Team Arctos 6135 is a FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) team from Bloor Collegiate Institute, a high school in Toronto. Our robotics team was formed in 2015 and we began our rookie FRC season in the 2015-2016 season with support and mentorship from our principal, several teachers at Bloor, and help from older teams such as 610. As of January 1, 2017, Arctos has 62 student members. About FRC Events

Costs

In addition to our team's build and material costs, there are also the costs of the competitions. The registration fee is nearly \$8000 and with the costs of transportation, food, and somewhere to sleep for the whole team the costs quickly get higher.
