PURPOSE	Since 1924 the Foundation has been awarding scholarships to students from Western New York. From the year 2000 on, we have awarded over \$16 million in scholarships to thousands of local college students.
ELIGIBILITY	Must be a permanent resident of one of the eight counties of Western New York; must be admitted to a nonprofit [501(c)(3)], U.S. Department of Education accredited school in the US for full-time undergraduate study.
GENERAL INFORMATION	Pell eligible applicants attending school within the eight counties of Western New York will be given strong preference in the award decision process; A limited number of scholarships are available to graduate students in specialized fields (architecture, arts, engineering, medicine, nursing, piano, environment and wildlife).
AWARDS	Awards range from \$1,000-\$6,000 – determined by the Foundation's Board of Directors. Strong preference is given to those applicants who are Pell eligible, as determined by the FAFSA, and attending schools within the eight counties of Western New York.
DEADLINES	March 1 <sup>st</sup> – applications due through website <a href="http://www.cfgb.org">www.cfgb.org</a> <b>NOTE: Deadlines are subject to change – check website often.</b>
REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION	Complete the <a href="#">FAFSA</a> Complete and submit the Community Foundation's scholarship application online Submit a copy of your most recent grades as part of the online application Be sure to authorize the Community Foundation to receive your financial information electronically from your college/university.
