I work well independently and with a team, can sell an idea, and I can hit the ground running.


Typeface Design

I was commissioned to design a monospace font for a boutique to use as a title font on all the signs in and around their store.

I chose a very light line weight, a shallow curve with a subtle sharp edge, a wide stance with and a low cross member to give the font a modern and sleek feel but at the same time giving it a sturdy visual weight.


The resulting typeface portrays both elegance and strength to give shoppers a feeling of high quality products.

The UCSC Backpacking Club hired me to create their new logo, they gave me a sketch of what the had in mind and told me they needed a one color logo made out of it to put on shirts, sweaters, banners, etc.

From the drawing they provided I decided the best route would be to go with positive against negative space instead of a line drawing to better suit printing on fabric and to help improve readability from a distance.







Orange umbrella was an app that gave the weather with a super minimalistic interface, I was hired by them to create the logo and wordmark as well as the app icon.

They wanted an umbrella as their logo so to keep with the minimalistic theme I decided to go with 2 color flat design. I worked the umbrella into to the "U" letter form to create what is a recognizable logo with or without the wordmark.

Because this business was planning to only advertise by passing business cards to computer repair companies that might use their services I made the cards a half an inch taller than regular business cards, and printed with metallic pantone colors on an extra heavy off—white card stock to help the cards stand out amongst others.

After drawing it up in Illustrator I started playing with the forms a little bit to break them into 3 seperate rings that can then be set to any combo of colors that are needed, the original image had a solid circle holding the composition, I took that and turned it into a ring to give a better 1 color mark.









Layout Design

When I was at HSU one of the extra design courses offered was layout design class for editorial journalism students.

We were assigned to duplicate the layout of a time magazine article as acurately as possible in Indesign including font family, character and paragraph styling, margins, header, and footer.

But that's consumptive happiness, the happiness that comes not from sowing but from reaping, not from building the house but from watching TV in your new living room. That may

be the goal of the work, but it's a goal that, once achieved, can leave us feeling bored.

Since 1972, only about one-third of Americans have described themselves as "very happy," according to surveys funded by the National Science Foundation. Just since 2004, the share of Americans who identify themselves as optimists has plummeted from 79% to 50%, according to a new Time poll. Meanwhile, more than 20% for us will suffer from a mood disorder at some point in our lifetimes and more than 30% from an anxiety disorder. By the time we're 18 years old, 11% of us have been diagnosed with depression.

The gap between our optimistic expectations and the reality that a significant portion of the population is, of late, cranky and dissatisfied may be what has spawned the vast happiness industry. We tap that industry in a lot of ways--with pills (the Time poll found that 25% of American women and 5% of men say they are taking antidepressants), with food (48% of women and 44% of men admit to eating to improve their mood, contributing to the U.S. obesity epidemic), with

self-improvement products and services (including books, audiobooks and seminars, self-improvement is a \$10 billion-a-year industry, about the same as Hollywood), with borrowed wisdom (there are 5,000 motivational speakers in the U.S., earning a collective \$1 billion per year). The pur suit of happiness, once an ideal, has become a big business but not an especially effective one; plenty of other countries are doing a lot better than we are without trying so hard. According to the 2012 World Happiness Report, published by the Earth Institute of Columbia University, the U.S. ranks 23rd on a 50-country happiness index, far behind No. 1 Iceland, No. 2 New Zealand and No. 3 Denmark and trailing Singapore, Malaysia, Tanzania and Vietnam

If you're part of the demographic pursuing joy or just trying to quell some psychic angst, none of this is a surprise to you, nor is the way happiness is now being merchandised, since you may have spent more than your share of disposable income on meditation or yoga classes, life coaching or happiness apps. Part of the solution, however, may lie not in a product or a program but simply in a better understanding of the particular way Americans define happiness in the first place. There are answers to be found in our genes, in our collective psyche, in the workings of our brain. If it was possible for our ancestors to be happy on the prairie, it ought to be possible for us to be happy in our jobs, our families, our communities.

Layout Design

For our midterm assignment we had to find an article in a magazine and make a single page layout for it that would still feel as if it fit in the magazine the article came fromto begin with, I chose to do an article from Wired.

By using an exaggerated drop letter and box headers I made a 3 column article page that used some of the common elements and themes used by designers in newer Wired Magazine copies including heavy contrast with loud breaks in the flow of the Layouts to create visually jarring page designs.



Who is the real John McAfee? He's the man who went on the run after his neighbour was found dead, face-up, with a bullet in his head. He's the man who jump-started the multibillion-dollar anti-virus industry. And now he thinks he can make you invisible on the internet.



Within tech circles he's long been a legend. But for most people, McAfee came to prominence last year when he fled his Central American home - teeth stained, hair dyed, in disguise - rather than let himself be questioned by authorities he accused of being corrupt.

He tells the BBC he had "no connection whatsoever" with his neighbour's death. Police say he remains a "person of interest".

Back in the US, after posting footage of young female "friends" stroking his naked tattooed torso, he now plans to neutralise the NSA's cyber-surveillance system. It might suggest a crazed, perhaps even deranged, personality. One journalist who has interviewed McAfee many times described him a "master manipulator" who lies and deceives.

"I've been called paranoid, schizophrenic, the wild child of Silicon Valley," McAfee acknowledges.

But he has a different perspective: "I'm an entrepreneur. I always have been. I am curious and I enjoy solving problems.

"I think that it's when we step out of the road, step outside the box, become our own person and we walk fearlessly down paths other people wouldn't look at, that true progress comes. And sometimes true beauty as well.

"We're missing that. We're missing the people who have the courage to walk into the wilderness just to see what's there."

This is how Amy Emshwiller, the teenage ex-prostitute he lived with in Belize, describes him: "He's sweet, generous. He likes to like adventures. He's serious and usually he has a dark sense of humour. He's generally a sweet guy. He just doesn't like to be [expletive] with."

So, who is the real John McAfee?

To have any chance of knowing and gaining an informed opinion of what really motivated his erratic-sounding behaviour after the killing of Gregory Faull, you must travel deep into the 68-year-old's past.

Addicted and expelled

Despite his Southern accent, the bleached-blond and goateed businessman is in fact half-British - the son of an Englishwoman who met an American soldier stationed in the UK during World War II.

"I feel as much British as I do American," McAfee says. "There's not much difference between our countries."

They moved to Virginia when he was young, where he had a troubled

childhood. His father was an abusive alcoholic who, when McAfee was aged 15, shot himself dead. In the following years, McAfee says, he too began drinking heavily and taking drugs, but still managed to maintain a promising academic career.

That came to an end in the late 1960s when Northeast State Louisiana State College terminated his PhD in mathematics after it was revealed that he had slept with an undergraduate he was mentoring.

They later married and McAfee turned his skills to a series of programming jobs with some of the biggest tech organisations of the time including Nasa, General Electric, Siemens, Univac and Xerox, all the while continuing to indulge in his addictions.

"Most of my bosses also used drugs of some kind," he says. "I was in the tech field, after all, we were the leading edge in technology and the leading age in personal experimentation.

"I had to hide it from my mother and sometimes from my wife. But in the work environment - depending on where you worked - in some companies drugs were taken openly at lunchtime in people's offices. It was a bizarre time."

Matters came to a head in the early 1980s after his wife left him, his most recent employer, Omex, let him go and the scale of his drug dependency forced him to seek help.

"It was 1984, the last time that I took drugs, drank alcohol or sold drugs for that matter," he says.

"I simply stopped. I started going to an organisation called Alcoholics Anonymous... and that was my last taste of that world.

"However, it is still with me. My body is covered with tattoos from that period. And I'm afraid some of my ideas and concepts and attitudes that were moulded during that time are still with me. That's why people think, perhaps, I'm a little bit off the wall."

Anti-virus millionaire

Despite his troubles, McAfee managed to land a job at defence contractor Lockheed Martin, where he worked on a classified voice-recognition program.

Layout Design

Our final assignment was to create a double page spread of a presidential inauqural speech using a completely original layout, containing images, a title, quote, header, and footer.

I went with a wide dual column design to make reading of the large blocks of text flow better, gave the break quote an American Flag pattern, and gave the article a good amount of breathing room from the header and footer to make the layout less crowded.

The filters came in a small zip lock bag with a hang tag hole.




Meat Without Feet was a hobby project to create a package design that will repeat in some way regardless of how you stack them next to each other, each surface lines up with a pattern of each other surface so regardless of how these are stacked or lined up the design will always extend from one package to another.





A microbrewery was having a design contest to name and design their new Double IPA.

To fit with the name Hammered Nail I decided to go with a wood shipping crate inspired design and played with the keylines of the 6 pack holder design to add a hammer head to the handle.









For the bottle label I decided to go with a shipping tag theme including a decorative string leading to a paper nail head.

I included all details needed by the FDA and BATFE to sell in the USA on the rear tag.

The Geology department at HSU hired me to design them a new brochure for incoming students.

They needed a neatly layed out brochure that describes why an incoming student should go with geology as a major while also being eye catching next to other departments brochures.

I decided to go with sharp and colorful vector images over a muted out photograph to give a strong visual contrast and a feeling of refinement while still being fun and approachable.

To suppliment my design skills I tought myself 3D modeling, as well as texturing and rendering.


This knife render is one of the better examples of a piece I modeled, painted the textures, and then composed, lighted, and rendered.
