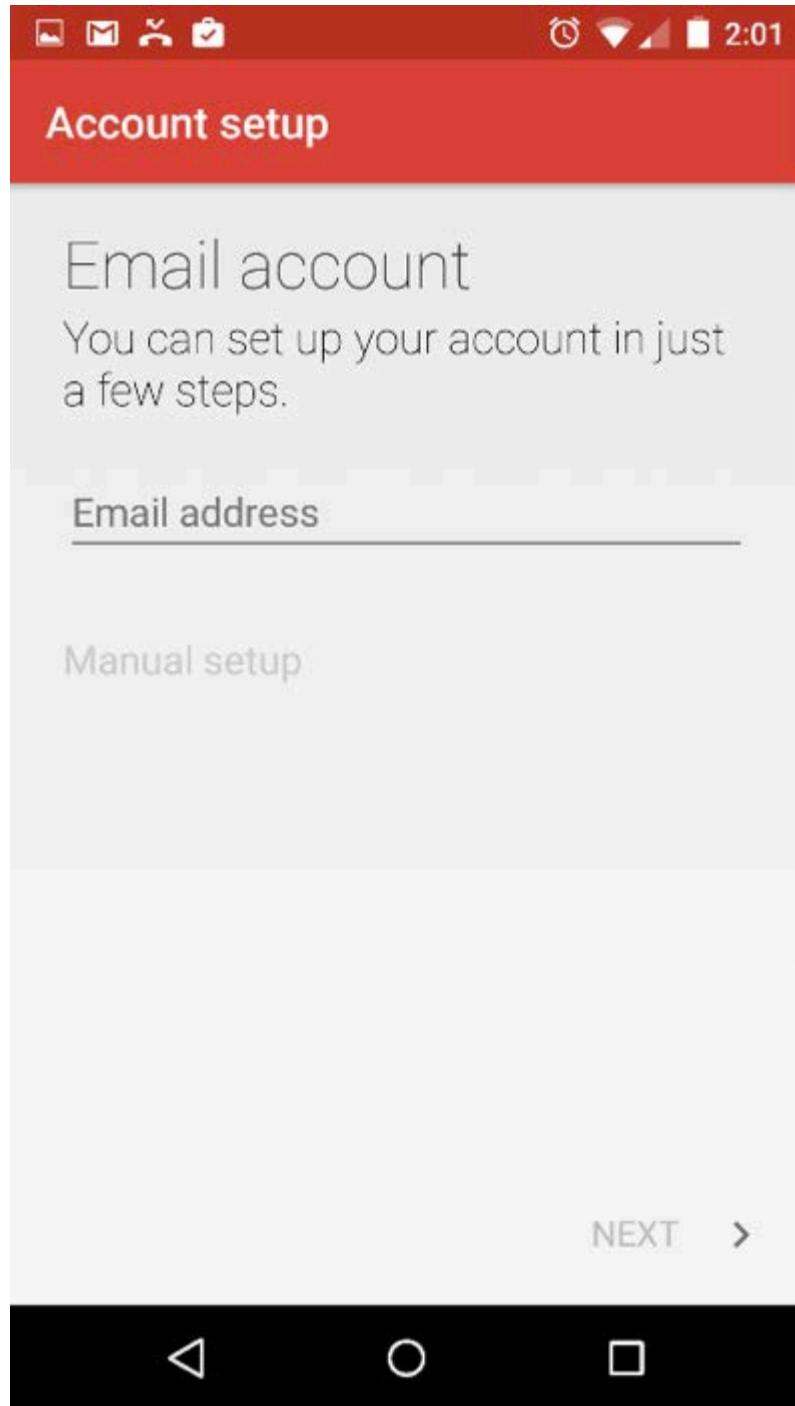


4. Select "**Personal (IMAP)**".



5. Enter the following information:

a. **"Email Address"**: example@unifyamerica.net



6. Tap "**Next**".
7. Enter the following information:
 - a. "**Username**": example@unifyamerica.net
 - b. "**Password**": Your email address password

- c. **"Server"**: secure.emailsrvr.com
- d. **"Port"**: 993
- e. **"Security type"**: SSL/TLS (Accept all certificates)
- f. **"IMAP path prefix"**: Leave this field blank

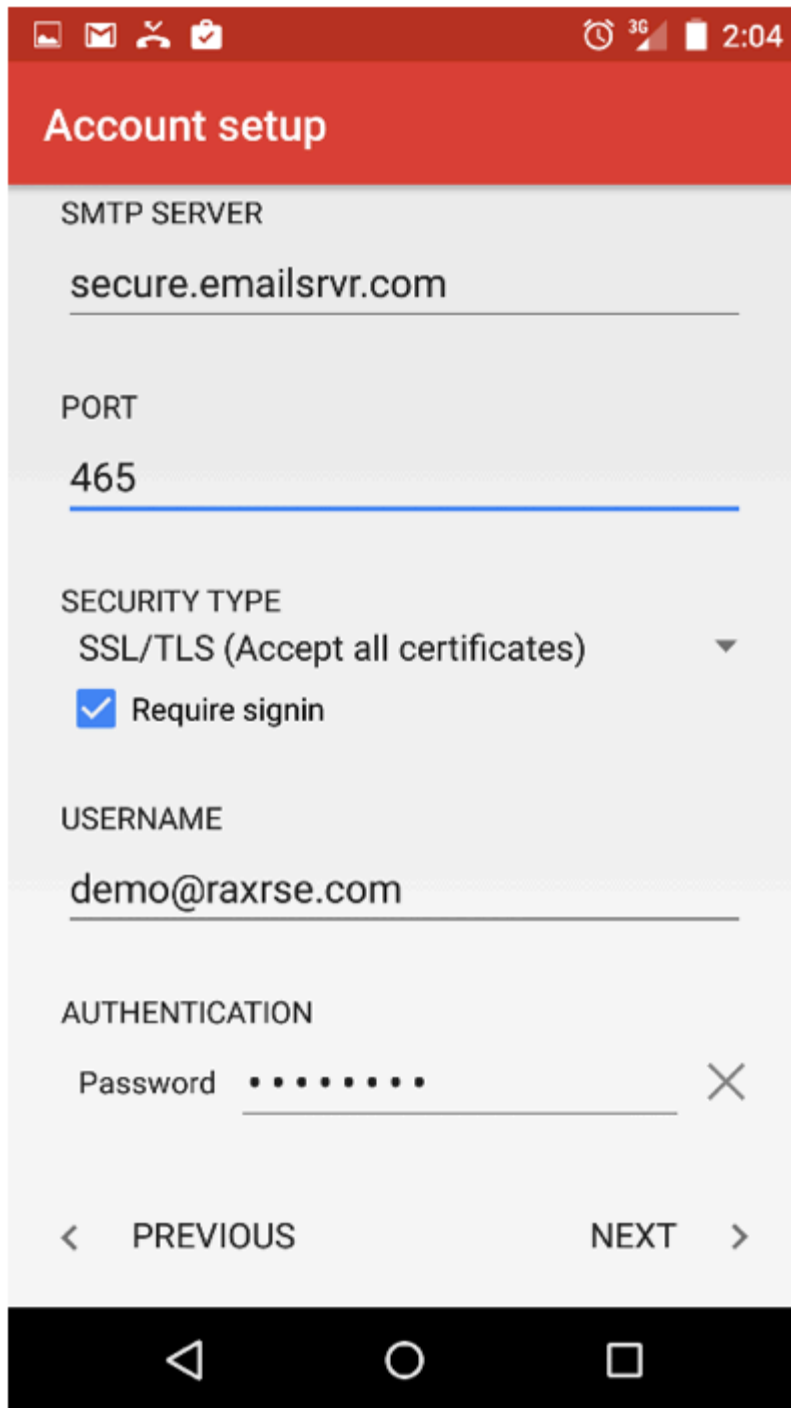

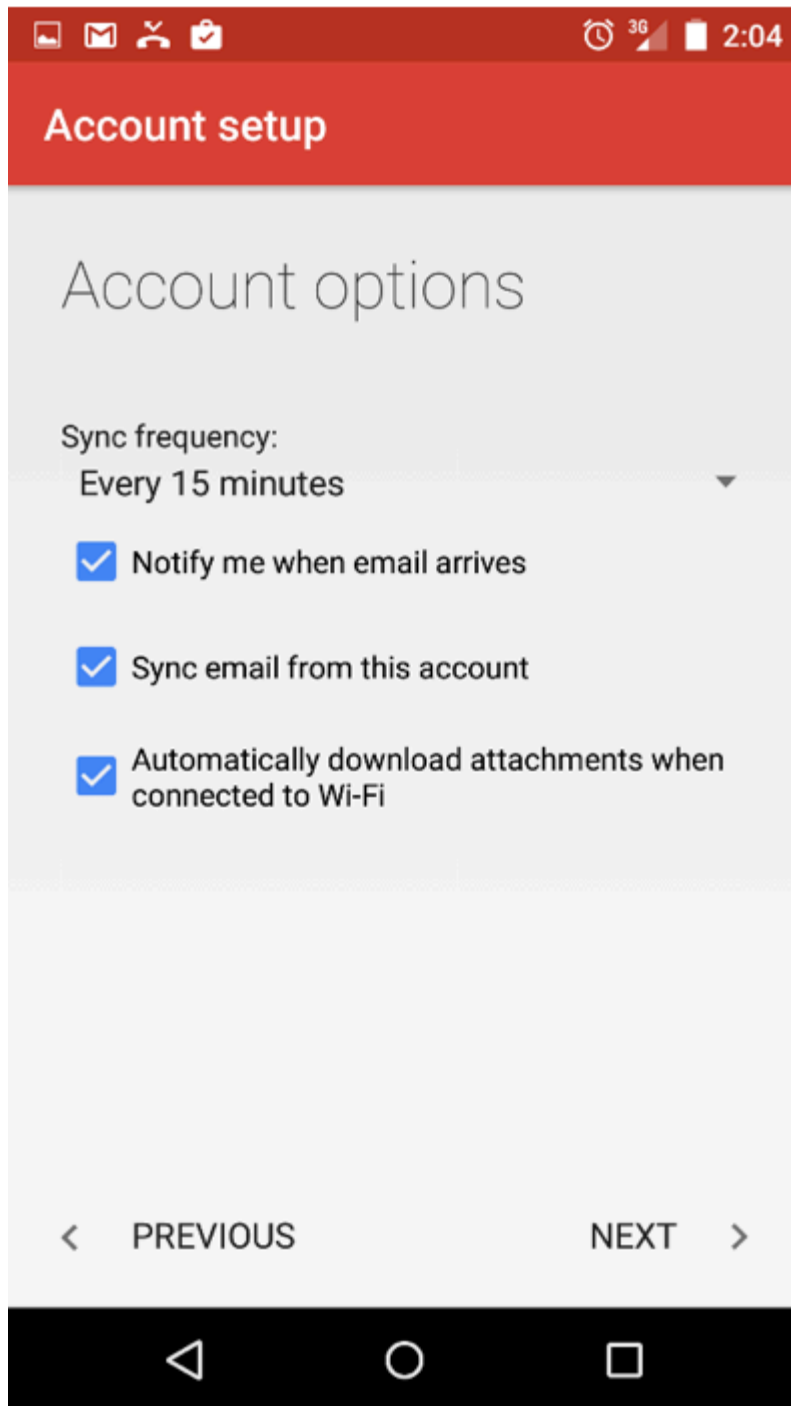

8. Tap **"Next"**.
9. Enter the following information:
 - a. **"SMTP Server"**: secure.emailsrvr.com
 - b. **"Port"**: 465
 - c. **"Security Type"**: SSL/TLS (Accept all certificates)
 - d. **"Require signin"**: Checked
 - e. **"Username"**: example@unifyamerica.net
 - f. **"Password"**: Your email address password



10. Tap "**Next**".

11. Adjust the displayed mailbox settings, if applicable.



12. Tap "**Next**".

13. Success! Your Nexus device should now begin syncing with your mailbox.
