

Armored for Battle

Introduction

This process was given to me by a friend who got it from a friend who transcribed it from Ian Clayton. I'm not sure if she got it from a live meeting or his audio. Either way, the transcription was quality, despite a few words missing. I followed it and had great results. The key is Faith in the God who loves you and that you follow His lead!

The following is a compilation of the transcription, a few assumptions, and minor additions, so remove any attribution to Ian Clayton or myself, lean not upon your own understanding and pursue Him. He is the One that will dress you for Battle, but you have a part. The process took me about 50 days.

Overview

Luke 11:20-22 Amplified Bible (AMP)

"But if I drive out the demons by the finger of God, then the kingdom of God has [already] come upon you. When the strong man, fully armed, [from his courtyard] guards his own dwelling, his belongings are undisturbed [his property is at peace and is secure]. But when one stronger than he attacks him and conquers him, **he robs him of his whole armor** on which he had relied and divides up and distributes all his goods as plunder (spoil)."

Satan arms himself with simple things: lies and deceit. Then he comes to you with lies, deception and deceit. As soon as you open yourself up to this and receive the lies about who you are, your destiny and your life, he has already stripped you of your armor. No matter how much you proclaim your righteousness etc, you have already been stripped of your armor. Not only that. he has come into your house and taken from you all your goods as his own.

Then when you come and find it difficult or that you are too tired to pray, etc. It's because he has come and you have been stripped from the covering of the Presence of God in your life because you chose to receive something that isn't true and it has overcome your life.

We are able to strip him of all his deception by the Word of God.

The Three Armors of God

- 1) Armor of Light (Romans 13:12)
- 2) Armor of Righteousness (2 Corinthians 6:7)
- 3) Armor of the Strength of God and the Power of His Might (Ephesians 6:10)

You put on these armors by prayer, faith, fasting and confession. You have to walk like you carry it. You have to learn to use this armor and make it yours. Then you can join with someone else that has made it their own. Remember! Put these on by faith - we live by faith, not sight.

STEP 1: Put on each armor individually several times a day (up to 10 minutes) for 21 days.

STEP 2: Put on all three armors at once several times a day (up to 10 minutes) for another 21 days.

Armor of Light

Romans 13:12 "The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us **put on the armor of light.**"

The nature of light is to dispel darkness. Its primary purpose is protection. It gives you the authority and power to subdue and assault the demonic world too. It empowers you -- the believer -- for victory. It's for protection inward and outward, and dealing with issues.

Armor of Righteousness

2 Corinthians 6:4-7 "But in all things we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, by the word of truth, by the power of God, **by the armor of righteousness** on the right hand and on the left."

It gives you defense against the enemy. You cloak yourself with Yeshua, putting Him around your life, cloaking yourself with the armor of His being. You cannot earn righteousness. God imputes it into you. You have to believe that righteousness is armor and that you cannot earn it.

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians 15:50

Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, Yeshua Hamashiach and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts. Romans 13:14 Put on Jesus Christ, put on the Lord, Jesus Christ, Yeshua Hamashiach! He is known as the righteous one. After this, where Ian had been vulnerable to attacks, the attacks began to stop.

Armor of Might

Armor of GOD - the Strength of God and the Power of His Might

Ephesians 6:10-11 "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. **Put on the whole armor of God**, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil."

Wiles: Third person, singular present, plural of wile. Noun: Devious or cunning stratagems employed in manipulating or persuading someone to do what one wants.

(AMP) Ephesians 6:10-11 "In conclusion, be strong in the Lord be empowered through your union with Him; draw your strength from Him that strength which His boundless might provides."

It's a shield covering over us. This armor stops poison darts and poison arrows sent by the wiles of the devil. You can draw strength from God and you can release His strength. It mandates you for assault; it mandates you for assaulting the enemy's camp. It gives you the ability, the power and authorization to go and do the job. Ian Clayton says, "After you do this for 10 minutes a day, you can jump over the moon!"

Note: I - not Ian Clayton - noticed that SINCE I CAN DRAW STRENGTH, I can therefore release His strength too!

Testimonies

Ian Clayton

After about 14 days, he began to see himself from outside of his body. He did not know at the time that you needed to have an anchor for the supernatural to come on, for the glory and the potential reality of what's inside of it, but he began to see it. He began to see what came out of the realm of the kingdom was a fine gold, silver and white thread that began to wrap around his body, over and over again, until he was wrapped in this fine gold, silver, white thread like a cocoon and a light began to form around his spirit. He now had an anchor. It kept going around and around and would get brighter and brighter, until he could not look at it with his eyes. So he shut his eyes.

It continued to wrap and get brighter until he could feel the force of that light push upon him and he could see the white behind his eyelids. Then suddenly he found himself back into his body. The Lord said to him, "If you, being a child of light, cannot look at the intensity of that light, how much more in the kingdom of darkness!"

He then spent three weeks weaving this light, weaving it around his body, cocooning himself in the light of this glory. That is now why his "cocoon of light" in the realms of the spirit is like lightening. He has done the work, to produce this in the spirit realm.

This light, as it penetrated outwardly, also penetrated and turned inward. The Armor of Light penetrated the dark recesses of his soul and began to expose everything that was out of order. This covering became a protection while it exposed the dark disorder without the enemy having any access to it.

Ian walked through about six months of his life dealing with repetitive sin pattern. He came out of it feeling clean, pure and sanctified by this light that penetrated the depths of his being, because this armor is a protective covering.

Wallace Johnson [myself]

This process took me about 50 days. I lost count during some of 21 day segments so I did one or two more. There is no "magic" in 21 days but 21 days of anything forms a habit and these 21 days ingrain a "new creation reality" into you. It is a good tip to journal or mark the days off with a calendar. I did not memorize the prayers and actions – I had them on my phone.

I think I will have this story in my third book but in case I don't, I will capture it here:

The night that I finished the 21 days of all three armors, I thought I would put these to a test. So, I asked the Father where I could go to test my armors. I had seen the movies, "300" and "Gladiator" several times so I assumed that I would be transported to some "training arena". I did not receive a response or a transport. So, I thought, "I must be able to choose". I had a friend that was ministering in Columbia, so I thought I would go there and "clear the area of the demonic hordes for him". So I spoke to my angelic team and moments later me and three angels landed in Columbia. I'm not sure why I asked them to come with. I think I was being polite since I had recently just met them. Anyway, we landed in a village, but I couldn't see or find any demons. I started looking and I was disappointed. The angels were not a help in finding demons. So, I went on a rampage pulling down and destroying structures. It was kind of like the way I imagine Jesus cleaning the temple with a whip. There seemed to be political, religious, and demonic structures that were established. So I destroyed them. It was fun. I returned to my bedroom pondering why I could not find any demons. I made a few entries in my journal and went to sleep.

Put Each Armor on for 21 Days

Father God, I hereby commit to pray these prayers with Your help to put on each armor several times a day for 21 up to 10 minutes a day, starting _____. [Check off each day.]

Father, I cast off the works of darkness! *[Cover yourself with the blanket and throw it off. Repeat 3 times or more.]*

Father, I put on the armor of light in the name of Yeshua. Father, I draw the armor of light around me and I put it on. [Pray in tongues.] Father, by faith I cast off the works of darkness, in the name of Yeshua and I put on the Armor of Light. *[Cover yourself with the blanket and throw it off.]* Father, by faith I cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. Thank You Father!

Father, I thank You that, by faith and by Your grace, I receive the armor of righteousness into my being and around my being. I receive it from You Father! I receive it from You right now, in the name of Yeshua. I put on Yeshua, and I am the righteousness of God in Christ.

Father, today, I draw on Your strength and declare I am strong. I draw it around me as my armor today. By faith I draw on the power of Your might. I draw on that in the name of Yeshua.

Put All Armor on for 21 Days

Father God, I hereby commit to pray these prayers with Your help to put on all armor several times a day for 21 up to 10 minutes a day, starting _____. [Check off each day.]

Father, I cloak myself in these armors that I have grafted. I cloak myself in them in the name of Yeshua. I set my spirit, soul and body to be cloaked with the Armor of God now - the Armor of Light, the Armor of Righteousness, and the Armor of the Strength and Might of God. I come into agreement with God and declare I have put on Christ! I am in Christ! I live in Christ and Christ lives in me! I am one with the Father! In this world, I am like Yeshua! I do what Yeshua did and greater. Thank You Father!
