

AUDI MIB MMI Shortcut keys

In this document the following shortcut key sequences are shown for each MMI system.

- 3-finger Reset (*Soft reset of MMI*)
- Update Menu (*Red Engineering menu*)
- Screenshot capture (*SD Card required & Copy Script*)

Please note the appropriate vehicle type and Infotainment system to determine the correct shortcut key combination.

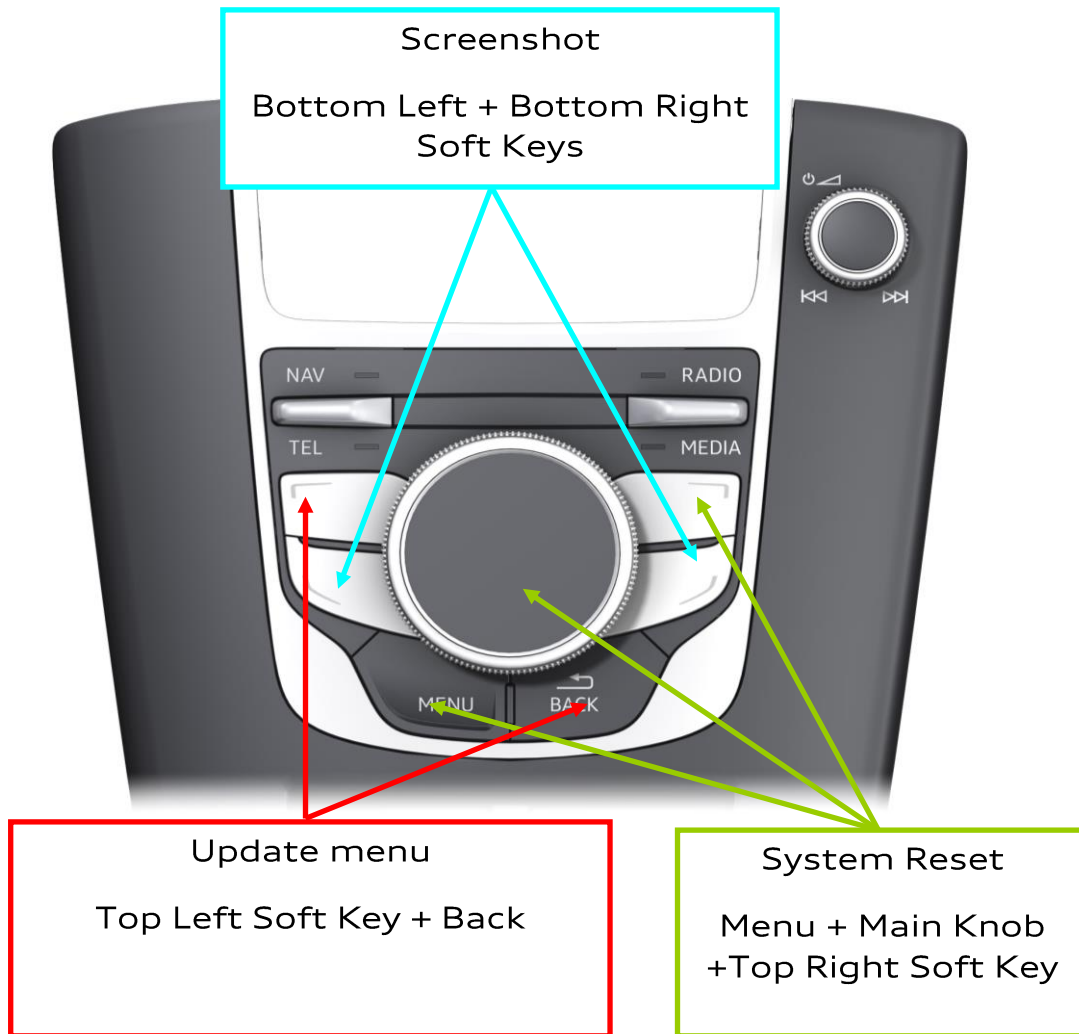
Note:

- Observe the key press sequence as described on the following pages – press and hold the buttons in the order they are described.
- In some instances, the first button must be pressed slightly before the second (exception: Screenshot).
- The MMI reset combination will reset the MMI once the buttons are released. Holding down the buttons for an extended amount of time is not necessary.
- If the MMI screen changes when the button combination is pressed, then the combination was not entered correctly and will need to be repeated.
- For screenshot capture, the MMI display screen will flash white if successful (similar to taking a screenshot on a smartphone). Screenshots are stored to the internal hard drive. The images can be retrieved from the internal hard drive using the ODIS tester (*5F>>Guided Functions>>Basic Settings*) or by using an SD card with the copy script (*Available on ServiceNet>>Technician References>>Audi MMI Scripts>>MIB MMI Screenshot Script*). Follow the instructions on ServiceNet. Once the SD card is inserted into the MMI, the images will be copied directly onto the SD card.
- There is a limit of 50 images on the hard drive and the software uses the logic of “First In First Out”. This means once you hit the max limit of stored images, the oldest image will be automatically overwritten.

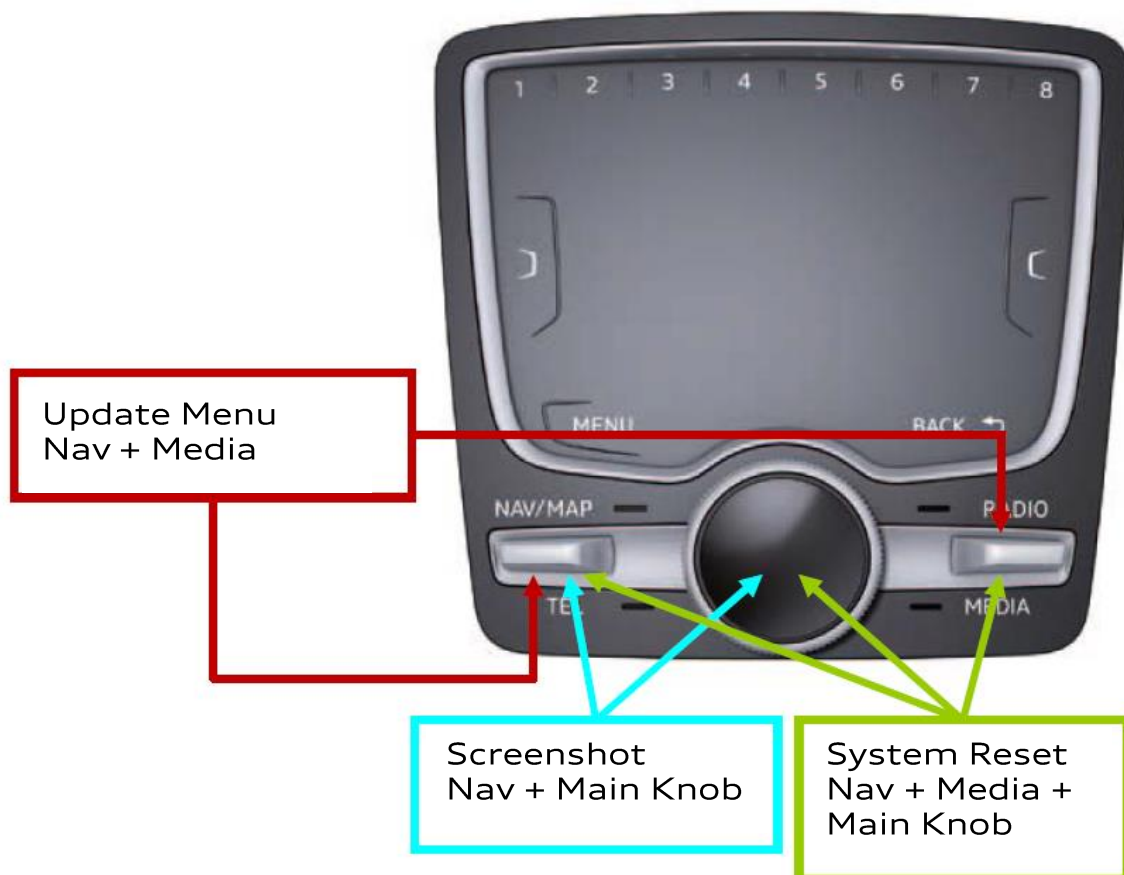
