Corruption

27. When they announced a date to investigate the headquarters, Trump pretended they didn’t know it was supposed to be that day. He then claimed that they were harassed by the investigators, even employees who made sworn statements later refused to testify under oath.
28. **After a year and a half, they finally reached a settlement where Trump’s organization agreed to no discrimination against minorities. The government sent in undercover minority applicants, and they were once again discriminated against compared to the undercover white applicants. Trump went to court again in 1978, where they once again reached a settlement.**

Corruption in Trump's charity

1. 2. **In 2013, the Trump Foundation donated \$25,000 to Florida attorney general Pam Bondi, at the same time they were looking into the Trump University scam. After this donation, she dropped any investigation into Trump University.**

1. A Muslim ban on entering the United States would violate the Establishment Clause in the First Amendment.

3. Any citizen could challenge the Muslim ban for violating speech, religion, and associational protections in the First Amendment.
4. A Muslim ban would violate US violations of international law, including the Refugee Convention, Convention Against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, along with other American statutes of refugee protection.
5. Even a “only block Muslims from problematic countries” plan would blatantly violate the First Amendment. A ban of people entering from certain countries could also be challenged, if it was apparent that the Trump administration were intentionally targeting Muslims. (And no, Jimmy Carter is not an equivalent precedent. Carter temporarily blocked Iranians, which was a country condoning the action of terrorists. Visa restrictions were taken to pressure the Iranian government.)
6. Massive immigration enforcement would erode civil liberties of undocumented immigrants and U.S. citizens alike by leading to a systematic reliance on racial profiling and illegal detentions. A campaign like this would result in rampant Fourth Amendment and Equal Protection violations.
7. A mass deportation would only be based on racial profiling; they’re either asking *everyone* for their identification, or targeting poor Latino families. What’s more likely?
8. Because of this, mass deportations would lead to a mass breakdown of due process, thus violating the Fifth Amendment. Undocumented immigrants are still protected by a long trial and review process, which can take up to two years. Rounding up millions of immigrants in the first hundred days is literally impossible if you follow the constitution, and it is near-impossible to deport all of them in a span of two years.
9. “No catch-and-release” violates the Fifth Amendment and immigration laws, because every person in America has a right to due process and a trial.
10. Promising that the “good ones” can return makes no sense. Not only are visas hard to obtain, but the majority of undocumented immigrants would be forced to wait at least five years according to US immigration law.
