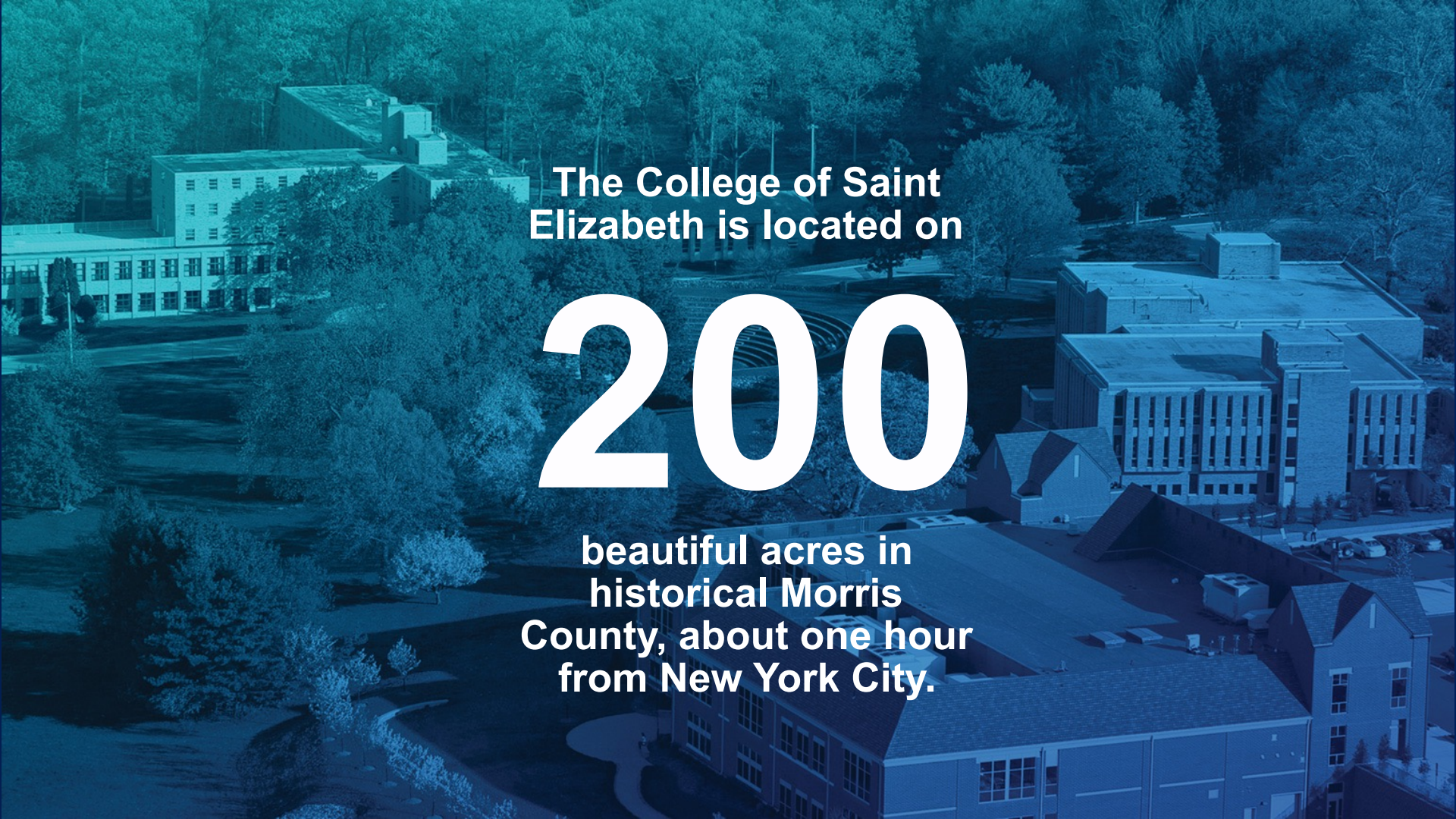

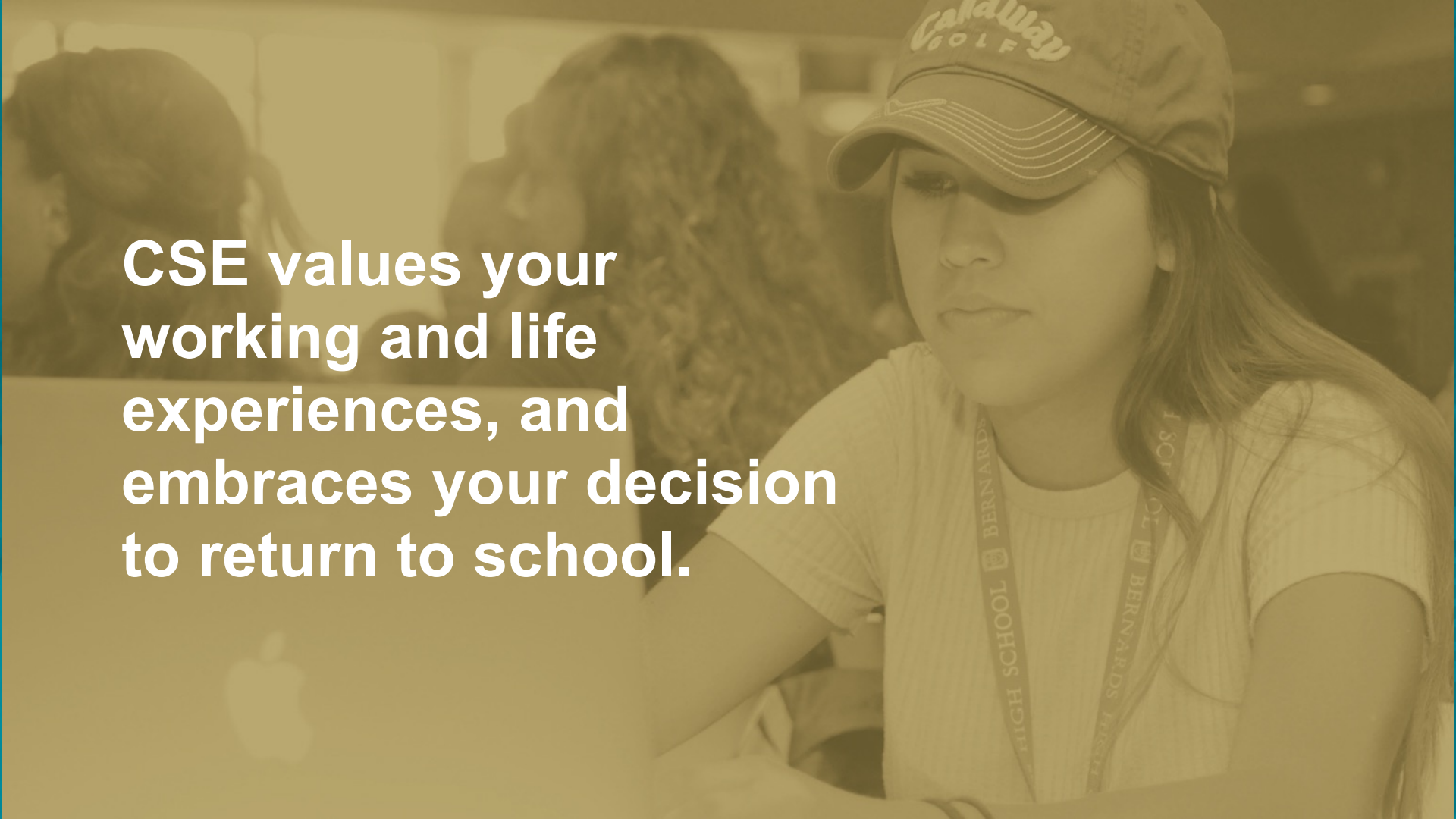

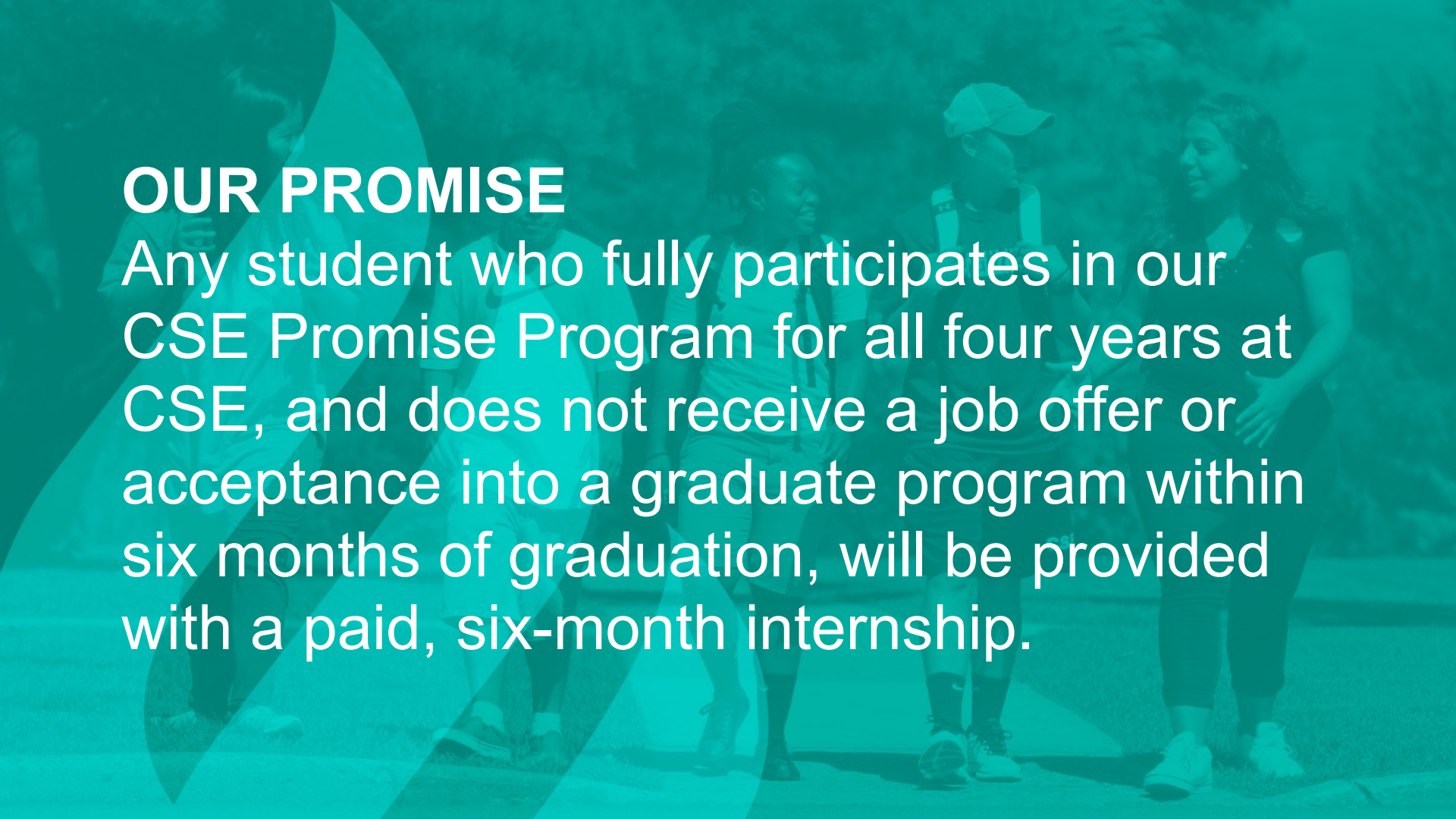

Historic Class of 2020

- First undergraduate co-ed class in the College's history
- Out of 169 undergraduate students, approximately 40% were male
- Students came from across New Jersey as well as California, Delaware, Florida, Maryland, New York, Pennsylvania and Texas as well as emigrants from countries such as Germany and Syria.
- Highest undergraduate enrollment in more than five years
