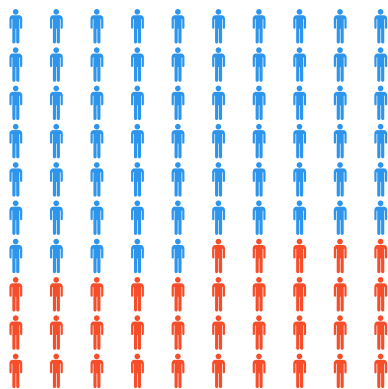
## Future Implementation

The Nuclear Energy Institute survey also found that 84% of United States citizens believe that nuclear power should be more important in the future.

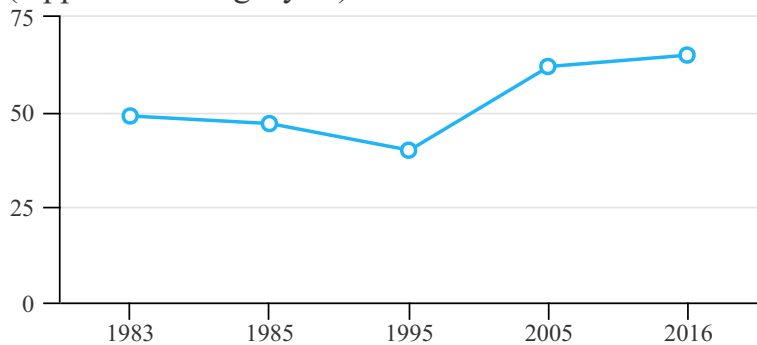


## Survey Results
