Enjoy cosmic bowling, with disco lights and internet jukebox.

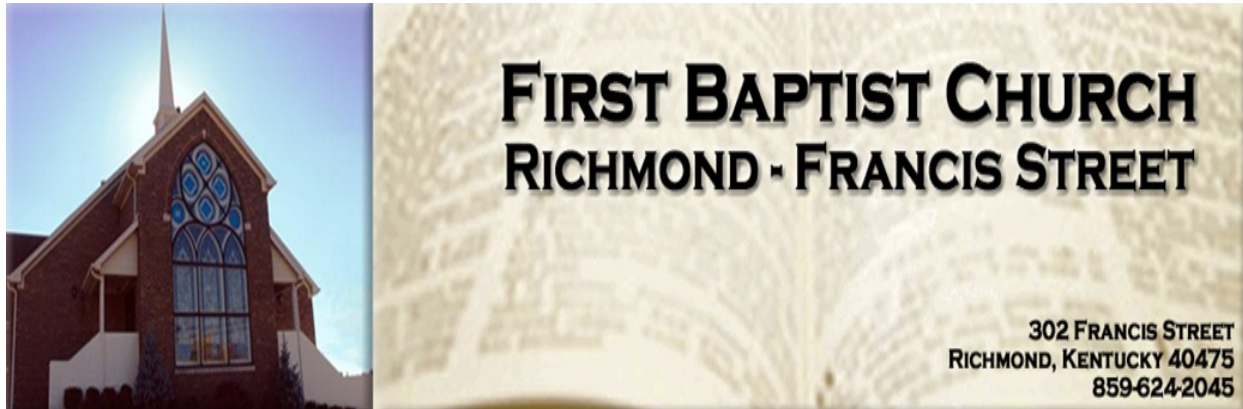
Bowl 2 games/shoes included- Bowling shoes will not be issued without
