33% Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier Light gold and fresh, lively with citrus and hints of apricot.

50% Chardonnay 50% Pinot Noir sourced entirely from Grand Cru vineyards. The nose is white flowers, honey, toast, hazelnuts, chalk. An exceptional vintage this is a Champagne with plenty of body.

2014, Gruner Veltliner, Austria

32

Medium-bodied with subtle yet vibrant citrus and exotic fruits on the palate followed by a refreshing lingering finish. The most food friendly of white wines.

2014, Litorale Vermentino di Maremma DOC, Val delle Rose, Italy

28.30

This wine displays distinct floral notes with a hint of orange peel, ripe apricot and a fresh salty undercurrent which follow onto the palate along with a rich, oily mouthfeel.

2014, Pinot Grigio, IGT, Giovanni Puiatti, Italy

27

A true classy, flavoursome example of Pinot Grigio at its best; whilst it displays mouth-wateringly fresh grassy notes, hints of green apples, floral hues and a steely minerality.

2015, Sauvignon Blanc, Much Mas, Chile

7/14/21

Produced from old vine Sauvignon Blanc, this Chilean gem is wonderfully refreshing and packed full of Lime zest and kiwi fruit.

2014, Muscadet Serve et Maine, Loire, France

7.70/15.40/23

100% Melon de Bourgogne. Very fruity on the nose with bright, floral notes, lime and grapefruit. Crisp and very refreshing on the palate.

2014, Le Chene Blanc, France

19.75

55% Grenache, 40% Colombard, 5% Marsanne. Fresh and zippy with a wonderful elegant rounded feel.

2014, Free-Run Steen Man, Chenin Blanc, South Africa

7.30/14.70/22

This wine's hot climate roots can be found in its juicy, tropical aromas of guava, melon and ripe peach, which is perfectly balanced by racey acidity and minerality.

2013, Viognier Le Choix de Voltaire, Pays d'Oc, France

28

Classic notes of apricots & peach but with a cracking citrus twist. Full and ripe with hints of sweetness that loves to pair spicy dishes.

2014, Vouvray, Loire, France

33

Christophe Boutet is the definition of small scale, he makes classic Vouvray from his 10 hectares vines. Energetic, pure and full of green apple freshness and chalky minerality.

2014, Rioja Blanco, Heredad de Tejada, Bodega Classica, Spain

8/16/24

This straw-yellow wine displays rounded ripe fruit flavours with twists of dates and banana. It is full, complex and long lasting.

2014, Passion de Moscatel, Spain

27

Delicate hints of orange blossom and white flowers enrich the refreshing citrus and green apples aromas on the nose while the palate is packed full of juicy citrus fruit and apricots.

2014, Columbia Valley Riesling, Chateau Ste Michele, USA

8.30/16.60/25

This Riesling retasins total balance between refreshing green apple acidity and richly flavoursome mineral and apricot notes.

2013, Pinot Blanc, Trimbach, France

28

This simply encapsulates Trimbach wines; whilst showing off such elegance and finesse, the wine is still deep and concentrated flavours with notes of white flower, apricot and steely minerality.

2014, Ward Valley Estate Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

26.50

Unlike many other Kiwi Sauvignon's, this has all the typical expression of passion fruit, whilst retraining finesse and elegance. The bold flavours will definitely stand up to the kick in our dishes.



ROSE

2014, Le Chene Cab Sav, Pays d'Oc, France

6.40/12.80/19

Rose petal pink colour with a lively fresh nose of raspberry aromas. Dry and fruity in taste with strawberry and bright cherry flavours.

2014, Provence Rose, France

29

Domaine de Pontfract is located near Brignoles, and is a superb Provence Rosé; pale, dry and crisp.

2012, Cenrtal Coast Pinot Noir, Mac Murray, USA

Whilst still light-bodied and fresh, these intense flavours of lavender, dark cherry and pomegranate will make your mouth water at the first sip and make drinking the bottle devilishly easy.

2014, Borsao Garnacha, Spain

7.40/14.70/22

Wonderful concentrated fruit whilst remaining fresh and harmonious. It is a perfect juicy blackberry fruit bomb that Robert Parker described as the best value wine from Spain. Not a bad accolade!

2014, Le Chene Rouge, France

19.75

Blended from Grenache and Syrah; Rich in colour and packed with juicy black fruit.

2012, Valpolicella Superiore, Zenato, Italy

34

This family-run estate is based on the shores of Lake Garda. Their Valpolicella is a fantastically structured yet smooth and elegant wine with notes of cherry, spices and ripe plum fruit.

2014, Cotes du Rhone Villages, Landun, France

30

This is an outstanding Cote du Rhone Villages. Spicy, smooth and crfammed with dark fruit. A delicious Southern Rhone red.

2012, Santiago Rioja, Spain

8/16 /24

Classic Crianza style Rioja; smoky with warm vanilla tones, red fruits and soft, well rounded tannins.

2014, Costadune Frappato Syrah, Mandrarossa, Italy

7/14/21

These two grapes offer up a quirky blend; the Frappato bringing red fruit notes and a smoky essence, whilst the Syrah comes with lusciously ripe dark fruits and autumnal spices.

Full

2012 Blood & Courage Shiraz, Barossa, Australia

38

From Shiraz country in Australia, deep red in colour, this wine is packed with aromas of spices, blackberries and liquorice. It is smooth with a full and impressive finish.

2013, Malbec, Tomero, Argentina

27

Ruby red colour. Powerful but elegant flavours with plummy and blackberry hints. Butterscotch and a slight spiciness is integrated by the subtle notes of vanilla that come from the oak aging.

2013, Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva, Vina Leyda, Chile

7.70/15.40/23

This is both soft and structured with rich notes of cherry and plum, as well as gentle toast, hues of tobacco and mocha - all finished with silky smooth tannins.

Glass of wine also available in 175ml/125ml
