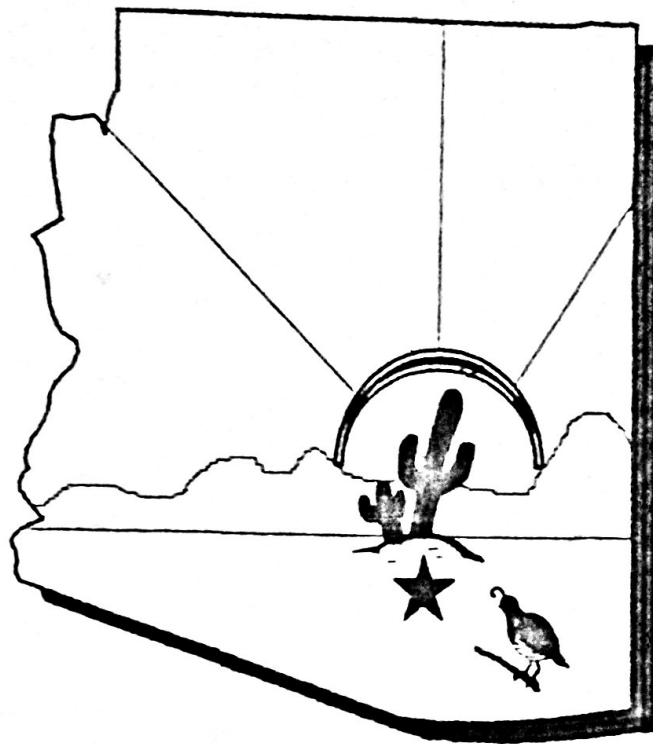

WINTER SHOW RULES

- 1) Entries must be **POSTMARKED BY NOV. 1, 2017.**
Late entries accepted only at the discretion of the
Show Secretary & Show Superintendent.

Show is open to all Poultry, Pigeon & Fancy Fowl members and non-members. Non-members are invited to join our club. Dues are Family-\$15.00, Single-\$10.00 and Junior-\$5.00. Make checks payable to the Tucson Poultry, Pigeon and Fancy Fowl Club (TPPFFC).

- 2) Entry fee is \$3.50 per bird, \$9.00 per trio. American Game entry fee is \$5.00 per bird, \$7.50 day of show. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Large fowl will be double cooped for an additional \$3.50 per bird cooping fee.
- 3) The Tucson Poultry, Pigeon and Fancy Fowl Club is a member of the APA & ABA. All poultry and pigeons will be judged by these Standards. All other fowl will be judged in its own class or variety. This includes Pheasants, Peafowl, etc. All non-standard breeds will be judged by comparison.
- 4) The exhibition, in all respects, will be under the control of the Show Superintendents and the Board of Directors of the TPP&FFC. who will be governed by the APA, ABA.
- 5) In the event of protest, said protest must be submitted in writing, along with a \$25.00 fee to the Show Sec. The Judge, Show Secretary and Show Chairman will render the final decision. In the event they find justification, the entire protest fee will be refunded.
- 6) There is no limit to the number of entries made by a single exhibitor other than those due to lack of space & coops available.

WINTER SHOW RULES

- 7) Birds shall be entered as follows: Cock, Hen, Old Duck, Old Drake, Old Goose, Old Gander and Old Trios are birds hatched **before Jan. 1, 2017**. Cockerels, Pullets, Young Duck, Young Drake, Young Goose, Young Gander and Young Trios are birds hatched **after Jan. 1, 2017**. Trios will consist of 1 male & 2 females of the same age & variety. Pigeons will be entered as Old Cock, Old Hen, Young Cock, & Young Hen.
- 8) A display of chickens will consist of 1 Cock, 1 Hen, 1 Cockerel, 1 Pullet & 1 Trio, old or young. In all displays eligible birds must be of the same variety. Points for determining Displays will be based on the Award won by each entry (6 points for 1st, 4 pts for 2nd, 3 pts for 3rd, 2 pts for 4th & 1 pt for 5th) multiplied by the number of birds competing in that class. i.e. cocks, hens, etc. Geese & Ducks also are eligible for displays. Old Goose or Duck, Old Gander or Drake, Young Goose or Duck, Young Gander or Drake & three other birds.
- 9) An entry form is included with each show book. Please list Bantams, Large Fowl and other birds in separate groups. (Plain paper is acceptable). Please be specific about which of the above categories you are entering. All birds not designated will be entered as Standards(Large Fowl).
- 10) Entry forms must include the previous information plus Sex, Age, and whether Single or Trio. This also includes Pigeons. Exhibitors of Silkies, Polish & Japanese must state if bird is Bearded or Non-Bearded. Exhibitors of Leghorns, Minorcas or RI Reds must state if Single Comb or Rosecomb. Booted Bantams are Non-Bearded. Belgian D'Uccle's are Bearded.
- 11) The Show Building will be open to receive entries from 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM on Friday Nov. 17th and from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM on Saturday Nov. 18th. **Birds must be in place by 9:00 AM on Saturday, Nov. 18th, 2017.**

- 12) Only healthy & disease free birds may be shown. The Show Supt. will reject birds showing signs of vermin or disease. All birds must be banded & band numbers written on the coop tags. Owners should ensure all band numbers are on before judging begins.
- 13) A Show Official will be present from 4pm to 9pm on Friday and 6am to 5:30pm on Saturday and 7am to closing on Sunday. The building will be secured at all times to safeguard the exhibits. However, the TPP&FFC will not be responsible for losses due to theft, fire or other causes. Birds will be entered at the Owners risk.
- 14) No persons other than the Judges & Show Officials shall be allowed to handle the exhibits without the consent of the owners. Any person interfering with the Judging or Judges shall have their entry disqualified. All eggs shall become the property of TPP&FFC unless requested by owners prior to the Show.
- 15) Checkout time is 10:00 AM on Sunday, Nov. 19th, unless otherwise announced by the Management. **Note: Any exhibitors who have any special needs or request, please contact the Show Secretary and the Show Chairman.**
- 16) Birds will be placed to 5th place with ribbons awarded.
- 17) All premiums & awards from Specialty Clubs & Individuals are accepted in good faith, however the TPP&FFC will not be responsible for payments or awards not received. Mail your Specialty Club dues in now.
- 18) Exhibitors will be responsible for feeding and watering all their own entries for the duration of the show, unless other arrangements are made.
- 19) The Club will keep and water and feed birds for anyone who wishes to come early or stay after the Show.

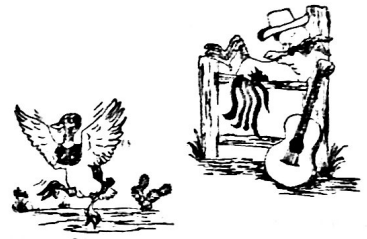

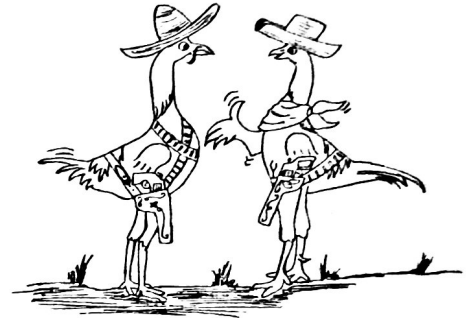

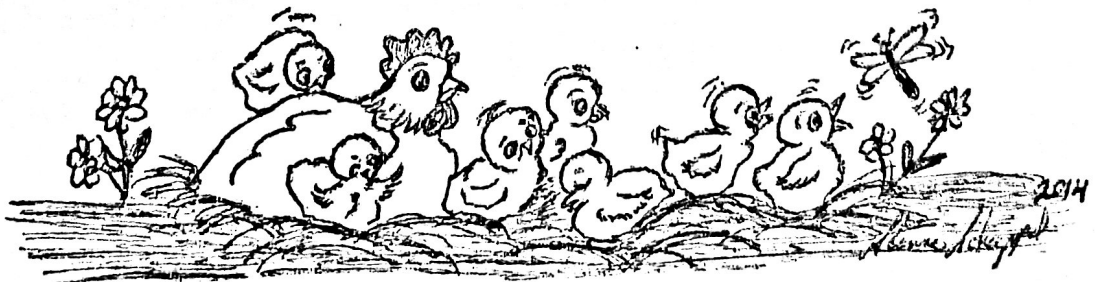
