116. Speaking with Australian Prime Minister Turnbull, he bragged about his “big win,” yelled at Turnbull about refugees, and then hung up on Turnbull halfway through the call.
117. On a call with Mexican President Nieto, Trump said, “You have a bunch of bad hombres down there. You aren’t doing enough to stop them. I think your military is scared. Our military isn’t, so I just might send them down to take care of it.”
118. On a call with French President Hollande, Trump complained that America wanted money back from NATO and that China was taking advantage of the United States.
119. Publicly released personal phone number of Senator Lindsey Graham of South Carolina, a rival candidate at the time.
120. Nicknames political opponents: Crooked Hillary, Little Marco, Lyin’ Ted, “Low Energy” Jeb, Pocahontas (Elizabeth Warren).
121. Blacklisted news networks from his campaign events: Univision, BuzzFeed, Politico, The Daily Beast, The Huffington Post, The Des Moines Register. *Multiple occasions*
122. Scott Pruitt’s LinkedIn page describes him as a “leading advocate against the EPA’s activist agenda.”
123. Crowd chanted “Lock her up!” as Hillary Clinton was announced at the inauguration.

## **Analysis**

Donald Trump is afflicted with a bad case of incompetence. Though America would love to see a President capable of rational and sophisticated thought, it seems that the ballot boxes failed to provide her with this for the present moment. President Trump has welcomed global warming, that is, if it even exists, as a cure for New York’s winter chill (7,9). He is unclear as to how many Articles the United States Constitution has (53), possibly because he is such a stranger to books (54). This aversion to the written word is also apparent in his disgustingly oversimplified intelligence briefings (137), too short to be adequate for an adept leader. When he does receive intelligence, it is seemingly not completely considered and analyzed (142, 144), or is flaunted like a filet mignon (143). Trump seems to lack the understanding of the importance of nuclear disarmament (67, 132). His spokespeople insist that terror attacks happened even when they did not (135), and when confronted about them, claim they are an alternative, yet factual, way of looking at reality (74). His same spokespeople then have issues following ethics rules (107). The President incoherently rambles campaign slogans at foreign leaders (116, 118), and chooses Cabinet members which are not only unqualified, but almost dangerously and extremely so (122, 124, 140). The President should note that battles lost in court cannot be battled in court once more (106), sending federal agents to solve murders is a bit overkill (78), and banning the entry of approximately 200 million people into the United States with no warning is not the best way to conduct foreign policy (138).

Donald Trump is also burdened with the trait of poor temperament. He seems to take particular issue with Arianna Huffington (4), John McCain (15), Jeb Bush (17), journalist Jorge Ramos (18), Carly Fiorina (19), journalist Katy Tur (28), Marco Rubio (38), Meryl Streep (68), Congressman John Lewis (69, 70), Snoop Dogg (114), Senator Lindsey Graham (119), Ted Cruz (48), and, of course, fake news (77, 84, 86, 95, 100, 101, 102, 103, 110, 115). To degrade his opponents in the 2016 race, he resorted to using catchy yet hugely disrespectful nicknames for other politicians (120). He felt it necessary to bully a disabled journalist (26) and then deny it (68). His temperament causes him to enthusiastically back unnamed types of torture (35), and support the torture of people as nothing more than simple revenge (25). He is keen to accuse people of being ignorant and thugs undeserving of finances (75, 93, 94, 99). Donald Trump also has issues with judges who do not agree with his totally Constitutional bans (96, 97, 98) and Democrats who attempted to save the Department of Education (104). He doesn't even have the level-headedness to accept a less-than-spectacular inaugural crowd (125, 139).

Donald Trump does have a remarkable skill though: the skill of dividing an entire country with little effort from himself. It comes naturally to him. His specialties are worsening relations with racial (11, 13, 40, 41, 42, 50, 57, 131) and religious (21, 22, 23, 46, 51, 91, 141) minorities, deepening the already miles-wide partisan rift in politics (89, 90, 105, 112, 134), magnifying the perceived falsity of the media while championing the idea that only Trump is truth (79, 80, 81, 121, 130), attempting to defame his predecessor (83, 113), and delegitimizing any and all forms of protest (111, 136). His fan base makes dissenters in his crowds overshadowed and supporters emboldened (123, 127). Stephen Miller's eerie and authoritarian words make it clear enough that President Trump condones division and accepts only his own views (108).

Destabilization is another of Trump's strong suits. Destabilization can take multiple forms. It can mean questioning the legitimacy and religion of a sitting President and creating the greatest anti-executive conspiracy theory of the 21<sup>st</sup> century (2, 3). It can mean, when that same President is re-elected, openly calling for a violent revolution to overthrow him (8). It can mean stereotyping all southern immigrants as vile people, and at the same time alienating the millions already within the United States, and then threatening the country of Mexico to pay for a wall to keep out said immigrants (12, 14). It can mean a failed real estate developer claiming he knows more about the Islamic State than the nation's top generals, offering to take the reins of the fight, and expecting the rest of the world to just be okay with that (20). It can mean expressing desire not only to kill the terrorists of the Islamic State, but to also kill the family members of the terrorists of the Islamic State (27), an order which the armed forces would find too compelling to refuse (43). It can mean campaigning on a platform of banning Muslims from entering the United States (30), and then backing it up with a flimsy argument about internment camps (31). It can mean asking Russia to hack your Democratic opponent, and then having it actually happen (55). It can mean possibly not accepting the results of a lost election, an atmosphere absolutely ripe for civil conflict, especially with such an inflammatory orator at the movement's head (60, 61). It can mean accusing millions of people of voting illegally without any evidence and then expecting Republicans to have any faith in future elections (64, 76). It can mean planning to flaunt America's military might like some sort of dictator, tempting the world to a fight (72). It can mean accusing the Attorney General of "betrayal" after she did nothing wrong except displease the President (88). It can mean baselessly accusing the most docile nation on earth that it has tremendous immigration problems (85, 109) or threatening to invade Mexico to supplant the Mexican Army (117). It can mean adding a man who lusts for holy war and the collapse of

the federal government to the National Security Council (129). Imagine, if one man were to do all that?

Donald Trump is known for attacks, and democracy itself is a common target. He puts on a pedestal the Tiananmen Square massacre (1) and defends the actions of contemporary dictators (32, 33, 52, 66). Trump regularly complained about the rigged American democracy (62) and continues that process of thinking with the approval ratings (71), blurring reality. He and his allies spoke of restraining free thought (29, 37, 87) and jailing his main opponent (58). President Trump didn't even see the need for an election after all (63), and his administration is giving off signs that the system of expressing grievances to the government has been dismantled (126).

The President has turned his back on the American people. He does not care, perhaps prefers, is those on the political left and minorities are injured by agents of the alt-right (16, 24, 36, 39, 45, 56, 133). He openly admits, violence does not scathe his image, not even if he were to do it himself (34). This has consequences (128).

In final analysis, Donald Trump is also a sad absurdity. Apparently nothing can stop his attraction to women's genitals (5), or to his own daughter (6), a contagious attitude (65). His I.Q. is immeasurably high (10), his penis is, assuredly, immeasurably large (44), and he feels the need to name African-Americans as "his" (49). He declared his first day as President an oddly cultish holiday (73) and calls all deals he disagrees with "dumb" (92). Trump is anti-abortion (47) and spews falsehoods from his mouth and his thumbs with no restraint (59, 82).

## **Solution**

A vengeful and uncaring conman with no morals or decency has unprecedented control over the government of the United States. He is backed by a political party that lost its heart in the 20<sup>th</sup> century, a party that does not have American interests at its core. This unfortunate combination of reaction, inexperience, lies, and deceit resting atop a fractured population cannot lead to bright days.

The Constitution was designed to prevent exactly this situation. The Constitution has failed. Checks and balances are eroded. The branches are not equal. The people are no longer free to life, liberty, or the pursuit of happiness. The social fabric of the country is getting significant holes and tears. Neighbors are turning against each other as Red America tries to swallow the ports of the East and the West. America is not safe. America is not welcoming. America is not prosperous. America is not brave. America is not great.

Trump has hypnotized the heartland to believe everything he says, even when he is completely false. The President is a ridiculous bully who is a champion of hate, fascism, and political tremors. He has a cult of personality of 100 million members ready to protect him at the slightest threat, members who have been shown to be willing to kill and maim. He could tell them that water is not wet and they would rewrite the schoolbooks. That is why, when reality shows his true colors, they do not flinch. They do not perceive reality because they do not live in reality. They live in a world in which a Kenyan Muslim destroyed the United States, but now a highly successful businessman is here to save us all from the encroaching invaders. It is toxic and it is sick.

For the health of America, the safety of the continent, and the peace of the world, Donald Trump must be discarded. He will not stop and he will not quit. The day will never come when Trump peacefully leaves the Presidency. He called for a legitimate revolution in 2012 and put the peaceful transfer of power into question in 2016. Image what he will be capable of in 2020.

It is too dangerous to leave Trump where he is until the Russia investigation is done and impeachment proceedings are underway. Any extra day with him is a day too long.

My solution goes like this: All power is derived from the people. All powers derived from the people rightfully belong to the people, and are delegated to certain institutions. The Congress has the power to impeach. Since it is a power, it must have come from the people. The people delegated the power to impeach to Congress. If Congress does not keep the people safe by using this power properly, the people have the right to take this power back and use it themselves. The people would then have the power to impeach. If Congress will not impeach, the people will have to do it themselves. Ideally, this is accomplished by a referendum or by demonstrations. Whatever mode the people choose, it must be done in due time, before Trump is irreversible.
