1 Prognosis: pending response to therapy

2 Client Education: Discussed that parvo is a very serious disease - discussed that even with treatment, we only give him a 50/50 chance. Disease leads to secondary dehydration and sepsis if not treated appropriately and fluid therapy is not stayed on top of. At this time, bloodwork is showing that his WBC count is high which is a good sign, but things can change very quickly and p can decompensate very rapidly. Glucose levels have remained stable in hospital today but this can also change very quickly. P would benefit from overnight hospitalization/fluid therapy at MedVet in Mandeville. O declines at this time due to financial constraints and may not even be able to come back due to maxing out the credit card at this visit. Discussed that p absolutely should return tomorrow for further fluid therapy/repeat medications. Breeder suggested they "let p die and she would send another one". O understands that p will likely decompensate if therapy is not followed up tomorrow.

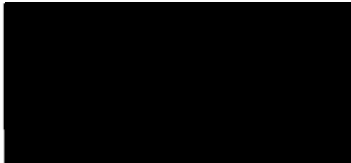

2 Client Education: continue to recommend referral to MedVet for continuous care overnight, even if P returns tomorrow; P has greatest chance of survival with continuous care/medications. Did not repeat labs today, as P remained clinically stable and O's are trying to keep costs low; recommend at very least repeating cbc tomorrow +/- BG, pending P's clinical presentation. P is still not eating -- important for O to apply corn syrup or high calorie paste to P's gums every 2 hours.

Explained P did not do well over last night and was in pretty poor shape today on presentation -- Low BG and low WBC. If not taking P to overnight care, P definitely will require continuous care tomorrow. If not able to be aggressive with therapy, prognosis is poor (based on how P presented today and blood work) and humane euthanasia is reasonable to prevent suffering. O's elect to take P home tonight so daughter can see P. Will likely proceed with euthanasia. Explained P may decline over night -- recommend medvet for humane euthanasia if P declines over night
