

I would like to amend the ordinance for Alcoholic Beverages, Hours of Sale.

Welsh only have the following:

Sec. 4-27. Hours of sale.

It shall be unlawful for any person, whether as owner, manager, agent, proprietor, or otherwise, to open, remain open, conduct, operate or engage in the business of a retail alcoholic beverage outlet (examples include, but are not limited to, barrooms, cabarets, saloons, lounges) and/or an alcohol retail package house, excluding private marketplace, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. Sunday and 12:00 a.m. Monday.

To have a guide from another Town, Lake Arthur, has the following:

Sec. 5-3. Hours regulated.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, attempt to sell, offer to sell, donate or serve any alcoholic beverages as defined in R.S. 26:241 within the town limits between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., Monday through Thursday. *defines public safety studies and economics*
- (b) It shall further be unlawful for any person except retail grocers to allow any place which is used to sell, attempt to sell, offer to sell, donate or serve any alcoholic beverages as defined in R.S. 26:241 within the town limit, to remain open between 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. Monday through Thursday, subject to exceptions noted in this section. *4 hrs.*
- (c) It is unlawful for any person to sell, attempt to sell, offer to sell, donate or serve any alcoholic beverages as defined in R.S. 26:241 within the town limits between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on Friday through Sunday.

*Remain open*
