OASA Rule Book Governs Play with the following exceptions:

Double re-entry rule (batting lineup only)

Teams must bat at least 9 batters – defensive players can switch in and out at your leisure (don't need to be in batting lineup)

Home team to be determined by a coin flip before each game straight through the Championship.

No new inning after 90 minutes of play on Saturday – If tied, straight to international rule (last out on 2nd base to begin inning)

Sunday – 7 full innings – straight to international tiebreaker if tied after 7

Mercy rule - 10 runs after 3, 7 runs after 5

No pitcher or player can play Sunday if they have not played on Saturday
