Candyfloss 2017

Candyfloss 2017 is an installation activating the venetian blinds of a dormant shopfront in Coburg North. The work renders the shopfront blinds into a continual loop, opening and closing the view upon each rotation. This simple intervention activates the usually dormant site, allowing for the community to have access to an otherwise concealed perspective. By removing the governance of the venetian blinds' gaze from the control of private resident, the sight is rendered equal between private space and communal space. The work is in operation 24 hours a day for the duration of the exhibition.
