Being so hard to locate previous owners she is now looking for a new home where she can settle in and make her own. We have no history of what she is like with other animals or children but with good slow introductions she may be suitable with any type of household. A little shy and bewildered about being in a strange environment she will need a little encouragement to come out of her shell but she is a sweet gentle natured girl once you get to know her.
